This month's [AARP Bulletin story](#) describes the [AARP Foundation Tax-Aide program](#), in which volunteers prepare federal and state tax returns for people without charge. The program is open to everyone, but geared toward low- and moderate-income residents, particularly those 50 and older. The nationwide program was launched in 1968 and is now the largest free tax prep program in the country.

In Massachusetts, the [Tax-Aide program](#) is offered at 220 sites such as community centers and libraries. Last year, 675 volunteers helped 45,000 MA residents file returns.

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
