 Caregiver to Client ratio of 3 to 1, and often less with
 volunteers. All caregivers are highly trained and are
 screened for health and vulnerability risks.

 Helping Hands Adult Day Services (ADS) members enjoy
 a well-scheduled day of social interaction, playing games,
 exercise, music therapy, and visits from special guests.
- Nutritious Meals and Snacks
 At our Adult Day program we believe health or behavior challenges can be helped with dietary solutions and good fluid intake. We offer nutritious meals and plenty of fluids.
- Very Affordable Participation Costs
 Pricing based on acuity levels begins at \$13/hr.,
 transportation costs also included. We help families access
 benefits and cost-sharing programs available through TriCounty Office on Aging and the Veteran's Administration.
