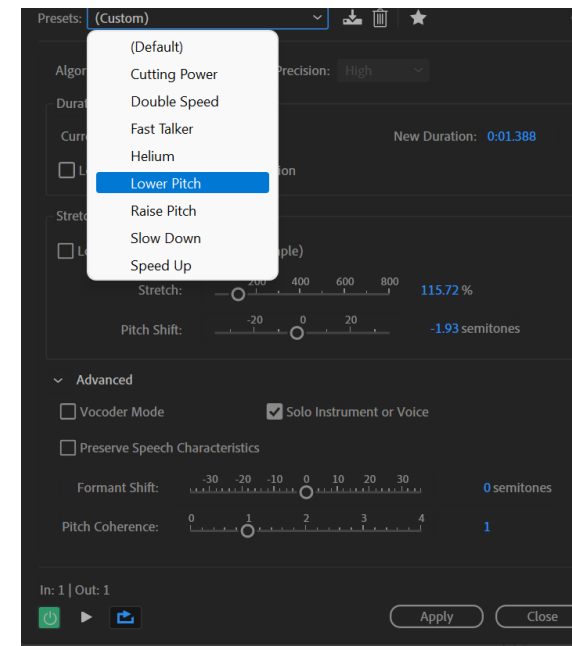
Getting rid of unnecessary parts by deleting them

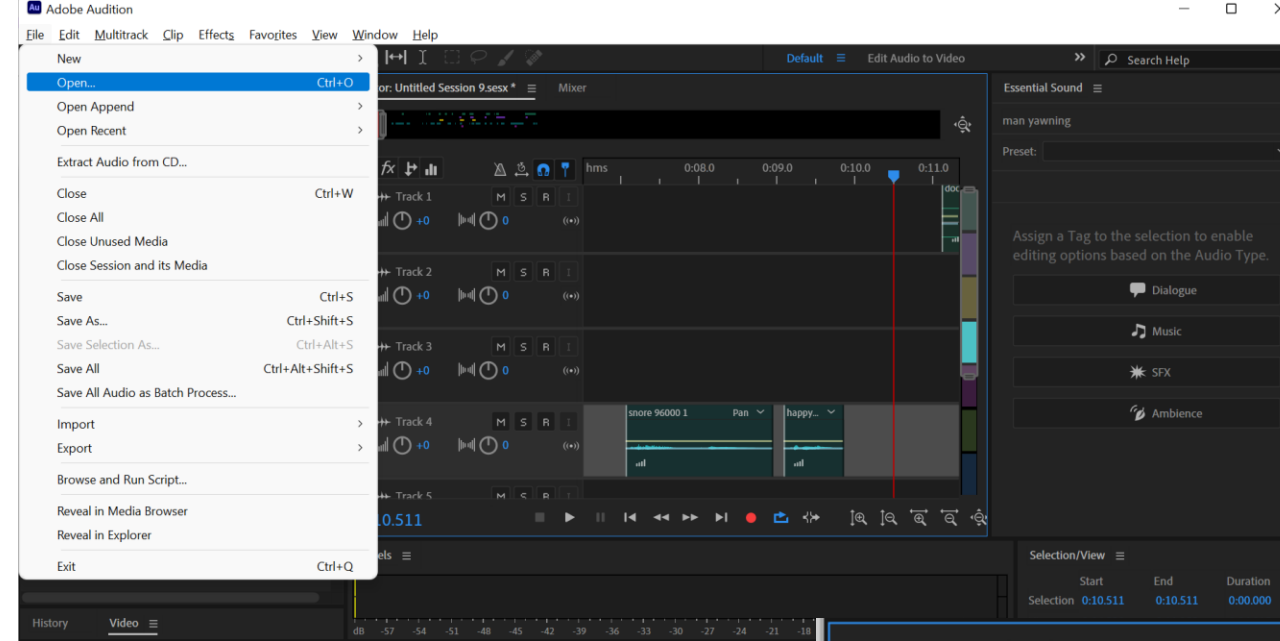
And raise pitch for the chicken voice



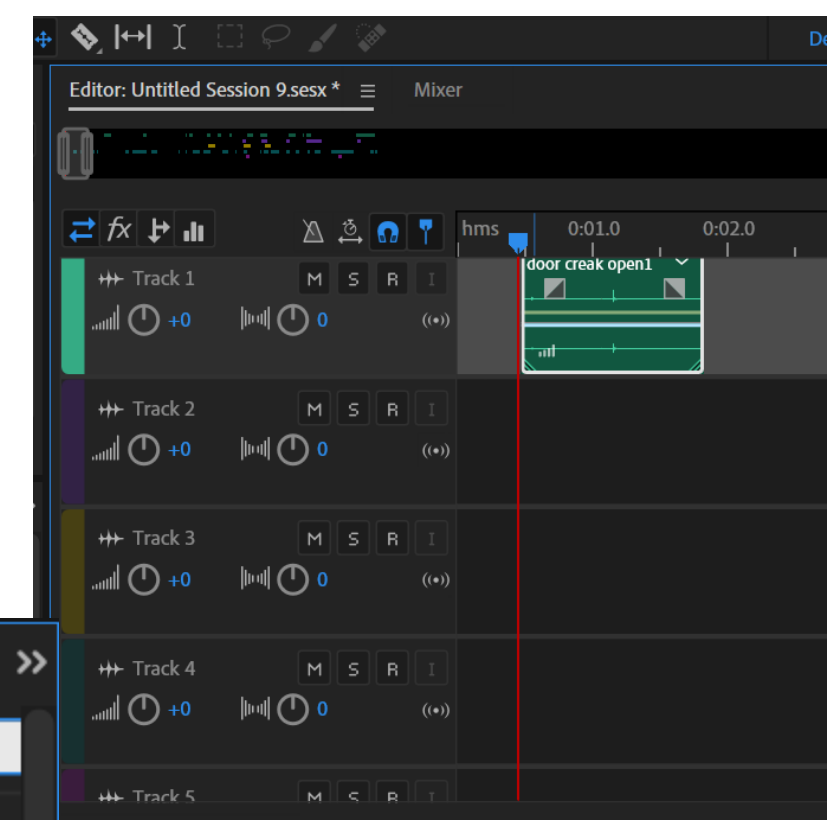
Go to effects and find stretch and pitch

Go to presets and choose lower pitch for the man voices



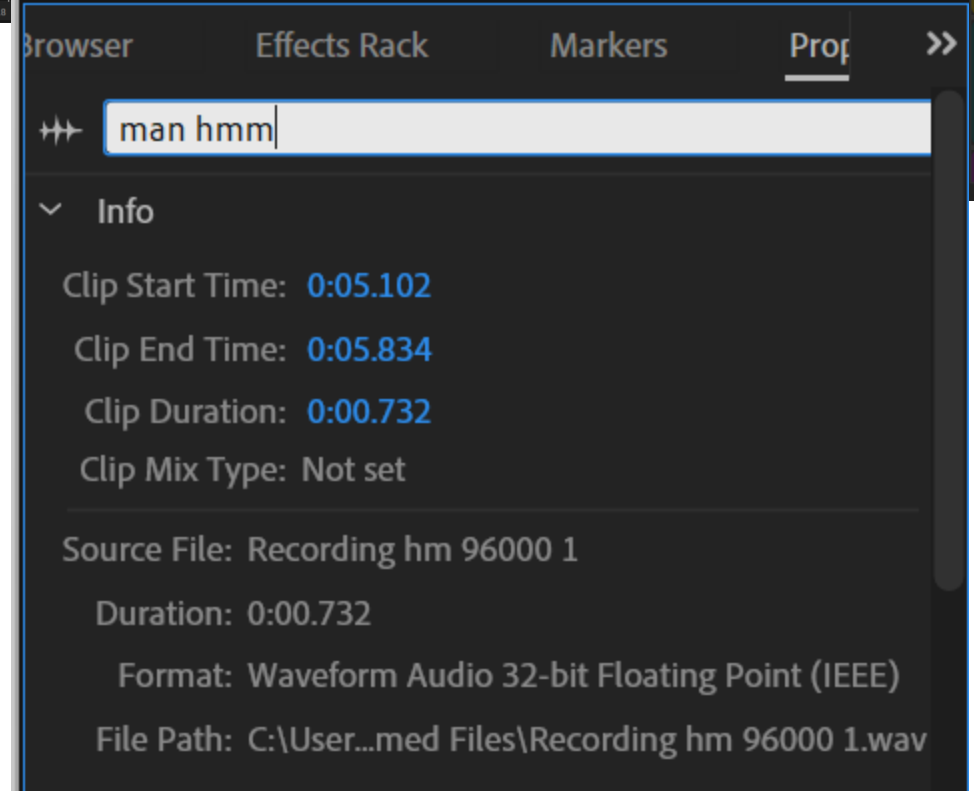


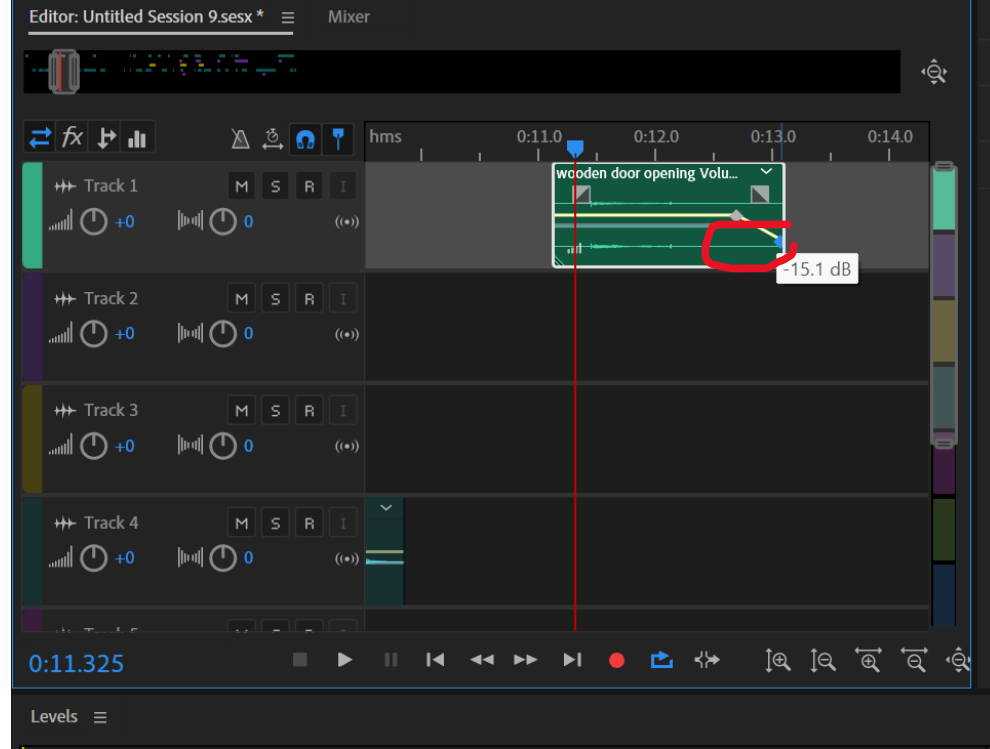

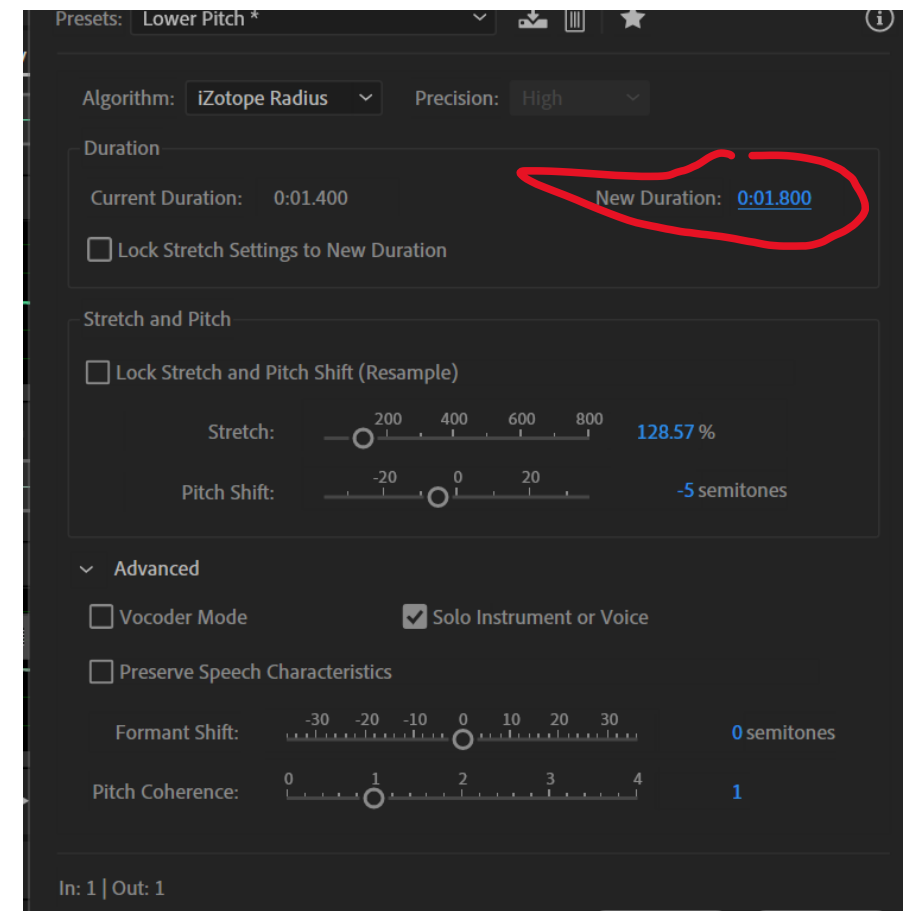
Import every audio file

Rename the audios to something easier

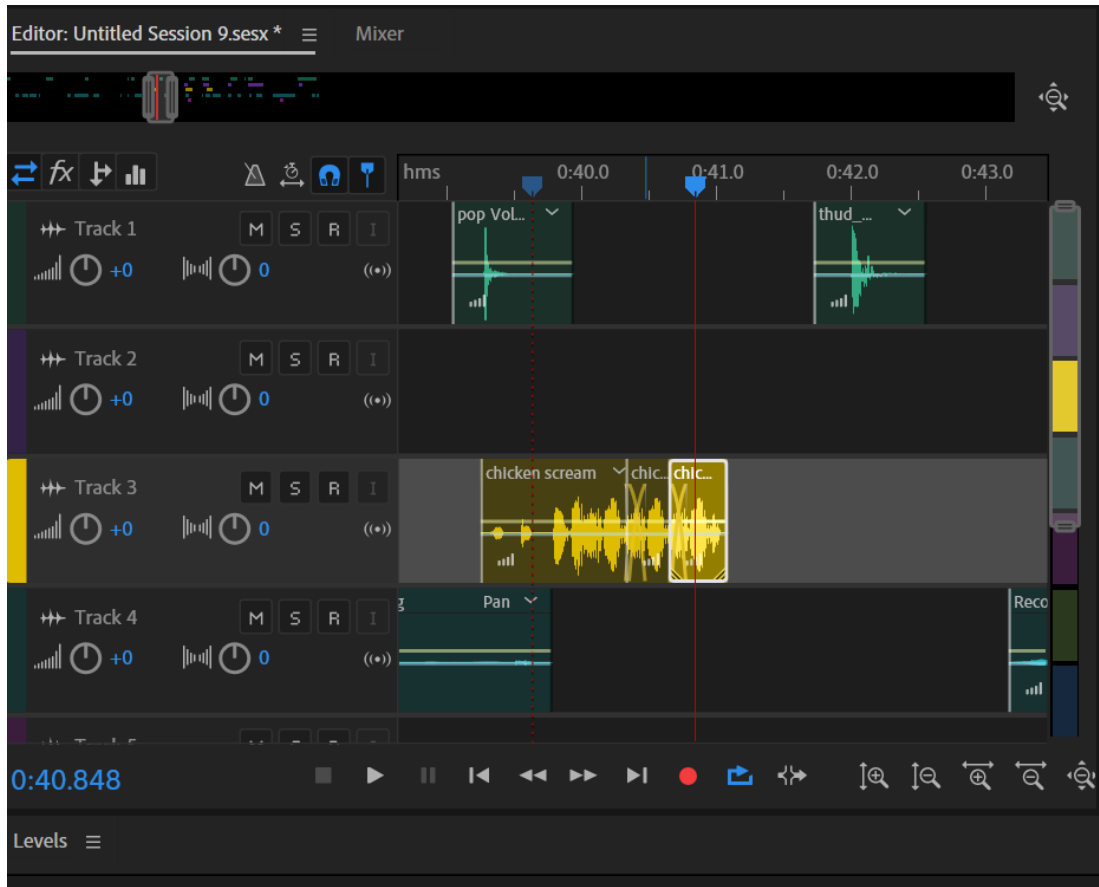




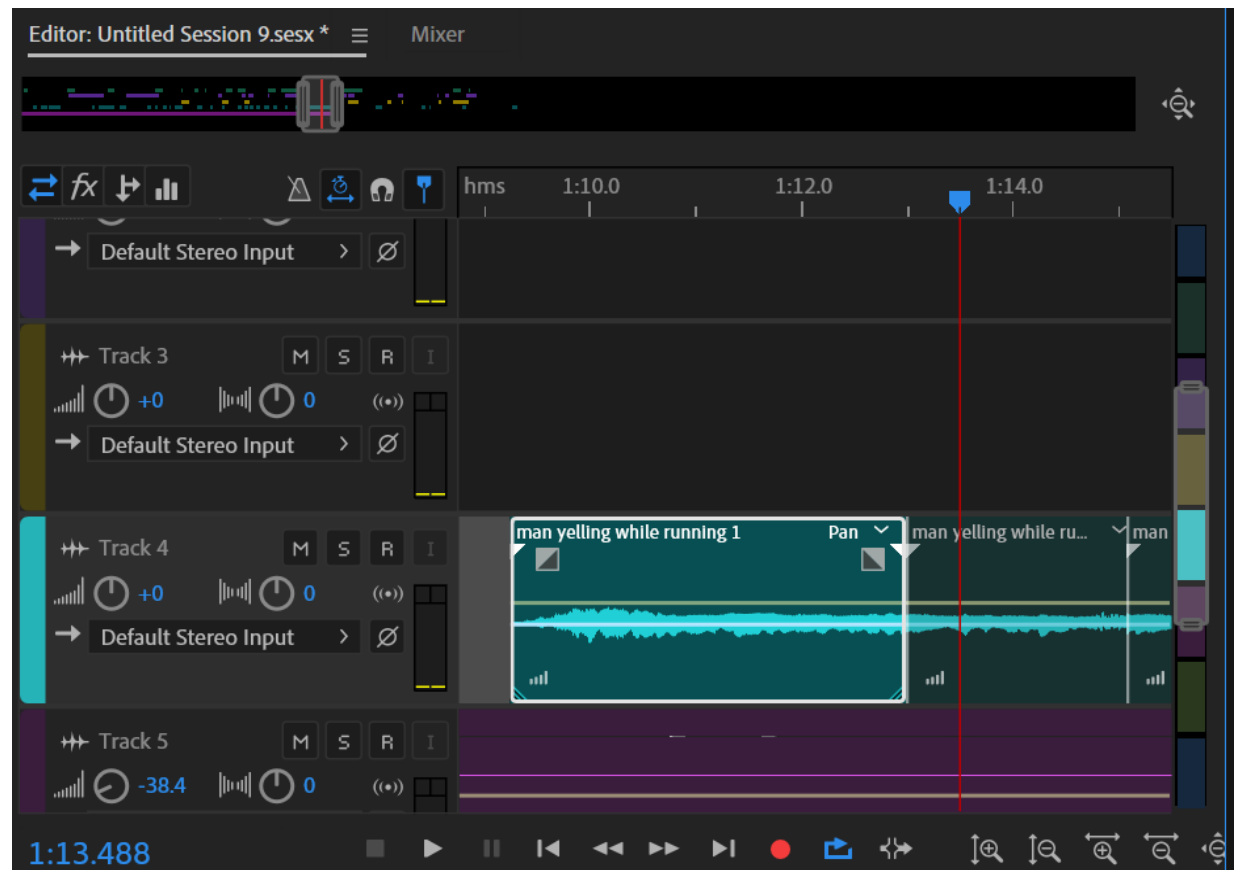
Fade out some audios by clicking on the yellow line and dragging it down



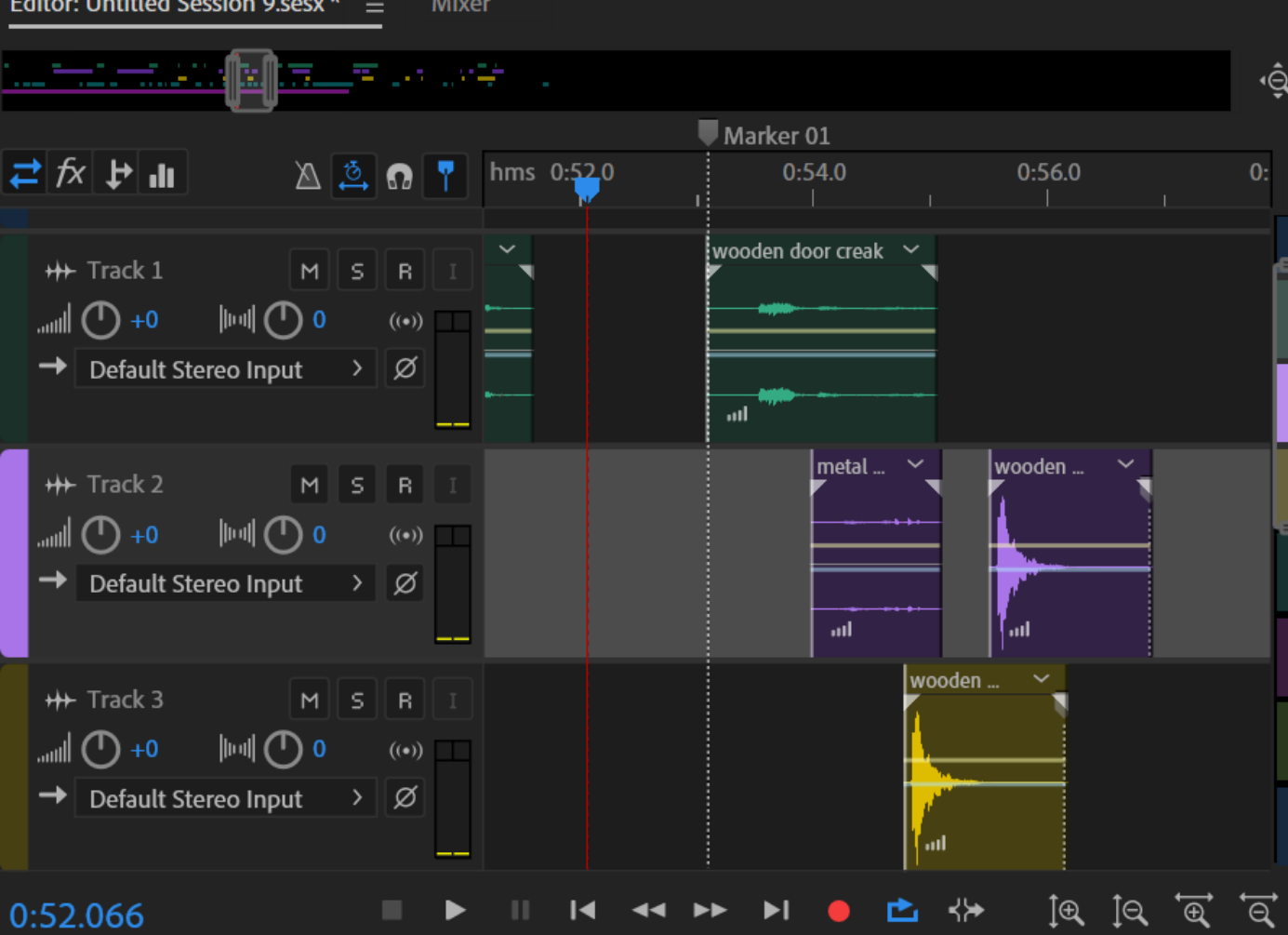
Since the sfx was too short I decided to lengthen it by using stretch and pitch, changing the new duration



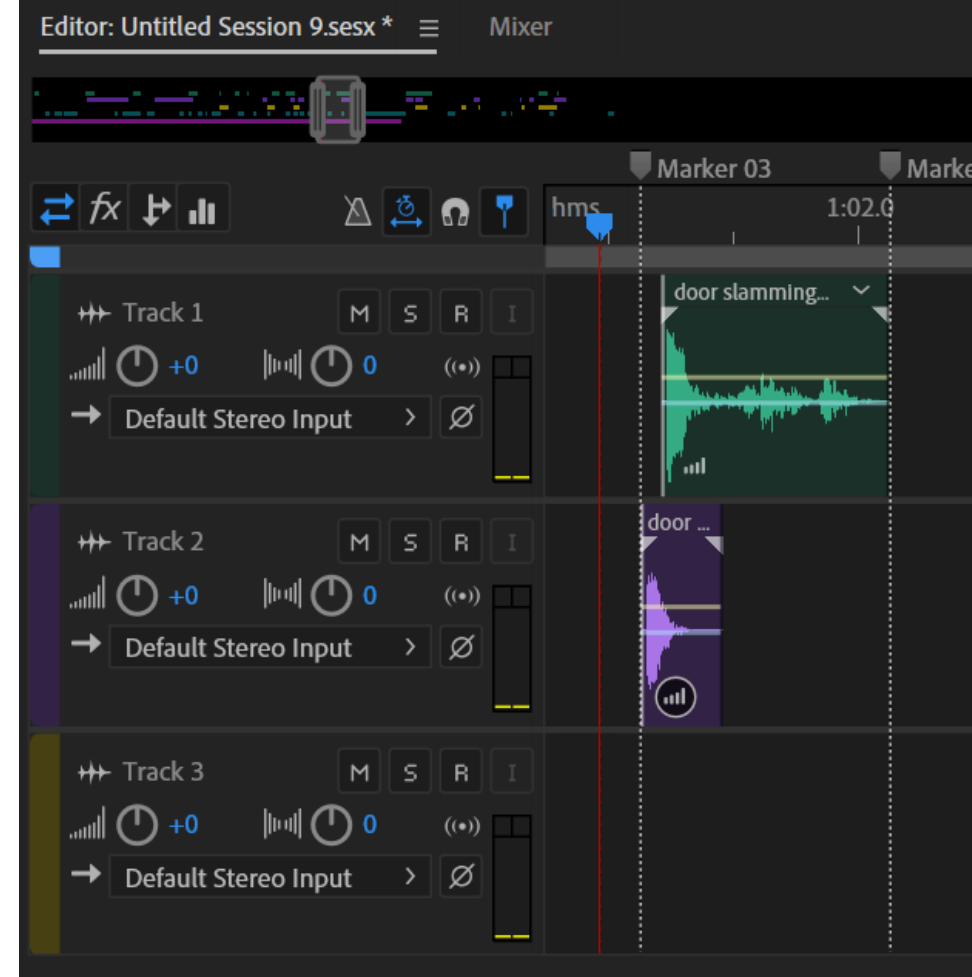
Felt that the scream was too short so I duplicated it with ctrl c and ctrl v and placed it so that it sounded seamless



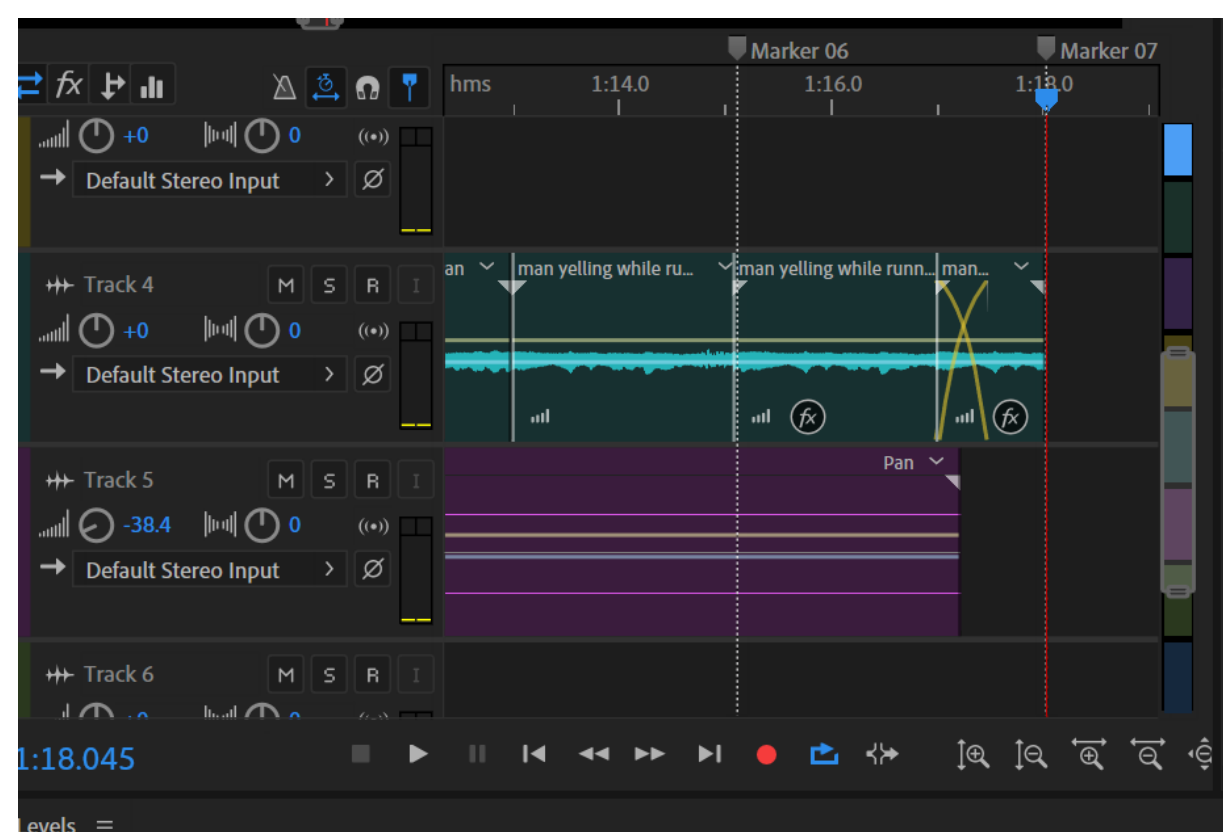
Did the same thing for this clip



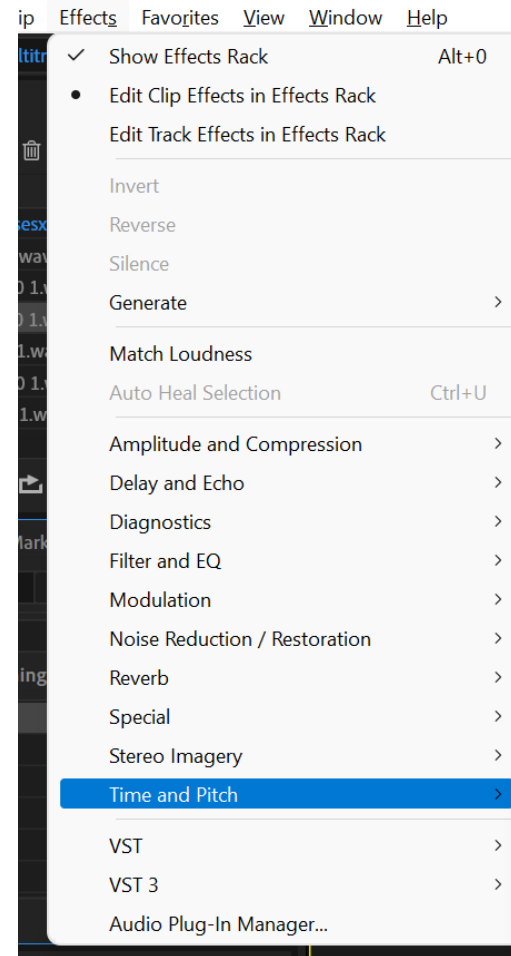
First customised SFX to mimic the sound of the wooden door opening and breaking



Second one was the sound of the man kicking the door open, slamming it against the wall

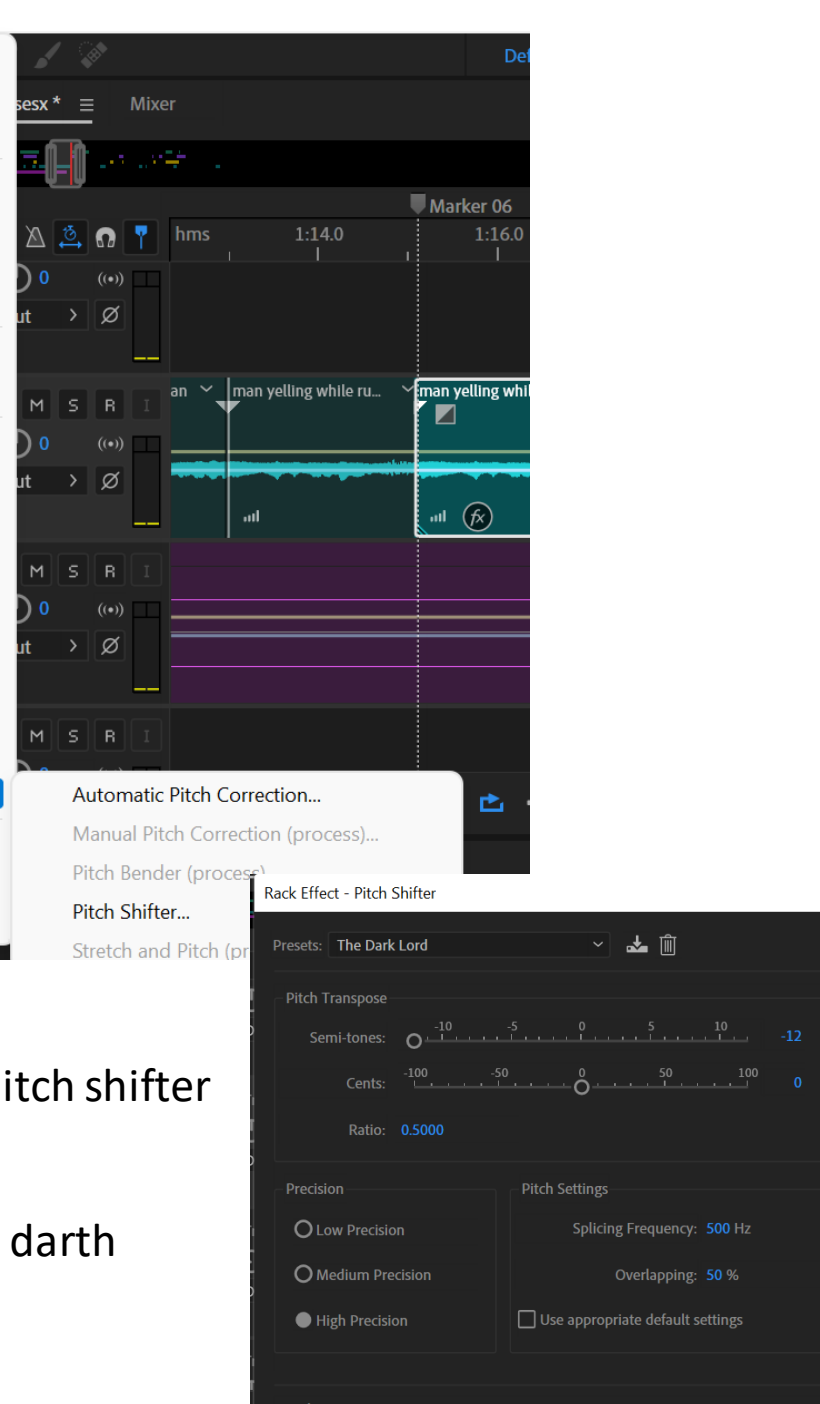


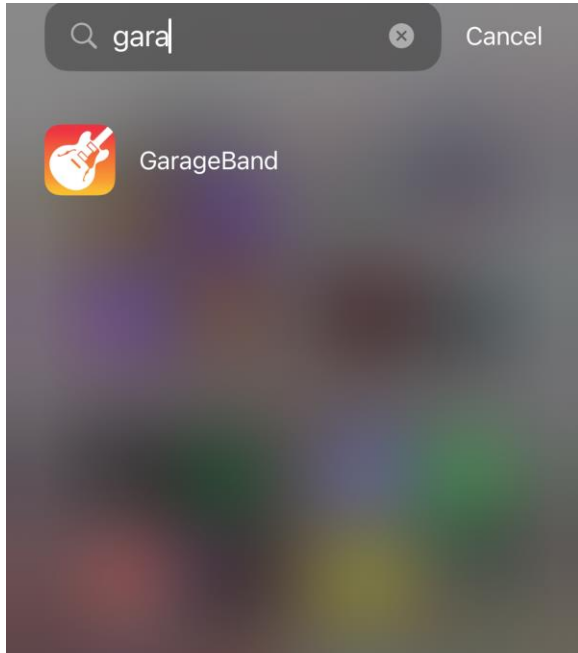
3rd one was to lower the pitch so that it sounds like it was in slowmo

And selecting the darth vader preset

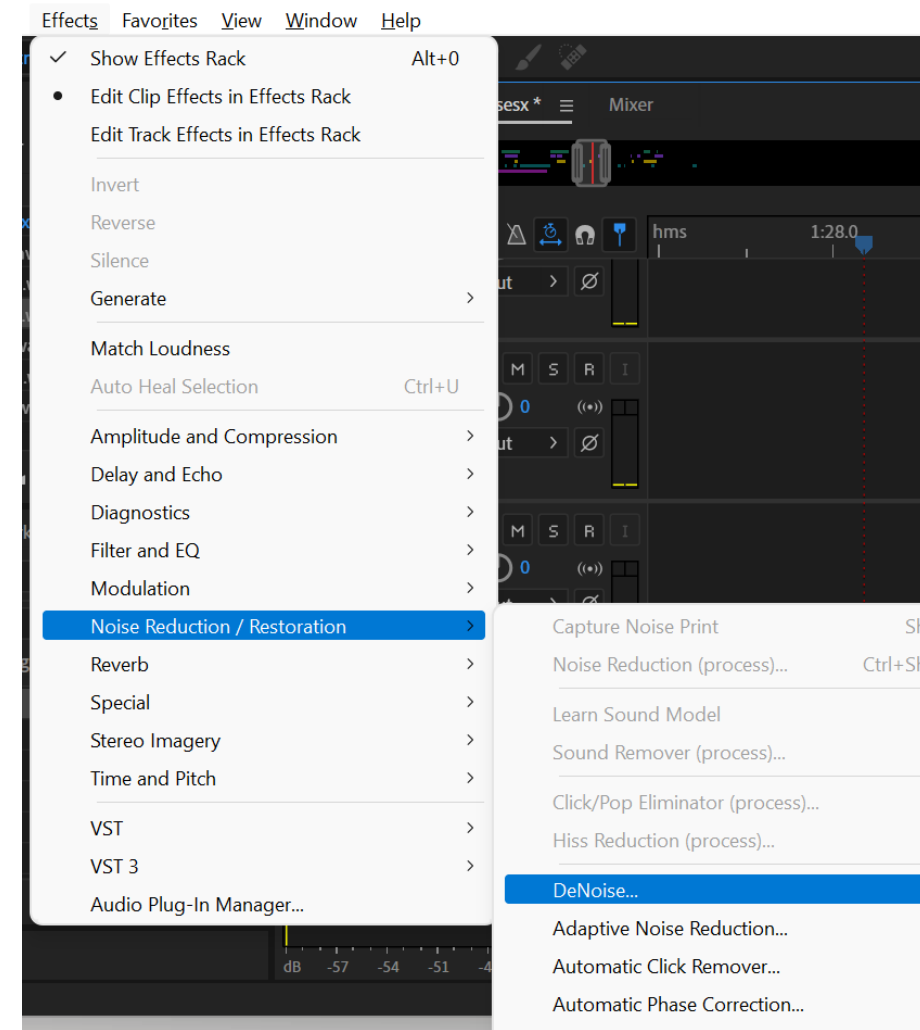


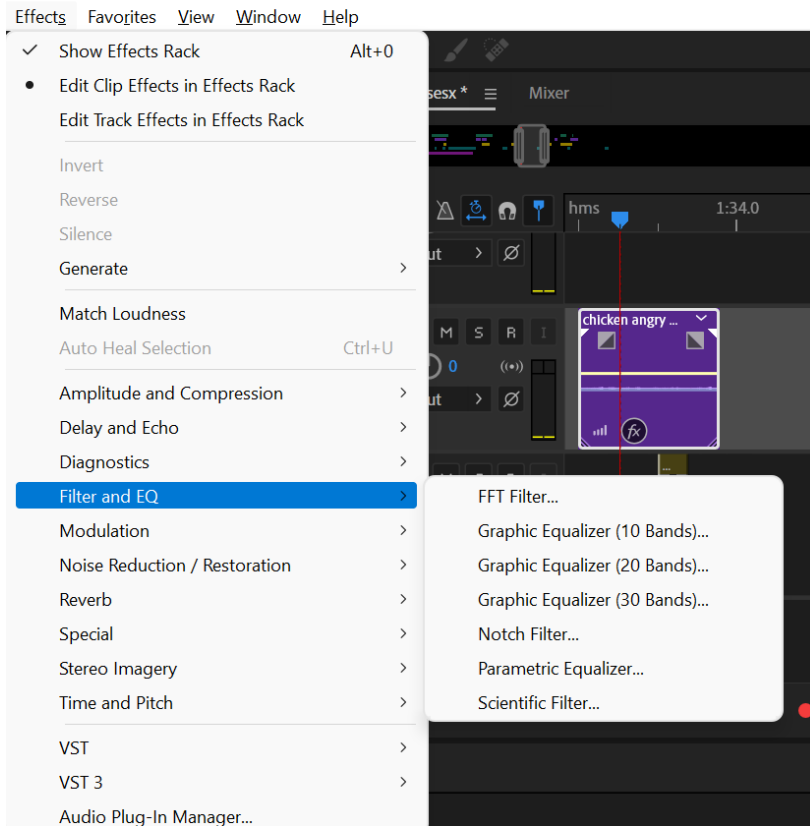


I used garage band to make the tiptoe noises just like how some cartoons do it

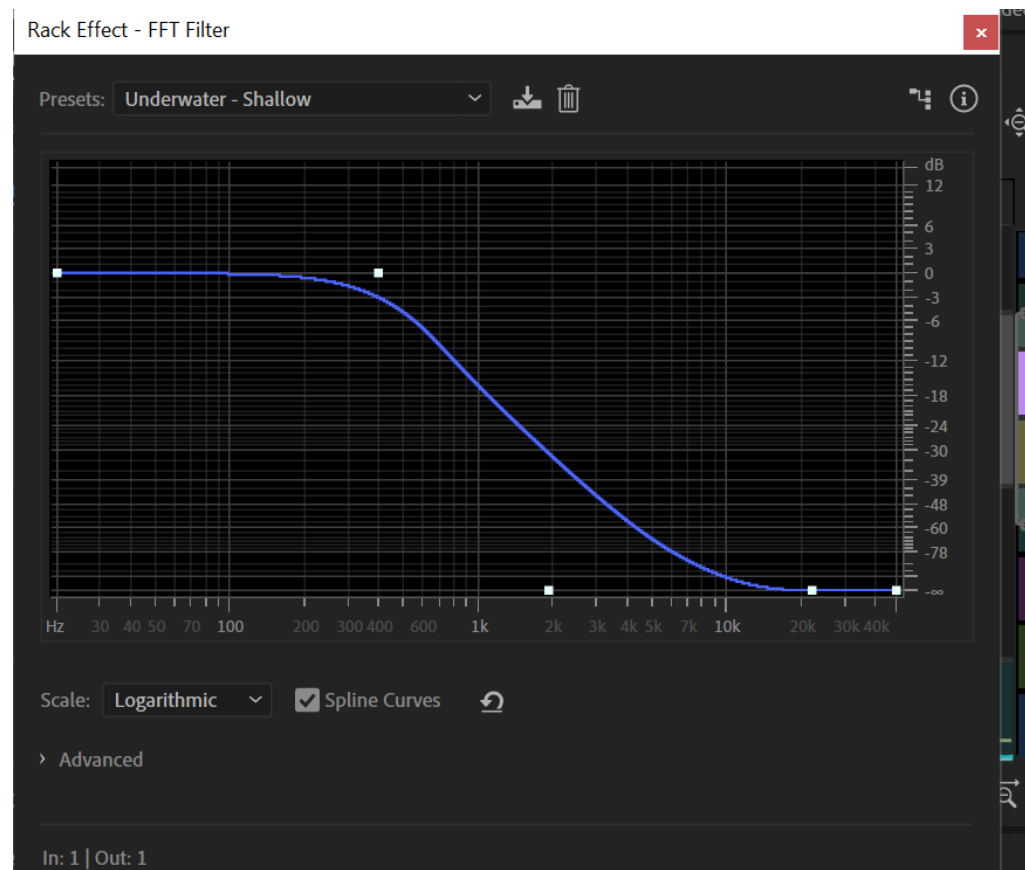


And denoise to reduce background noises from the recordings I did
