- Showed good vision for his assist as he played a well weighted pass through a tight gap.

Negatives / Areas to Improve / Weaknesses:

- Made some poor decisions when making passes/gave the ball away easily.
- Corners were poor with them failing to beat the 1st man.

Overall Conclusion:

A quiet game where he was not as effective compared to other games I have watched him, He showed good determination and work rate as he was always showing for the ball and working hard for the team, which is key when you are not having a huge impact on the game.

He did provide an assist that had good weight on the pass and showed good vision as there was not much space to play the pass.

He was not a goal threat in this game from open play as he had 0 shots. (had 1 shot from a free kick that went over the bar).

This was not a game where he showed technical attributes but he showed good mental attributes.
