**First Reading** Ezekiel 34:11-16

A READING FROM THE BOOK OF EZEKIEL.

Thus says the Lord God: I myself will search for my sheep, and will seek them out. As shepherds seek out their flocks when they are among their scattered sheep, so I will seek out my sheep. I will rescue them from all the places to which they have been scattered on a day of clouds and thick darkness. I will bring them out from the peoples and gather them from the countries, and will bring them into their own land; and I will feed them on the mountains of Israel, by the watercourses, and in all the inhabited parts of the land. I will feed them with good pasture, and the mountain heights of Israel shall be their pasture; there they shall lie down in good grazing land, and they shall feed on rich pasture on the mountains of Israel. LECTURE DE LA DEUXIÈME LETTRE DE PAUL À TIMOTHÉE.

Sois persuasif, adresse des reproches ou des encouragements, en enseignant avec une patience parfaite. Car le temps viendra où les gens ne voudront plus écouter le véritable enseignement. Mais ils suivront leurs mauvais penchants, et ils s'entoureront d'une foule de maîtres qui leur diront ce qu'ils aiment entendre. Ils fermeront leurs oreilles à la vérité, pour se tourner vers des légendes. Mais toi, garde la tête froide en toute circonstance, supporte la souffrance, travaille activement à l'annonce de la bonne nouvelle, et accomplis jusqu'au bout ton service pour Dieu.

En ce qui me concerne, je suis déjà sur le point d'être offert en sacrifice ; le moment de dire adieu à ce monde est arrivé. J'ai combattu le bon combat, je suis allé jusqu'au bout de la course, j'ai gardé la foi ! Et maintenant, le prix de la victoire m'attend : c'est la couronne du salut que le Seigneur, le juste juge, me donnera au jour du jugement. Et il ne la donnera pas seulement à moi, mais à toutes les personnes qui attendent avec amour le moment où il se manifestera.

**THE HOLY GOSPEL OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST ACCORDING TO JOHN.**

All: Glory to you, Lord Jesus Christ!

When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my lambs." A second time he said to him, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Tend my sheep." He said to him the third time, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" Peter felt hurt because he said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" And he said to him, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my sheep. Very truly, I tell you, when you were younger, you used to fasten your own belt and to go wherever you wished. But when you grow old, you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will fasten a belt around you and take you where you do not wish to go." (He said this to indicate the kind of death by which he would glorify God.) After this he said to him, "Follow me."
