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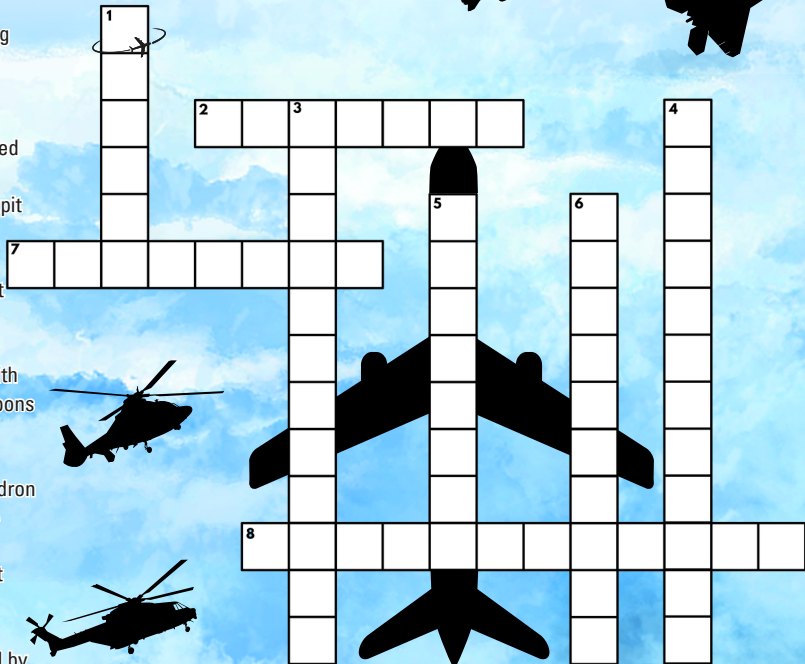

1. Provided basic flight training locally for pilots and was SADC's first flying aircraft
3. This jet fighter is an upgraded version of its original and features a unique dual-cockpit layout
4. An advanced jet trainer that has a unique side-by-side cockpit configuration and familiarised trainee pilots with air combat tactics and weapons delivery
5. This first operational squadron and first helicopter to fly the state flag during the 1970 National Day Parade Flypast
6. It can fly up to a maximum speed of Mach 2.7, powered by 2 ram jet motors and 4 booster rockets

2. This was the Singapore Armed Forces' (SAF) first remotely piloted vehicle (RPV). It has cameras that provide real-time coverage to detect enemy troops
7. This drone incorporated a Global Positioning System and was the first Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) in RSAF instead of being called a remotely piloted vehicle (RPV)
8. The first fighter jet of The Singapore Air Defence Command (SADC) received in 1970

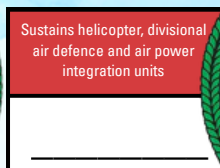
Squadrons 142 / 149 fly the F15 for the NDP Bomb Burst. Squadron 122 flies the C-130
