Cut to a clip of Katt Williams on stage, mid-rant, looking intense.

Katt Williams (on stage):

"Isn't there a lot of glitz and glamour on this platform, unlike the latter being unusable? Nah, man. There is a dark side to this game, and some people end up paying the ultimate price. Michael Jackson? Man was a legend, but they took him out. And you want to catch the dirty hands? Look no further than Puff Daddy. Yeah, I said it; Diddy. That man's got skeletons in his closet, and it is time the world knows."

Cut back to the host, looking shocked.

Host:

Ok. First off, let us process this. Katt Williams is no stranger to the unvarnished truth, but this? Now that is another level. Before we continue, one thing has to be made clear: these are mere allegations. Katt has offered no witness to certify his story, and Diddy has remained silent on these allegations thus far. But we know the internet. When something of this nature is heard, then it easily spreads like wildfire now. Here, it is crucial to dissect it completely and analyze if the accusations hold water at all, or whether it truly is but another arcane theory.

Cut to a montage of Michael Jackson performing, Diddy at events, and paparazzi footage.

Host Voiceover.

Let's go back a bit in history. The entire world was held in shock when Michael Jackson died in 2009. Thus, he died at a very young age, only 50 years, wherein the cause of death was certified as acute intoxication by propofol and benzodiazepines. His doctor, Dr. Conrad Murray, has been accused of involuntary manslaughter in administering these drugs, but has been the subject of innumerable conspiracies over the years regarding his death. Some people feel that Michael was murdered either because of his music catalog, because of debts, or because he knew the secrets of the industry. And now Katt Williams gives fire to that fuel by pointing the finger at Diddy.

Cut to the host, leaning forward, looking serious.

Host.

"Great talking, not just Diddy people: I mean, Sean Combs, aka Puff Daddy aka Diddy, is one of the fiercest and while-that-must-have-been-for-an-importance-in-the-music-industry figures: swinging beneath the property-hunting. Heartbreaker, a producer and a businessman, brings fire, determination, and rap into the ring, but well, accompany it with scrutiny as you have to buy it because, as heard this time, Diddy has always been in the scrapes with almost every kind of drama—court cases, gossips of dirty deals, and much more drama. But now to be tying himself up to the death of Michael Jackson, that truly is a new twist to the sighting."

Cut to a clip of Diddy and Michael Jackson together at an event, laughing and shaking hands.

Host Voiceover.

After all, Diddy and Michael Jackson are said to have engaged in some sort of professional relationship. They worked along with me on some projects, had some fun at the same events, and had quite a party together. Yet, what sparked between them remained a secret. Katt Williams would certainly seem to believe there is. In his rant, he suggested Diddy would have had a motive to shut Jackson up. But what on Earth could that motive be?

Cut to the host, holding up a piece of paper.

Host:

"Let us dissect this further. Katt Williams expresses that Michael Jackson knew too much about the inner workings of the music industry, and that this knowledge became a serious threat to some with real power. He also insinuated that Michael's music catalog, which is a billion-dollar one, became a tremendous bone of contention." "Here is where things get interesting. Given that Diddy has shown a great interest in acquiring music catalogs and has completed quite a few high-profile acquisitions through the years, might Michael Jackson's catalog have fallen into his sights? If so, did Diddy somehow arrange for him to die and thus hold the catalog?"

Cut to a montage of news headlines about Diddy's business deals and Michael Jackson's estate.

Host Voiceover:

"Michael Jackson's estate is without question one of the richest in the entertainment scene, with his music still bringing in millions every year, considered the goldmine in his catalog. Diddy or any other would-be claimant to that catalog would need to go through the estate, but here's the kicker: the estate has been embroiled in legal battles for years, with various parties trying to gain control. Could Diddy have been one of those parties? And if so, did he go to extreme lengths to get what he wanted?"

Cut to the host, looking skeptical.**Host:**

"Whoa, hold up there for a second. These accusations are quite strong, and without any stronger evidence to back them up, they are hard to take on their face. Katt Williams is known for rather frank comments and views, but then again, he is a comic. Could such accusations have just been another one of his hyperbolic speeches made for maximum shock? On the other hand, is there something true about what he's saying? Well, let's investigate a bit deeper."

Cut to a clip of Katt Williams in an interview, looking serious.**Katt Williams in the interview:**

"I am not here to play games, my friend. I am here to tell the truth. It was probably when there must have been a misunderstanding behind the scenes. Michael Jackson used to be a good man; he didn't deserve those things. And those responsible? They are out there enjoying life. It is high time for accountability."

Cut back to the host, nodding thoughtfully.**Host:**

Williams has a passion for this, and he has hardly been the only one expressing doubts on the subject of the death of Michael Jackson. There have been documentaries and books over the years that have addressed the idea of murder, which does indeed allow us the possibility of examining the link to Diddy. A new twist, then; let us examine the facts.

Cut to a list of bullet points on the screen.

Host Voiceover:

"Fact #1: Michael Jackson's death was determined as a homicide, with his physician imprisoned. Yet, many feel that there were other players in the scheme. Fact #2: Diddy has always had a penchant for being involved in high-level business transactions, particularly with music catalogs. Fact #3: Katt Williams has a knack for really saying what is on his mind, but at the same time has gained notoriety for making very unsavory allegations without sufficient or, shall we say, credible proof. Where does that leave us?"

Cut to the host, leaning back in their chair.**Host:**

Katt Williams brings people into the conversation. It is all just speculation until there is concrete evidence supporting the claims. The one thing that is for certain is Katt Williams has brought people talking—whether they believe him or not, his comments have opened dialogue about what people might do for power and money in the music industry.

Cut to a montage of fans reacting to Katt Williams' claims on social media.**Host Voiceover:**

The social media reaction over Katt's claims has been rocking the walls, with some convinced that he is on to something while others think he is just stirring the pot; however, one thing we know for sure is that this one is here to stay for some time.

Cut to the host, looking directly at the camera.**Host:**

In your opinion, does Katt Williams have any semblance of truth to his outrageous claims, or is it all just a convoluted plot fantasy? Let me know your take on it in the comments.
