





Givairo Read is a right-back for Feyenoord who developed through at FC Volendam before joining Feyenoord's academy in 2023. He progressed quickly through the club's youth structure and made his senior debut during the 2023/24 season, initially appearing in European competition before earning domestic minutes. Since then, Read has transitioned from a depth option into a first-team starter, benefiting from increased trust within Feyenoord's senior setup. He has also been a regular presence across multiple Netherlands youth national teams, reflecting his standing within the country's elite age-group pathway.



Crosses Total vs Chances Created

Read plots above the main cluster, sitting in a zone occupied by fullbacks who combine steady crossing volume with consistent chance creation. This places him above average for attacking contribution from wide areas, showing that his final-third involvement translates into real output.



Touches vs Dribbles Completed

His position sits comfortably above the mean for both involvement and successful dribbles, indicating a fullback trusted in possession who can progress play on the ball. He profiles as an active ball-carrier within this group, capable of advancing attacks through direct actions.

Conclusion

Read profiles as a modern fullback whose value comes from the combination of athletic capacity, technical security, and tactical reliability. Across his senior appearances, he consistently shows comfort receiving under pressure, an ability to progress play down the right side, and the physical tools to manage repeated high-intensity actions. His recovery pace allows him to hold aggressive positions without compromising defensive balance, while his composure on the ball supports Feyenoord's preference for controlled build-up from the back.

From a development perspective, the key theme with Read is continuity at senior level. The raw tools are already evident, but the next stage is about sustaining influence across longer stretches of matches and full seasons, particularly as opposition teams begin to target him more deliberately. His decision-making in advanced areas, timing of overlaps, and consistency of final delivery will continue to sharpen through repetition at Eredivisie and European level, where the tactical demands are higher and mistakes are punished more quickly.

In the wider context, Read's trajectory aligns with Feyenoord's recent history of accelerating young players into meaningful first-team roles before they reach full maturity. His long-term contract reflects internal belief, while the external attention he has attracted from teams such as Manchester City and Bayern Munich place him firmly within the current market of high-upside fullbacks. If his development continues along its current path, Read projects as a top fullback in a Top 5 League whose profile fits both possession-dominant systems and high-tempo transitional sides, with his ceiling tied closely to how quickly he turns consistent involvement into sustained authority within games.
