Hitting Ability *	45	50	Pull-oriented hitter with bat to ball skills and bat speed, able to pull the ball in the air and catch up to velocity in two strike counts. Looks com
Plate Discipline	50	50	Sees fastballs well and does damage, handles velo well, makes good swing decisions, doesn't strike out much but doesn't walk much either
Power Frequency *	35	45	Capable of double digit home runs in the big leagues but historically power manifests in doubles more than it does over the fence
Raw Power	55	55	DNS BP but from my looks strong avg raw. Best bullets look to be around 105 and have backspin, to LCF with authority
Running Speed *	30	30	4.6 down the line in my look - not a runner but historically better run speeds
Base Running	40	40	Non base stealing threat but may swipe a few via instincts, not a base clogger
Arm Strength *	45	45	Slight arc in throw, arm looks fringe average
Arm Accuracy	50	50	Throws are on-line and accurate
Fielding *	40	45	Makes routine plays routinely but doesn't stand out defensively. Hands work nicely just doesn't have the feet/speed
Range	40	45	Not the fastest guy but mostly gets to what he needs to get to
Baseball Instincts	50	50	Knows the game, solid approach to the game
Aggressiveness	50	50	Not overly aggressive but plays the game well
Summation:	<u>6'0, 215 lb 2B with feel to hit. who will be an average everyday player at the big league level. His bat is his carrying tool. Has bat speed - will touch the ball enough to get to double digit home runs but will most likely have more doubles than HR in the big leagues. K rate went up 5% (14-19%) from AA to AAA so would expect it to jump more facing big league pitching. He has shown he has aptitude and good enough bat-to-ball skills to make adjustments. Pull-oriented hitter but capable of hitting to all fields. His defense doesn't stand out and the arm is fringy, but he is functional and makes most of the routine plays routinely.</u>
