There are few who are able to afford a yacht—especially a finely made one from the likes of Wally, a Monaco-based company responsible for yachts that boast the latest technology and contemporary design. Yet there is one yacht that Wally released that stands out among the others, including those within their own company: the 118 Wallypower, one of the personal favorites of Luca Bassani Antivari, Wally’s founder.

First launched in August of 2003 with an outward appearance much like a military ship with a bow that slices through the ocean surface, the 118 is a boat within its own league. Described by Business Insider as “Darth Vader’s Home On The Water,” it has 17,000 horsepower and a cruising speed

of 60 knots, is made out of lightweight carbon fiber, and was even wind tunnel tested by Ferrari. The yacht won the MYDA, Millennium Yacht Design Award for “Layout of the Third Millennium.” Despite its dark exterior, the interior is minimalistic, sleek, and cozy, with the ability to comfortably accommodate up to twelve people.

Interested in buying one for yourself? Many of us will need to keep dreaming, as the triple gas turbine version costs a baffling \$33 million. Even if you’ll settle for the twin diesels, you’d still need to empty your pockets of \$22 million. Despite the cost, there’s no doubt that the 118 Wallypower is a paragon yacht whose quality is worth the price tag.
