

Breaking News: Chicago Police chase ends in crash. Two juveniles in stolen Kia at fault

CHICAGO — A police chase that originated in Bronzeville has ended with two juvenile suspects in custody. The Kia used in the chase was reportedly stolen. The suspects were accused of armed robbery.

According to CBS 2 drone footage and local police scanners, after the initial robberies, there was a crash and foot chase with one of the suspects. Leading up to the foot chase, there was a female juvenile driving the Kia. According to scanners, it appears that the driver may have wanted to stop; which led to movement in the front seats. The movement is said to be a possible argument, leading up to the female suspect being thrown out.

The chase was believed to have ended around 558 E. 40th St. After the crash, the police did secure one firearm, and emergency services were called for the juvenile who was thrown out of the car, and both juveniles were taken into custody.

This is still considered a developing story, as the juveniles and other details are still unknown.
