TECHNIQUE / AWARENESS / COMMUNICATION / DECISION MAKING – (Briefly Describe)

- Predominantly left footed, good close control. Able to use right foot to control, pass & shoot.
- Hugs the left touchline to offer width, then cuts inside to allow space for the LB to overlap.
- Has a physical & athletic build, has strength to hold off opponents & shield the ball.
- Can spot a clever ball in behind, nearly playing in the No9 on 11 mins (too much pace on pass).
- He scans over his shoulders to see where opponents are & where pockets of space open up during attacking transitions in the final 3rd.
- He was seen to communicate on the pitch with team-mates, trying to organise & make sure they were in position.
- I did see Osifo lose possession in central positions on a few occasions, taking the wrong choice of direction & being dispossessed. He would however track back to try & get it back.

POSITIONAL – BASIC TASKS – (How did the player perform in their basic positional tasks?)

- Playing on the left-wing, looking to get forward either down the flank or cutting inside.
- He moves into central areas to allow the LB to overlap him.
- Looks to get forward & play forward/incisive passes to fellow attacking team-mates.
- Got a shot in on target with his right foot (44 mins), cut in from the left wing, shot too central & saved by the GK.
- 2nd half he had a goal dis-allowed for offside. But he showed excellent chest control & a powerful & accurate finish into the top corner on his left foot.

POSITIONAL – SECONDARY TASKS – (How did the player perform in their secondary positional tasks?)

- Tracks back to help defensive transitions & also comes back into the box to defend set-pieces.
- Tracked back to put in a tackle & stop a cross on the left-hand side (24 mins).
- Stays outside the box, mid way into the opponent's half on attacking set-pieces to cover in a defensive role, to allow tall defenders to go into the box.
- Also seen to drop into a defensive role & help in defensive transitions (35 mins).

ADDITIONAL NOTES – (Change of position? Fitness / Attitude / Set Piece involvement)

- He stayed out on the left wing & showed a good level of work rate throughout the game.
- He showed good fitness, lasting the whole game. Attitude showed throughout was good.
- Involved in the box for some attacking set-pieces, mainly kept outside the box to screen.

RECOMMENDATION – NEED TO WATCH HIM AGAIN IN ANOTHER FIXTURE.
