(smiling)

(innocently)

(performatively)

I am Haag. I am... Many things.

(mysteriously)

To you, tonight, I am merely a friend. A comrade in arms.

Beat.

(teasing)

You want more, don't you? I can see it. You thirst for it. Knowledge. Wisdom. You ache to know everything, to understand...

(menacing)

Well, my child, I want doesn't get.

(dismissive)

Come back to me when you've cut your teeth a little. You're too fresh, too unscathed, too bright.

Beat.

(engratiating)

You can spend an eternity wandering these grounds feeling the comfort and safety of hardwood and soft silence...

HAAG CONT.

(smiling)

But at some point, you'll ring the bell that cannot be unrung. The Seal. His Seal.

(commanding)

Peer into the abyss, child. You might like what you see.

(chuckling)

Then again, you might not.

IF PLAYER COMES BACK BEFORE USING THE SEAL:

HAAG

(serious)

You showed me courage before, by approaching me first. Show me it again, by heeding my words and following the Seal...

IF PLAYER COMES BACK AGAIN BEFORE USING THE SEAL:

HAAG

(threatening)

Do not provoke me, child. Earn your stripes. Dance for your supper. It will be worth your while, that I can promise you.

IF PLAYER HAS USED THE SEAL AND PLAYED THE RITUAL:

HAAG

(surprise)

That's better. Much better, yes. I see it now; the light has been tempered. The darkness, it grows in you.

(thoughtful)

Balance. I believe that's what He intended for us all. And that is where he failed.
