The iconic *Housewives* franchise is entering a new era with a London iteration – and one of the women joining the show is Aussie-born Juliet Mayhew. Here, the interior decorator and event planner, 47, sits down to talk famous friends, on-screen fights, and which celeb she'd love to throw a party for...

How did you end up on the show?

I was in New York with *Housewives Of Dubai*'s Caroline Stanbury – she's a good friend I've known for years. We'd been out to dinner and she tagged me on socials. The next thing, I got this

message from a production company in my DMs. I thought it was a scam at first! **Was it an instant yes?** No, it took some consideration. I've done bits and bobs on TV before, but always things where I was in control. I was a royal correspondent on Fox, and I trained as an actor. I was actually asked to do *Ladies of London* years ago. There is some fear and trepidation, because people are either going to love or hate you. I think my daughter struggled with that – she loves her mummy and doesn't want anyone to say anything nasty. But taking risks is something I've done

all my life. This is an amazing opportunity. **Have your Housewives friends given you any good advice?** Caroline said to me, 'Go in with eyes open and know that you can never lie.' She's been a great mentor to me. I've got a lot of girlfriends who've done this job. I'm good friends with Nicole O'Neil, who did Sydney. I know Chanel Ayan and Taleen Marie from Dubai, and New York's Tinsley Mortimer. It's one degree of separation. **Are you a fighter or a mediator?** I don't know if I'm a mediator, but I don't like drama. I might be an epic fail as a housewife! The last thing I want my

children to witness is their mother screaming at the top of her lungs. I'm a happy-go-lucky Aussie. But I'm also like Vegemite – you'll either love me or hate me. The whole point of the show is seeing how personalities rub up against each other. That's what brings the saltiness and flavour. **Which celeb would you love to plan a party for?** People who are vivacious and crazy, like Robbie Williams or Lady Gaga. If you threw something to them, like, 'Why don't we paraglide off the side of the Eiffel Tower?' They'd be like, 'Let's do it!' Those are the clients you want – and also the ones with very big budgets! ■
