# 'It's getting better for Jimmy's killer and worse for us'

Father of murdered Jimmy Loughlin highlights the flawed HSE's Mental health services as no patient incident report was ever filed for his killer

ON RTÉ Investigates on Tuesday evening, the programme delved into the subject of the psychiatric care scandal in Ireland.

The programme honed in on two families affected by this issue in County Sligo, speaking to Jodie McGuinness who lost her sister Natalie in 2015 and to Michael and Paula Loughlin, who lost their son Jimmy in 2018.

Both of the killers in these respective cases were found not guilty by reason of insanity.
