**Summation:** Athletic right-handed emergency call-up, up/down middle reliever with 3-pitch mix. Throws outlier knuckleball he has two variations of with 5-8 mph of velo separation between the two. KB will dance in lower elevation but in AZ wasn't doing much. Fb sits around 90 and is fringy - not much movement to it. Slury breaking ball he flashes occasionally. Inconsistent with strike-throwing and command is zone-over-spot. His path to a chance at the big leagues is the outlier pitch.
