5 Best English to Estonian Translators That We Tried for Live Translation [Top Picks]

Are you facing trouble conversing in a meeting with your fellow Estonian work colleagues who are not fluent in English? JotMe can help you fix that! JotMe works as a live AI interpreter which translates English to Estonian in real-time while keeping the whole conversation contextually accurate.

JotMe works effortlessly in translating English to Estonian during meetings by providing accurate translations without missing out on the context of the conversation. JotMe has a wide translation support in 45 languages over the desktop and 77 languages through the Chrome extension for most video conferencing platforms. It also provides you with essential features such as real-time summaries and automatic post-meeting notes to boost the meeting's output and increase productivity.

It might be overwhelming for you to find an accurate AI translator that can translate from English to Estonian in real-time. So, we decided to scour the web and find the 5 best English to Estonian translators available out there. During our research we found that some apps missed out on the context of the conversation, while the others lagged and just couldn't keep up with the pace of the discussion. Mentioned below are few of the apps that handled English to Estonian translation with speed and accuracy:

- JotMe provides multilingual live translation in 77 languages in the Chrome extension and 45 languages on the desktop app. At just \$15/month, it offers you real-time live translation, post-meeting notes, Al ask and much more.
- <u>Translate.com</u> offers document and website translation support in 110 language pairs through human translation and 5,900 language pairs through machine translation.
- MerlinAl works as an Al assistant for research and translation. However, live translation is not present in MerlinAl.
- <u>Veed.io</u> is focused on video and subtitle generation with multilingual support in over 100+ languages. It offers AI translation but not in real-time.
- <u>Sider.ai</u> works as a browser extension and provides real-time translation in 50 languages. However, its pricing can be a bit too steep with its ultra plan priced at \$1600/year.

Quick Comparison of English to Estonian Live Translation Tools

Most of our best 5 English to Estonian live translation tools had an expansive library of Al tools. So we went through each of them keeping our focus on Al translators that can provide real-time

translation during video conferences which is contextually accurate. Here's a quick review of the capabilities of the best apps to live translate from English to Estonian:

Some other apps also provide English to Estonian translation functionalities, so let's delve deeper into each one.

During our testing, our key focus areas were speed and accuracy and JotMe ticked all the boxes. JotMe delivers contextually accurate English to Estonian live translation at groundbreaking speeds making our conversations easier with our Estonian colleagues. Other key features that make JotMe our standout option are:

- Simple Integration: JotMe integrates seamlessly with most video conferencing platforms like Meet, Teams, Discord, Webex etc. Just a simple click on the "Play" button in the JotMe app and the real-time translation starts to flow.
- Excellent Customer Support: Even though we didn't face any issues within the app, JotMe's customer support is extremely attentive at handling customers. No long waiting times or ticket chains, the customer support handled every query readily.
- Character Identification: JotMe excels at identifying characters during the meeting, ensuring that every live translation is communicated correctly. It focuses on assigning characters to each member of the meeting instead of providing live translation in a bulky paragraph format.

JotMe Key Features

JotMe offers a plethora of features on its platform but the ones that stood out for us were live contextual translation, Al Ask, real-time summary and sharing translation minutes. These features proved to be very useful in translating English to Estonian during our meetings. Let us tell you what exactly these features do:

Live Contextual Translation

JotMe works on a contextual translation engine which ensures the context of the conversation is never lost. Unlike traditional AI interpreters, JotMe functions on Natural Language Processing (NLP) and speech recognition which ensures what your client means is what you read. Be it

idioms, slangs or quips, JotMe handled all of it with ease. Let us tell you about an instance that showed us why JotMe could be our go-to Al interpreter:

Al Ask

In meetings with professionals of a technical background, technical jargon is definitely going to pop up during the conversation. During such conversations, JotMe's AI Ask feature comes to the rescue. All you need to do is simply input the term into the AI Ask option in the app and it will provide you a clear definition without interrupting your meeting or disturbing your workflow. For instance, in one of our recent meetings someone asked, "what is fission?" and JotMe explained how fission is the process of dividing the central part of an atom, when a large amount of energy is created.

Real-time Summary

Real-time summary stood out as one of the key features for us during our testing of JotMe. JotMe provided summaries during the meeting which ensured that the meeting flowed smoothly. For lengthy meetings, JotMe's real-time summary reduces wordy sentences into clear and concise actionable statements and helps you keep track of everything discussed in the meeting.

Sharing Translation Minutes

Not everyone needs to sit down with a copy and pen when you have JotMe's post-meeting translation minutes at your disposal. JotMe cuts out the noise and provides automatic post-meeting translation minutes in 13 different languages based on the transcript in bullet points. These minutes help the team stay aligned and remember the important agendas discussed during the meeting.

Pros

- JotMe provides real-time contextually accurate translation in several languages.
- JotMe works without any significant lag and is great at identifying the correct speakers.
- It provides a clear and concise Al post-meeting summary without any hassle or noise.

Cons

• JotMe is currently only available on the desktop as the mobile application is currently under development.

Pricing


JotMe offers a free plan that gives you 20 translation minutes along with access to all of its features. Two paid plans are also available. The details of the plans are as follows:

• Pro Plan (\$10/month, billed annually): This plan offers up to 200 live translation minutes, 500 transcription minutes and 20 Al credits.

 Premium Plan (\$15/month, billed annually): This plan offers 500 live translation minutes and 2000 transcription minutes. Plus, you get 50 Al credits and access to unlimited meeting recordings.



Among the options that our team went through, we came across <u>Translate.com</u>. <u>Translate.com</u> is an AI translation tool that focuses on translating and proofreading services. It helps you in reviewing documents through the help of machines, native speakers and domain experts. It supports 110 language pairs for human translation and 5,900 language pairs for machine translation. However, it does not provide live translation for meetings and webinars which can prove to be a hindrance if you're looking for a live English to Estonian translator.

Pricing



<u>Translate.com</u> offers a free "Pay as you go" plan that gives you a limit of translating 500 characters per month. Apart from that it offers three paid plans based on machine translation which you can check out:

- Starter lite plan costs \$4/month and gives you a limit of translating 30,000 characters per month with support for 5900+ language pairs.
- Starter plan costs \$6/month and offers you a 100,000 characters per month translation limit.
- Standard plan costs \$20/month and provides 400,000 characters per month translation limit. It also gives you access to translate files directly as a whole.

Pros

- Offers language support of 5900+ language pairs.
- Can translate multiple file formats such as .csv, .docx, .xlsx, .pdf, .json etc.

Cons

- Pricing structure can be confusing as it provides several services in packages as well as in separate plans.
- No live translation available for meetings and conferences.
- A user on Trustpilot says the delivery times are too long.

Review

A user on Trustpilot reported that the translations provided were not as promised and the promised delivery time was not fulfilled.







I needed a last minute translation and paid them the price advertised on the webpage. They failed to get it to me on time so I was unable to get the permit that I needed the translation for.


MerlinAl



MerlinAI is an AI assistant built upon popular AI models such as ChatGPT, Claude, DeepSeek etc. It works as a browser extension as well as a standalone app to provide multiple writing and image generation services such as AI translator, AI essay writer, logo generator etc. MerlinAI's browser extension works in summarizing and translating websites through AI. However, it does not have live audio translation and real-time summarizing capabilities like JotMe required for live

English to Estonian translation. It can only translate text inputs through its AI translator in the app in 130 languages.

Pricing



MerlinAl offers one free plan and two paid plans for individual users offering different Al tools in each. Their details are:

- Free Plan Limited access to basic and plus-level models, 70+ Al tools and Chrome extension.
- Pro Plan Billed at \$108 annually, this plan offers unlimited access to all the models, Al tools and Chrome extension along with advanced image generation.
- Teams Plan Billed at \$180 annually per team member, this plan allows access to up to 5 team members with all the Pro plan features.

Pros

- Offers 70+ Al tools for writing and image generation purposes.
- Support over 130 languages in Al translation.

Cons

- Does not have live translation capabilities required for meetings, videos and webinars.
- MerlinAl does not offer live Al transcription for audios and videos.
- One user on Trustpilot reported that the customer care is not helpful in resolving queries.

Review

A user on Trustpilot said that the customer care does not handle queries well and the MerlinAl support system is buggy.




Veed.io



If you want to cater to an Estonian audience through audios and videos, <u>Veed.io</u> could be an option for you. <u>Veed.io</u> is designed for creators who wish to create content in multilingual

formats. The platform supports audio and video translation in 100+ languages. The app also offers subtitle generation, voice cloning and Al voice dubbing features, ideal for creators. With its Al powered editing and translation capabilities, Veed.io can provide translation and Al transcription only for pre-recorded audios and videos. However, meetings and webinars are not supported on the platform as it does not offer live-translation or real-time summary.

Pricing



<u>Veed.io</u> does not have a free plan for trial basis. It offers two paid plans:

- Lite Plan Billed at \$66.5 annually, the lite plan offers unlimited video generation with export quality up to full HD 1080p. However, this plan does not offer AI translation tools.
- Pro Plan Billed at \$159.3 annually, the pro plan offers all the lite plan features along with translation, subtitle generation and 144 hours/year text to speech generation.

Pros

- Supports translation of pre-recorded audio and videos in 100+ languages.
- Provides high-quality video generation services and editing tools.

Cons

- Does not support live AI translation required for meetings and live events.
- Not ideal for business professionals looking for an AI interpreter to converse with cross-border clients or partners.
- One user on Trustpilot said, "The interface is confusing, buttons shown in tutorials don't exist, and simple functions (like turning subtitles on/off) don't work."

Review

A user on Trustpilot pointed out that the platform does not work as advertised and you have to pay the complete annual fees without trial.






Not Fit for Purpose - Glitchy Software, Forced Annual Payments, and Zero Customer Support

What happened


- You have to pay for a full year upfront just to test basic features. No monthly plan, no trial.
- To access more tools, I had to upgrade again also only available as an annual plan.
- Within two hours, it became clear the software simply doesn't work as advertised.

Sider.ai



If you are looking for an English to Estonian AI interpreter that can provide real-time translation during meetings, <u>Sider</u> ai could be a good option for you. It works as a browser extension that interprets audio during meetings and provides you with live translation in 50 languages. During cross-border meetings with clients who are not fluent in English, <u>Sider.ai</u> opens up as a sidebar translating the meeting on the go. It can provide multilingual support but does not handle conversations with idioms or slangs well like JotMe. It might lose out on the context and force

you to ask your Estonian clients or partners to repeat what they said. We found that <u>Sider.Ai</u> also lags a bit in fast-paced discussions which is not ideal when hosting meetings with a larger number of members.



<u>Sider.ai</u> offers three plans, all of which are paid, which offer different amounts of basic and advanced credits for using different AI functions on the platform. The plans offered are:

- Basic Plan Billed annually at \$99/year, this plan offers 3,600 basic credits/month, 200 advanced credits/month and 80 elite credits/month with login access to 4 devices.
- Plus Plan Billed annually at \$299/year, this plan offers unlimited basic credits per month, 1,500 unrestricted advance credits per month and 250 elite credits per month with login access to 8 devices.
- Ultra Plan Billed annually at \$1,600/year, this plan offers unlimited basic credits per month, 10,000 unrestricted advance credits per month and 2500 elite credits per month with login access to 8 devices.

Pros

- Offers real-time audio translation suitable for English to Estonian translation during meetings.
- <u>Sider.ai</u> provides summaries and transcripts for recorded translated audios, useful for extracting key insights.

Cons

- The credit usage comes with terms and conditions, which might limit functionality even after buying the Plus and Ultra plans.
- Does not offer automatic post-meeting minutes like JotMe.

 One user on Trustpilot said, "You have a Unlimited account But That's not True. Since paying US\$300 in March 2025 I have paid NZ\$200 for more credit as my unlimited account went over it's limited and I only had 1500 credits left on my so called unlimited account."

Review

A user on Trustpilot pointed out the company isn't transparent with their claims of unlimited credits as they had to buy more credits even after having an unlimited account.

A day later I had to buy more credit NZ\$150 as the AI web creator keeps playing like pretending to create when it is not real the AI builds a fake website that is missing things & just a landing page. 
Step 1: How to Set Up JotMe?


