How the sample is positioned

This piece is positioned as a B2B sales letter for a cybersecurity services provider. The strategy focuses on the operational consequences of hidden security gaps, then offers a low-friction assessment as the logical next step.

Target reader

IT and security leaders at manufacturing companies responsible for system integrity, operational continuity, and cyber-risk oversight.

Core problem

Hidden cybersecurity gaps can trigger business interruption, operational disruption, and revenue loss after a cyberattack.

Offer

A free cybersecurity assessment designed to surface vulnerabilities, reveal blind spots, and move the reader toward follow-up action.

Primary CTA

Schedule a cybersecurity assessment.

Key persuasion angles

Operational downtime, revenue impact, unseen vulnerabilities, industry targeting, and a practical next step.

Structural flow

Problem -> Consequence -> Solution -> Proof -> Objection handling -> Offer -> CTA
