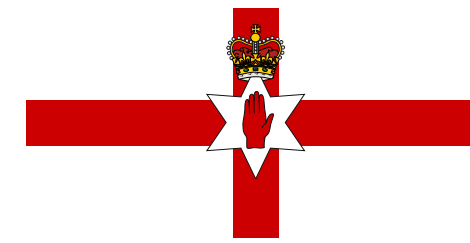

Player Overview

Isaac Price is a tall, lanky, attack-minded midfielder with a flexible profile across the right/left side and central areas. Having developed at Everton, before moving to Standard Liège and now in the Championship with West Brom, he has already played in a few different environments for his age. His game is built around delivery, ball-striking and forward running from midfield. He can operate as a wide midfielder on both sides who can carry down the line and whip crosses into the box, but also has the passing range and movement to play inside as an attacking midfielder. What stands out is the variety in his final-third impact: he can deliver from open play, take set pieces, shoot from distance, arrive in the box and pick passes into dangerous areas. Physically, he is tall and long-striding, but moves well for his size and is more coordinated on the ball than his frame might suggest. He is also willing to track back and compete defensively, using his size and upper-body strength well in duels. Overall, Price profiles as a versatile attacking midfielder with set-piece value, ball-carrying power, strong work rate and useful final-third quality.

Technical

Technically, Isaac Price offers a useful mix of delivery, ball-striking and passing variety. From the right side, he is capable of taking defenders down the line and whipping crosses into the box, while also having the range to play shorter combinations, longer switches and clipped passes into attacking areas. His right-footed delivery gives him set-piece value, with the ability to take corners, free kicks and penalties, which adds another route to chance creation. He also has a real shooting threat from distance, particularly from the edge of the box or just outside the area, and he looks comfortable striking through the ball when defenders drop off.

He is not just a crosser or runner, though; his passing range allows him to play through midfield as well, making him useful in both wide and central zones.

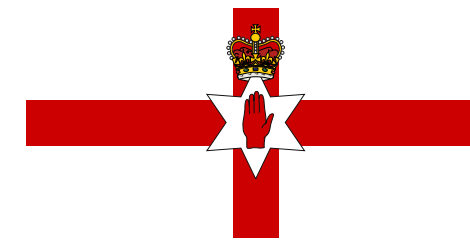

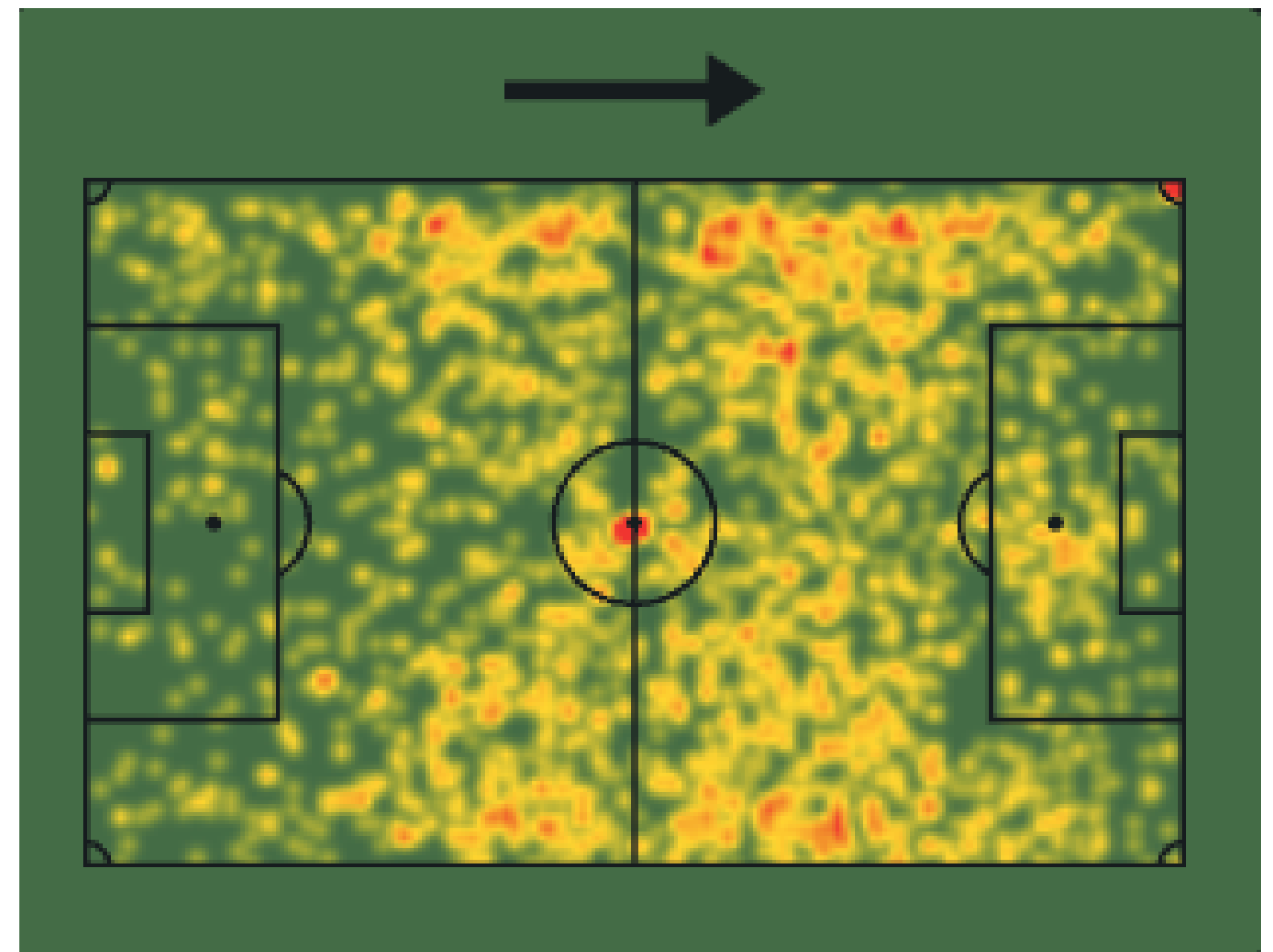

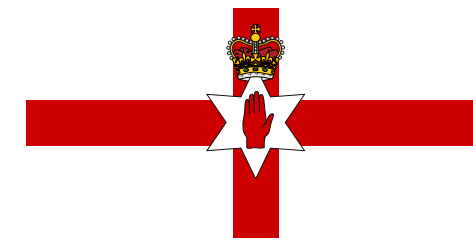
Tactical

Tactically, Isaac Price's value comes from his flexibility and his ability to impact different game states. As a wide midfielder, he can hold width, carry down the line and deliver into the box, but he can also move inside to connect play and create overloads in midfield. He is useful in transition because of his long stride, direct running and ability to carry the ball into space, but he also has tools against low blocks through crossing, switches of play, set-piece delivery and shots from range. Out of possession, his work rate is important: he tracks back, recovers into shape and is willing to put tackles in instead of being a passive wide player. He can be used as a wide midfielder or attacking midfielder depending on the team structure, which makes him tactically valuable across a long season.

Physical

Physically, Isaac Price has a tall and lanky body profile with long legs and a big stride, which helps him cover ground and carry the ball over distance. At around 1.88m, he naturally has more reach and aerial presence than many midfielders, so he can be a threat attacking the box or competing for loose balls. He also appears strong through contact, especially with his upper body, and that gives him an advantage in shoulder-to-shoulder duels and when protecting the ball. What stands out is that he does not look stiff for his size; he can shift the ball, change direction and move through midfield with decent craft. He is not necessarily an explosive winger profile, but he is powerful, rangy and mobile enough to be effective in wide and central midfield roles.

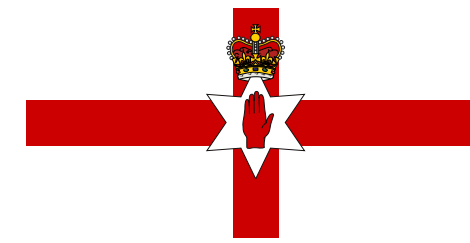

Mental

Mentally, Isaac Price comes across as a confident and proactive player. He is willing to take responsibility on the ball, whether that is delivering from set pieces, attempting crosses, shooting from distance or carrying forward in transition. His work rate also shows good application without the ball, as he is prepared to track runners and put in recovery tackles rather than only focusing on his attacking actions. There is a directness to his game that suggests he wants to affect matches, not just keep possession ticking. His versatility also points to a good tactical understanding, because he seems comfortable adapting his positioning depending on whether he is used wide or in a more advanced midfield role.

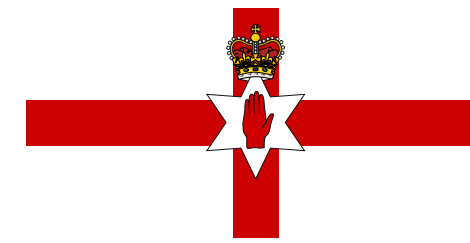

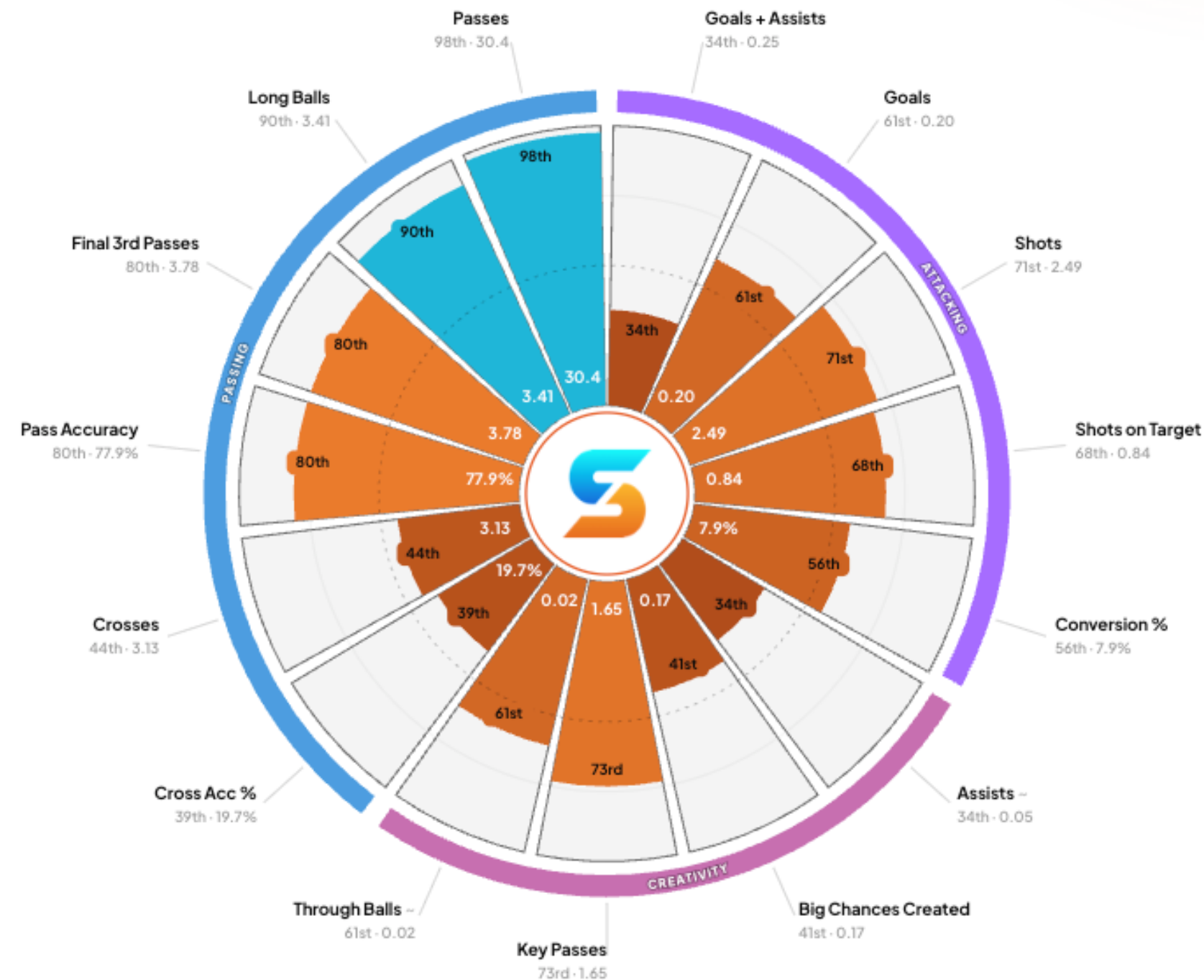

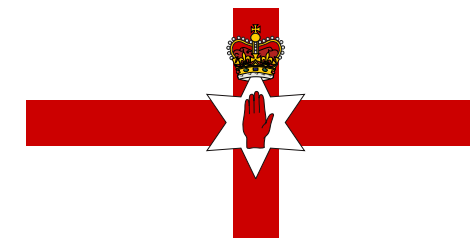


Pizza Chart (Attacking Metrics)

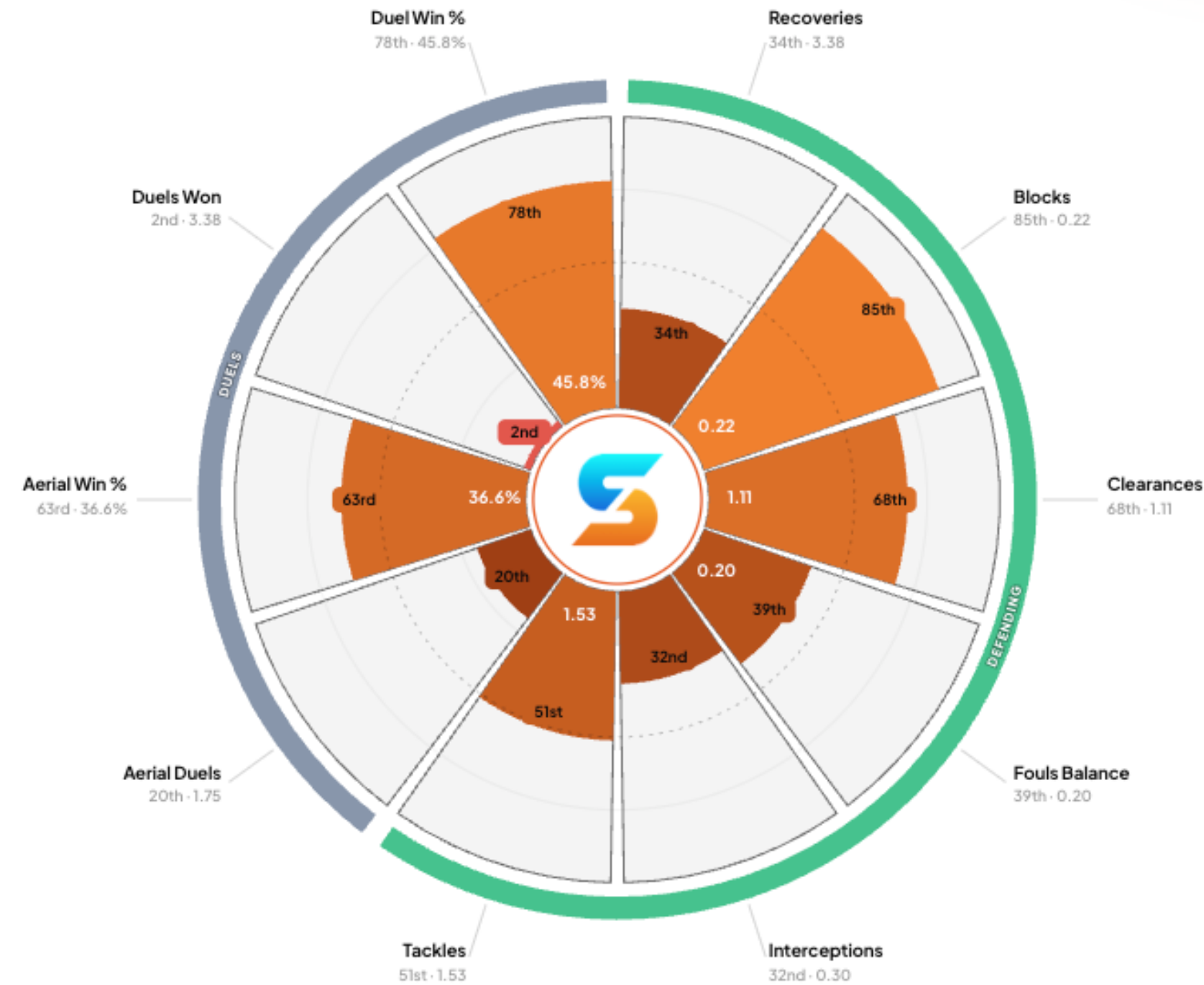


Compared to all U23 Wide Players from the Championship

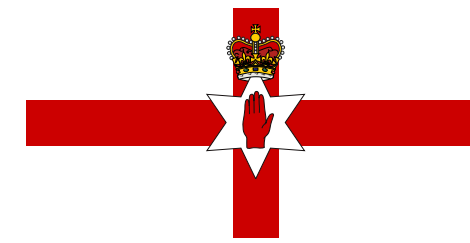


Pizza Chart (Defensive Metrics)

Conclusion

Isaac Price profiles as a versatile, attack-minded midfielder with strong physical tools, set-piece value and final-third output potential. His best qualities are his right-footed delivery, range of passing, ball-carrying over distance, shooting threat and ability to contribute from multiple midfield roles. He can be useful as a right midfielder in a more structured shape, but also has the skillset to play as an attacking midfielder who arrives around the box. The main question about his profile is whether he is best used wide, where his crossing and work rate stand out, or more centrally, where his ball-carrying and passing range can influence more phases. Overall, he is a high-upside midfield profile with size, technical variety and enough end-product threat to be a valuable attacking piece.
