Player Overview

Martin Baturina is a technically gifted attacking midfielder who likes to take responsibility in possession and stay heavily involved throughout attacks. He is most comfortable operating as a #10, but he can also play from wide areas and drift inside to get on the ball in central spaces. He plays with confidence in tight areas, showing clean control, good awareness and the ability to turn quickly when pressure arrives. Baturina regularly looks to combine with teammates, carry possession forward and find pockets between the lines where he can create. His movement is fluid, and he often drifts across the attacking line to stay connected to play and receive in dangerous positions. He has good creativity around the final third, sees forward runs early and is comfortable taking responsibility for the final pass. Overall, he profiles as an intelligent, technically strong and creative attacking midfielder with the quality to progress possession, connect attacks and create chances consistently.

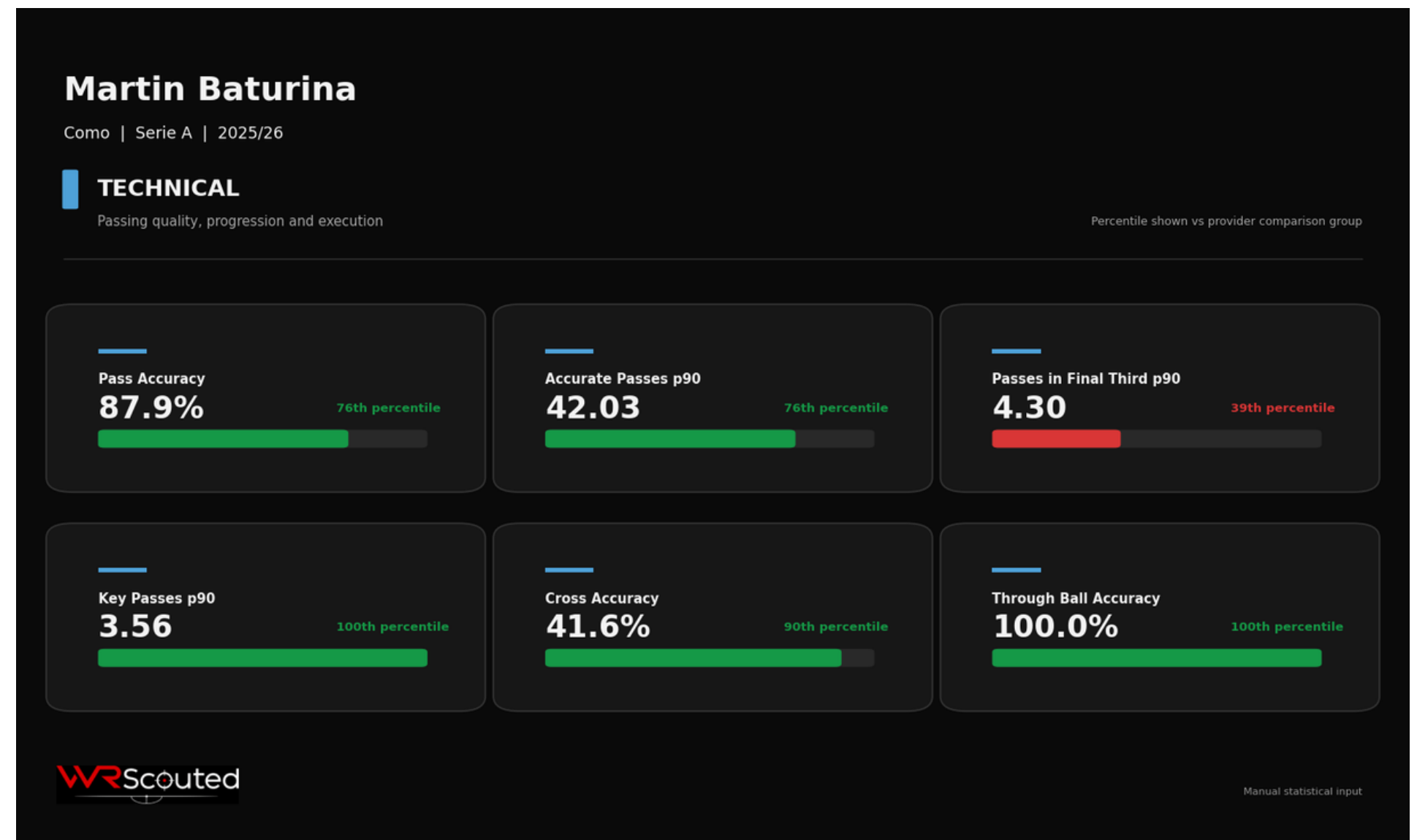


Technical

Technically, Baturina's strongest qualities are his close control, first touch and passing in advanced areas. He receives the ball cleanly in tight spaces and has the agility to adjust quickly when pressure arrives.

He is comfortable taking multiple touches in congested areas, manipulating the ball around opponents and using sharp changes of direction to create space. His passing has good variety, with quick combinations, disguised passes into runners and well-weighted balls through central areas. He also carries the ball confidently and can progress attacks by driving through midfield when space opens up.

Around the final third he shows creativity and imagination, regularly looking for combinations and passes into teammates making forward movements. His technical quality gives him the ability to influence possession across several different areas of the pitch.



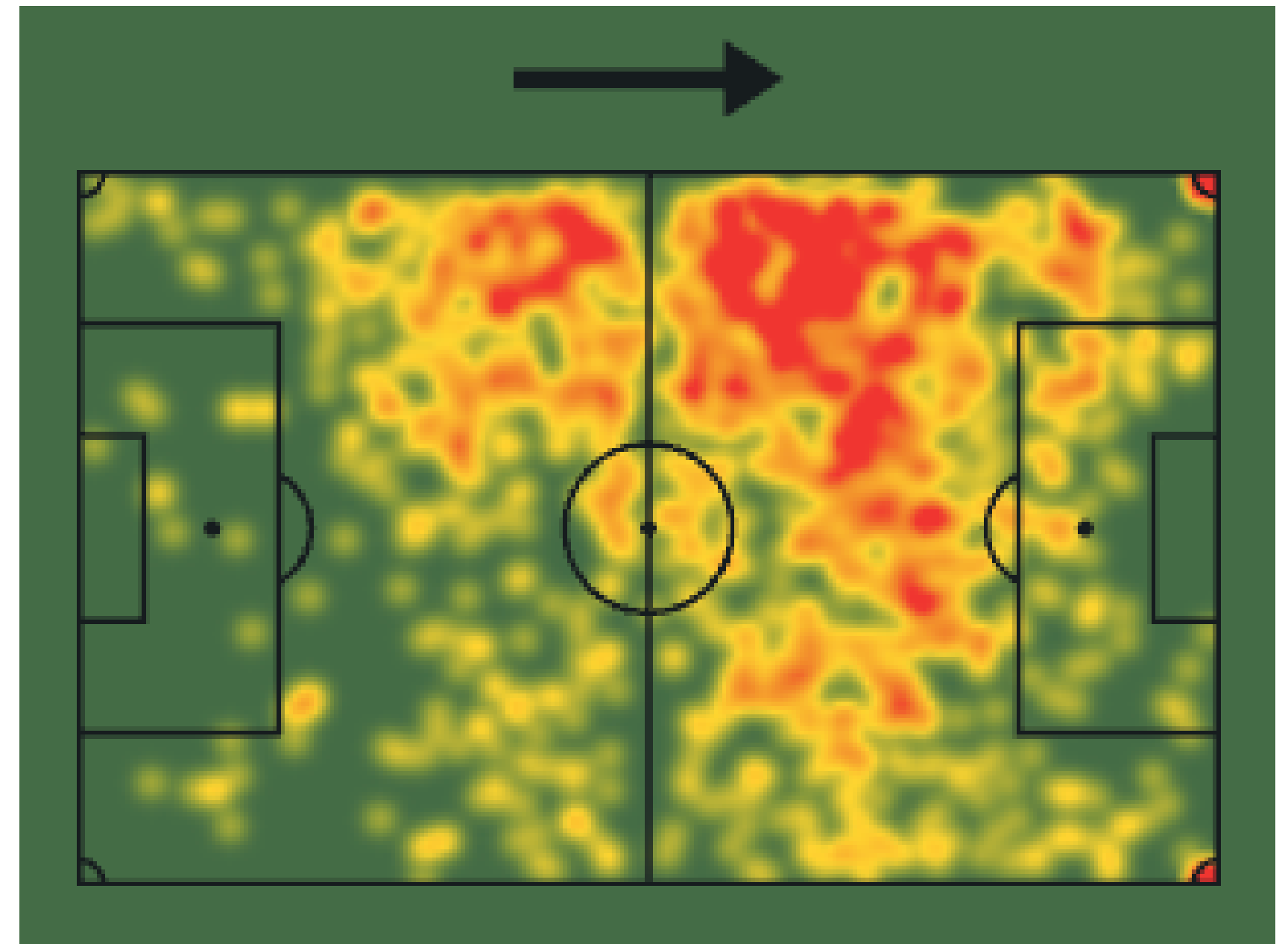

Tactical

Baturina moves constantly to stay involved and make himself available through different phases of possession. He frequently drops from an advanced position into midfield to receive, then pushes forward again once the ball moves higher up the pitch. He finds space between opposition midfielders well and often positions himself in the half-spaces where he can receive on the turn and attack the next line. His movement after passing is also strong, with Baturina regularly continuing forward to offer another option and become involved again later in the move. In the final third he drifts across central areas, combines with wide players and looks for space around the edge of the box. His movement and awareness allow him to connect build-up, progression and chance creation within the same attacking sequence.

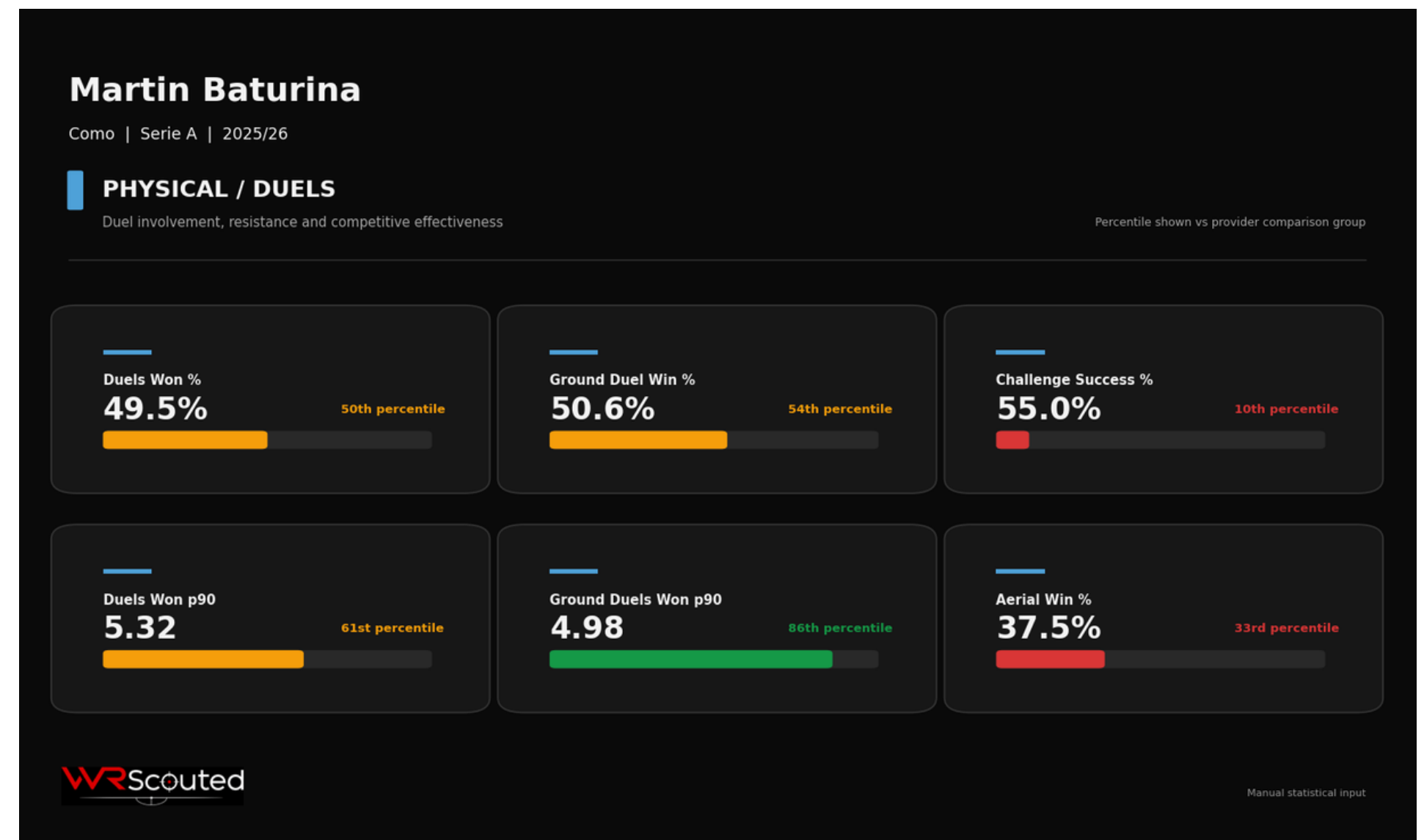

Physical

Physically, Baturina has a light, agile profile that suits his style of play. He moves sharply over short distances, changes direction quickly and stays well balanced when carrying the ball through crowded areas. His mobility helps him receive in different zones, escape pressure and stay connected to attacks as they move across the pitch. He competes willingly in ground duels and shows good intensity when stepping in to challenge or react after possession is lost. His frame can leave him vulnerable when stronger opponents are able to make clean contact with him, especially in tight areas where there is little room to move. Continued physical development would help him protect the ball more consistently and maintain his influence in more demanding midfield battles.

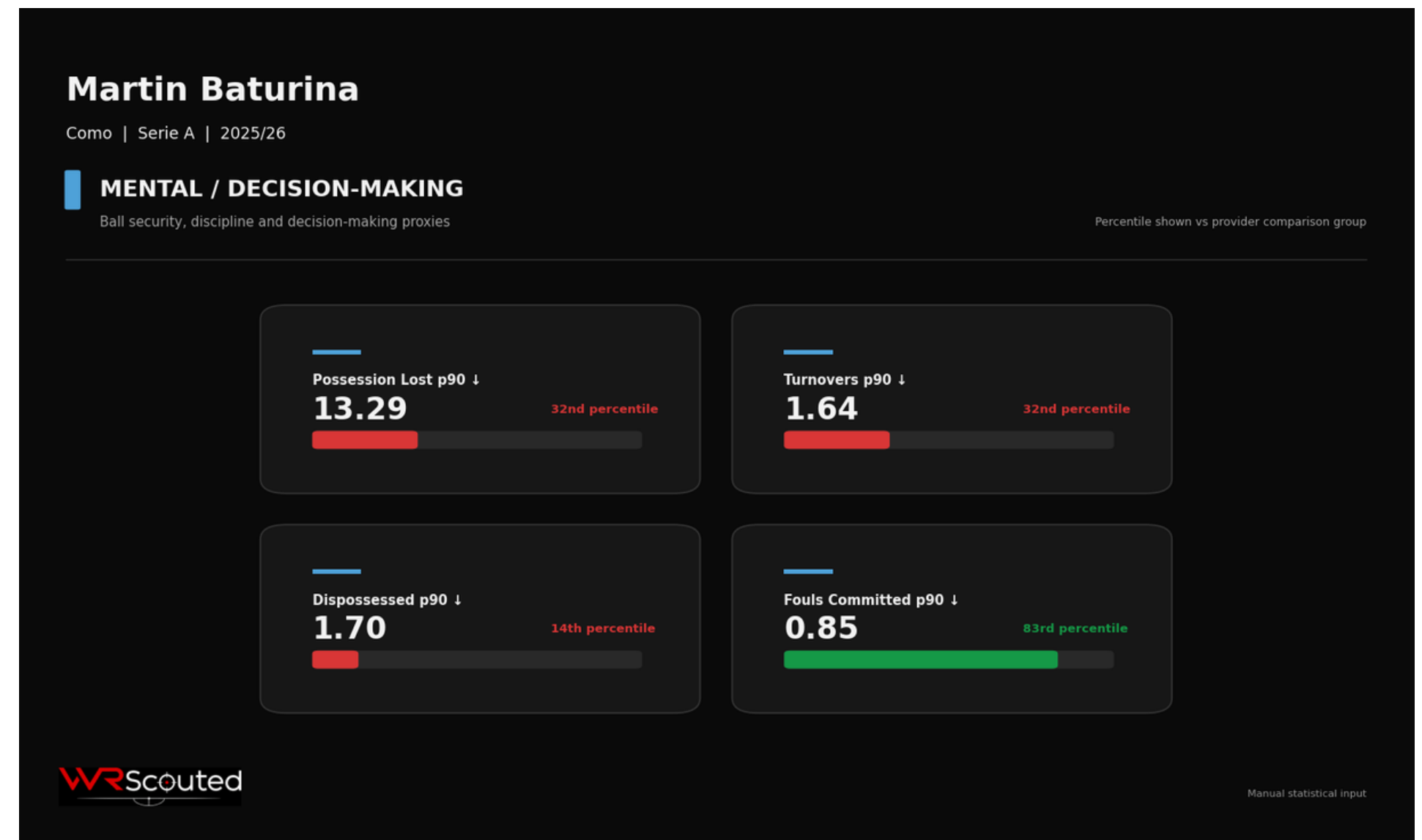

Mental

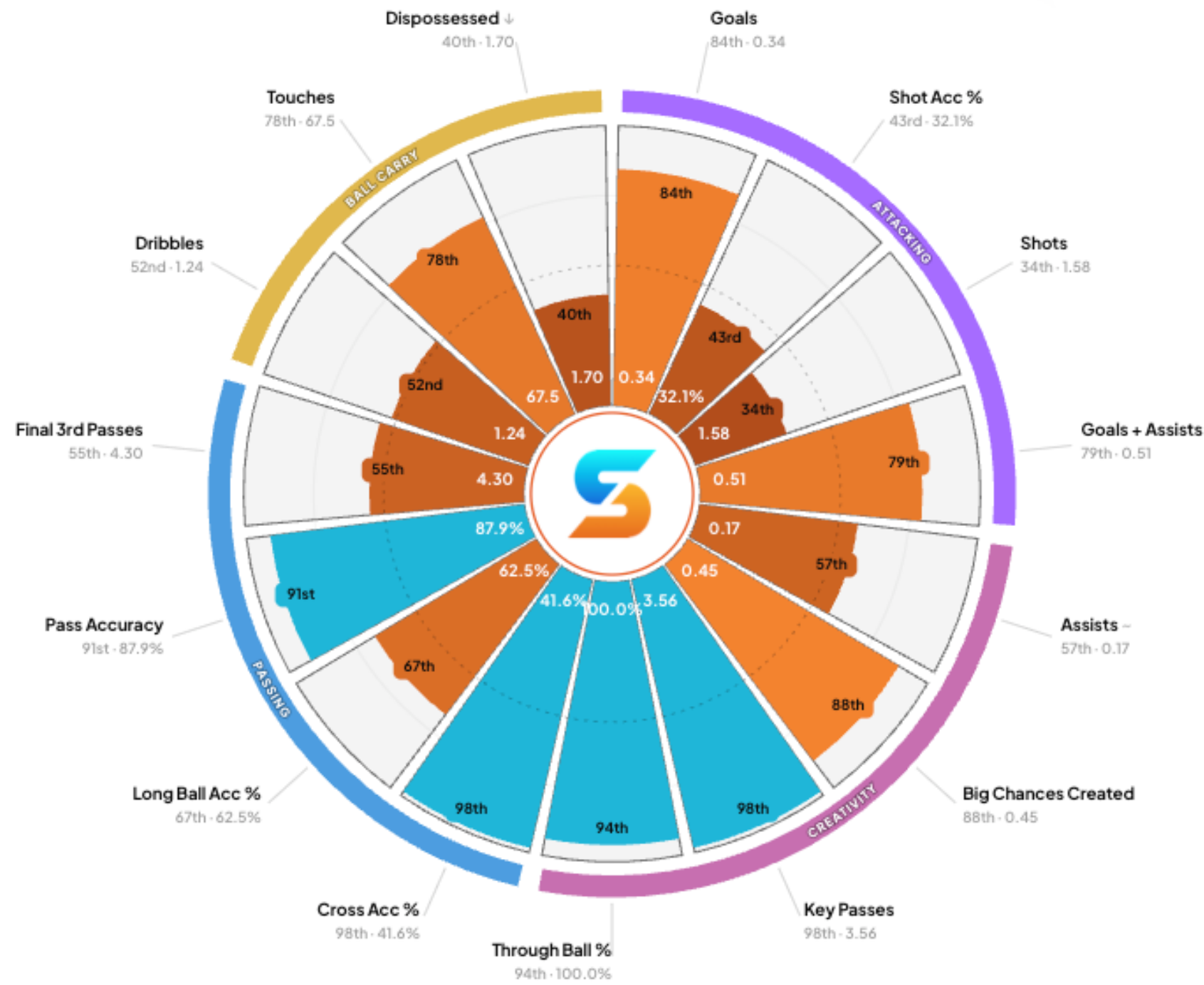
Mentally, Baturina plays with confidence and clearly wants responsibility in possession. He regularly shows for the ball in crowded areas and is comfortable receiving when pressure is close. His scanning is good, and he often checks his surroundings before the ball arrives, helping him recognize nearby pressure and available options. There is also a positive intent to his decision-making, with Baturina consistently looking for opportunities to progress the attack and involve teammates ahead of him. He is willing to attempt difficult passes and take responsibility in creative moments around the final third. The main area for development is knowing when to release possession earlier. He can occasionally stay on the ball for an extra touch while searching for an opening, which can slow attacks or allow pressure to close around him.

Pizza Chart (Attacking Metrics)

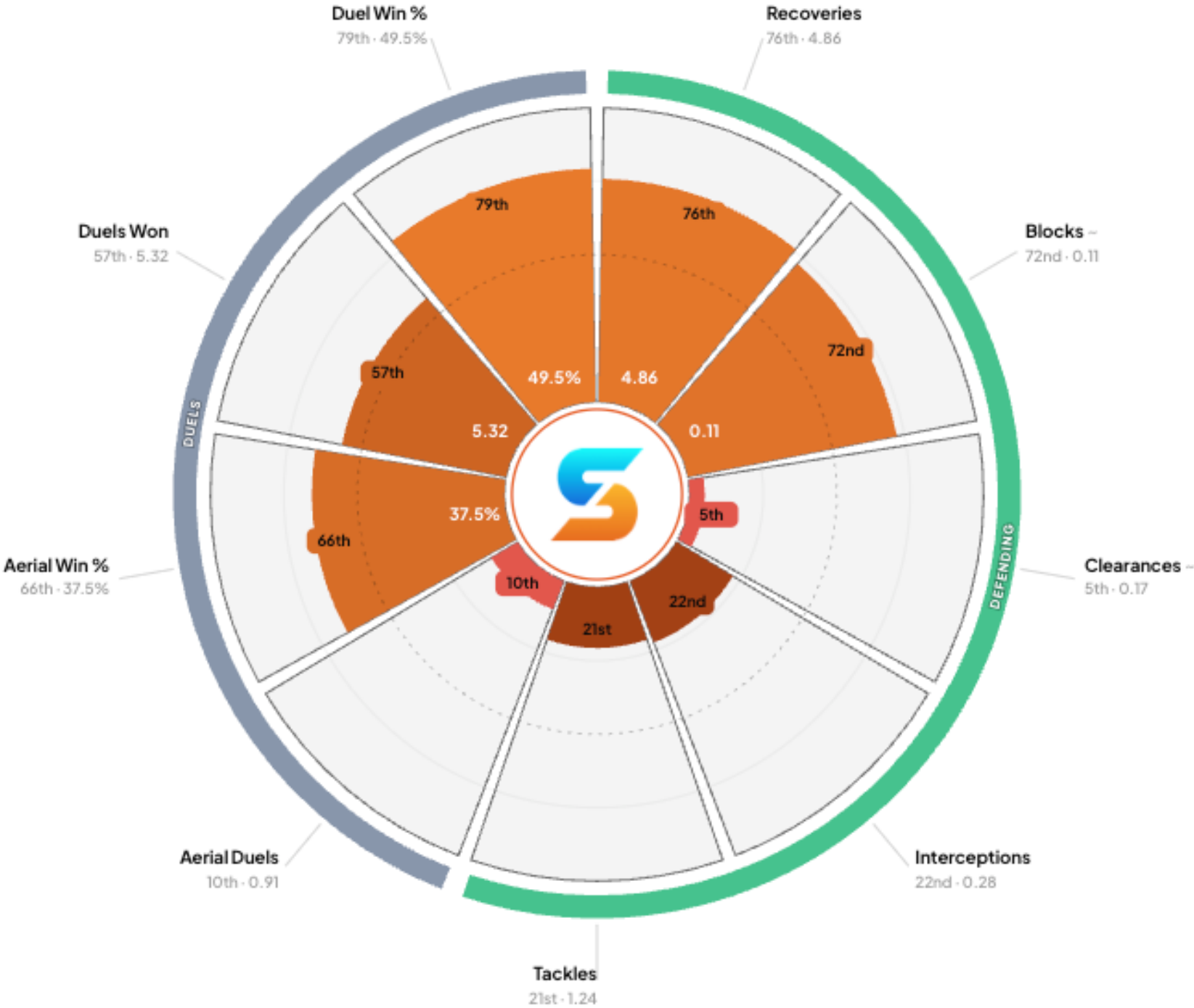


Compared to all U23 Attacking Midfielders from the Top 5 Leagues (2025/2026)

Conclusion

Baturina is a technically strong, creative midfielder whose game is built around receiving in tight spaces, progressing possession and creating from central areas. His first touch, close control and passing allow him to stay heavily involved through midfield, while his movement helps him find spaces between the lines and remain connected to attacks. He is comfortable playing as a #10 or out wide, and has the quality to contribute during build-up, progression and the final third. His confidence on the ball and willingness to take responsibility are major strengths, while his decision-making under pressure and physical consistency still have room to develop. Overall, he profiles as an intelligent, creative midfielder with the technical quality and awareness to become a high-level possession-progressing and chance-creating player.
