Activity: Diamond Painting

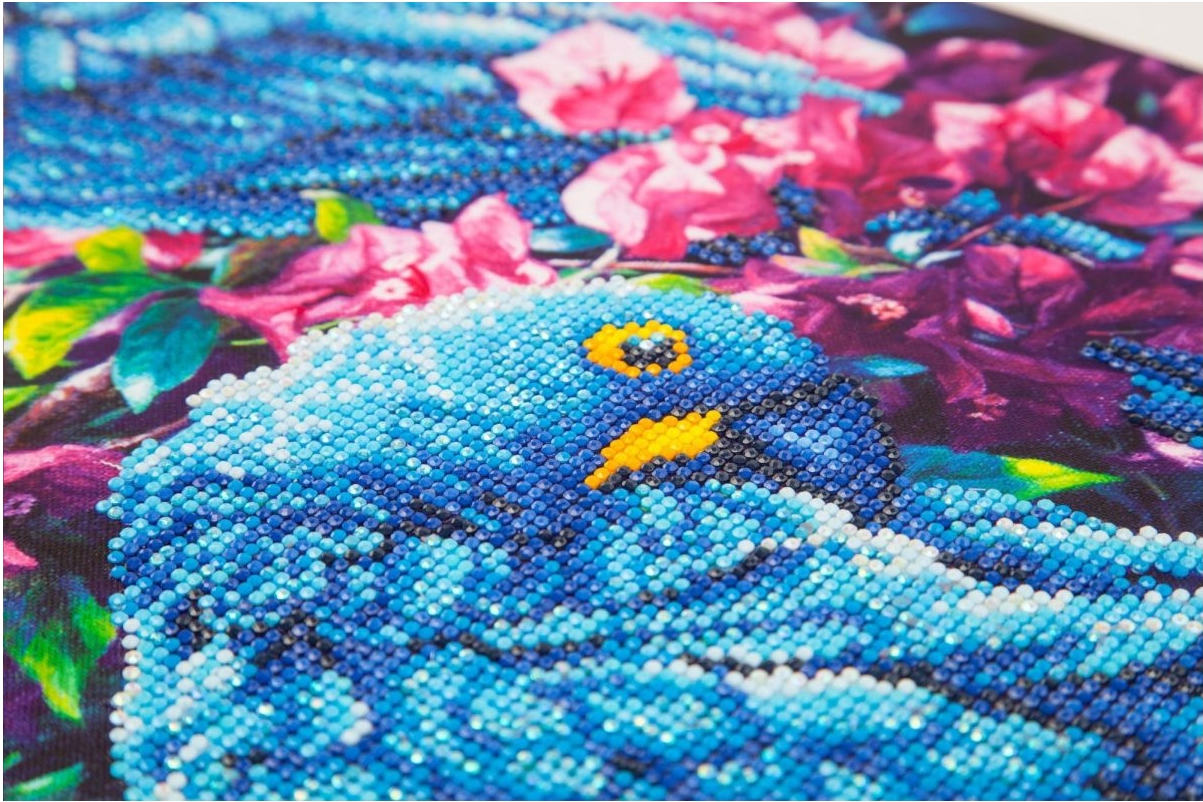
