TECHNICAL 6/10

- Showed good qualities in this area of his game with good ball control and dribbling, keeping the ball close to him at all times and not allowing the ball to get out of his control to give away possession.
- Passes were good in general with good weight on them and reaching the intended target with great accuracy. Showed **confidence playing 1st time passes** to quicken the tempo of play. Was comfortable on the ball in pressure and non pressure situations.
- Used both feet well but predominantly used his stronger right when possible.
- Was sensible in regards to the situation of where to play the ball, for example, would pass backwards if the midfield was congested rather than trying to make an unrealistic pass and lose possession, likewise when in the attacking 3rd would play the ball forward to build/gain momentum for an attack.
- He was lazy in his standing tackles, sticking a leg out rather than attempting to win the ball, ultimately leading to **conceding the 1st goal**.
- His height helped him to compete in aerial battles.
- Other attributes were not shown during the game so I can not judge fairly.

TACTICAL 7/10

- Box-Box cm with good stamina and energy levels to maintain throughout the game.
- Decision making was good as kept possession and made good passes with the ball at all times, not risking a turnover of the ball.
- Positioning, tracking back and off the ball movement were all positives as would track back when defending staying with his marker closely not allowing any 3rd man runs to be effective. Off the ball movement was good in both attack and defence as would make runs into wide areas to create room/space for others to run into/looking to break through the lines when attacking. when defending would stay with his marker always following them so it would be easier to intercept/tackle. And not lose sight of him easily to allow runs away from him.
- Made runs into advanced areas of the pitch providing a threat going forward, and getting in and around the box.

MENTAL 7/10

- Alert, vocal, always on the move ready to receive the ball/ react to lose balls/ intercept danger.
- Aggressive player who shows bravery in going for 50/50 balls with confidence and determination.
- Had good work rate never dropping levels in regards to the score and tracked back with willingness.

PHYSICAL 6/10



- A tall player (6'0) who is aggressive, has good stamina levels, is agile, and has decent pace.
- Was quick in getting back to help defensively as well as getting forward.
