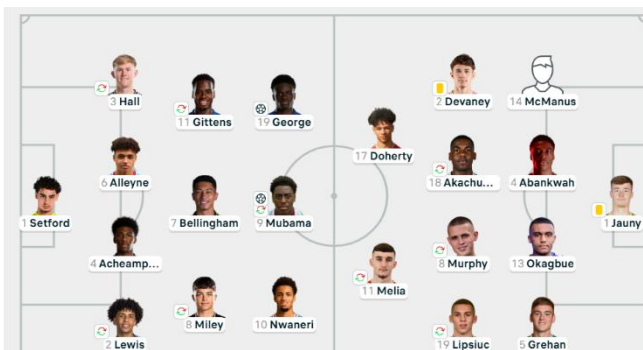

TECHNICAL 7/10

- Has good ball control and a good 1st touch, would show good dribbling ability by driving into advanced areas of the pitch with the ball.
- Gets good contact and distance on defensive headers.
- Committed 2 fouls within the first 5 minutes of the game but as the game went on gained composure.
- Marking was good as he got close to players not allowing them to spin in behind.
- Good with both feet and comfortable receiving the ball out from the back.
- Due to his size he is a threat from set plays.
- Can play long range passes.

TACTICAL 7/10

- Ball playing and Possession based CB who has a good passing range.
- Positioning was good as he defended the box well by covering open space and making clearances.
- 1v1 defending was good as he got close to players, applying pressure and was able to get blocks/ tackles in.
- Got in front of markers to attack the ball 1st/ get to loose balls.

MENTAL 7/10

- Was vocal as he communicated well with other defenders and GK.
- Showed good concentration levels as the weather conditions were poor.
- Showed good commitment and determination as when 2-0 late in the game with the game already won he stuck to his task well by tracking his marker and putting a block in.

PHYSICAL 7/10

- Is agile and adjusts body position well.
- Is quick and athletic in his recovery runs.
- Shows good acceleration and speed by getting back into position after an attacking situation.

CONCLUSION COMMENTS

A good game had showing good signs in all areas of his game, despite not having a lot to do defensively he showed good mental and technical attributes, especially.

Is currently on loan at Watford, gaining a good level of 1st team football, would be good for him to get another loan when his time with Watford is up, as it will be hard for him to get any game time at Manchester City with the amount of good players in his position. This would stop his development and progress.
