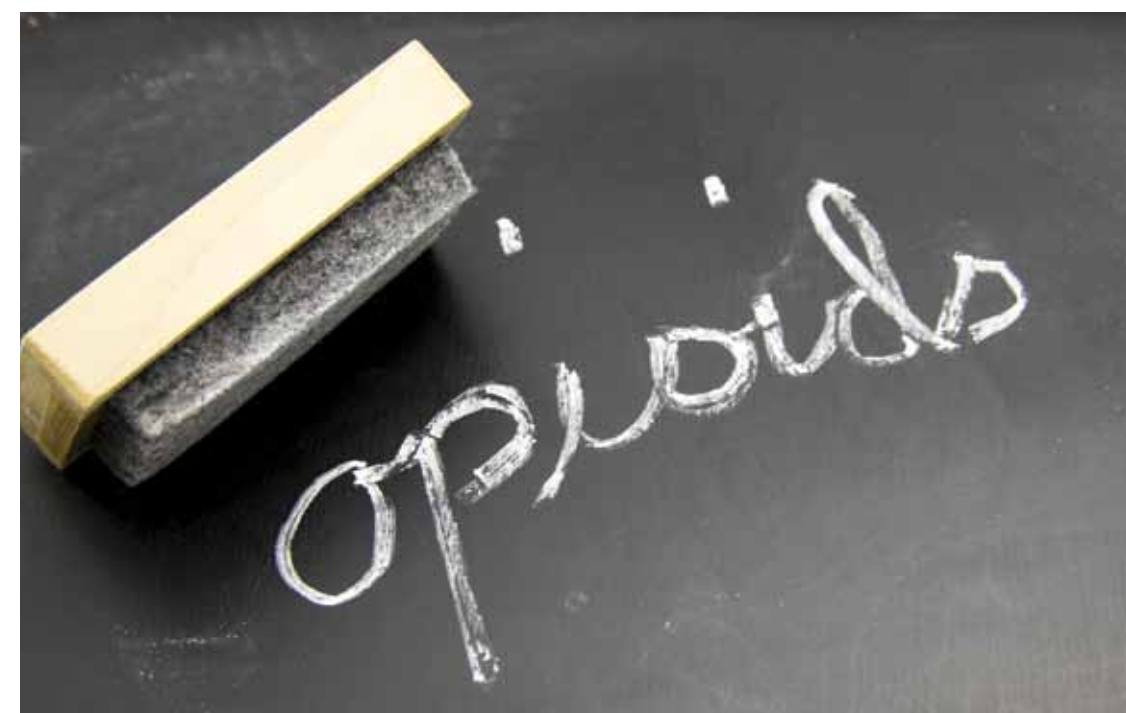

**Opioids have been making headlines nationwide. The United States is in the midst of a 50 state epidemic and Florida is among the hardest hit. According to the Center for Disease Control and Prevention, overdose rates went up by 22.7 percent between 2014 and 2015 in Florida and it's only getting worse.**

## Escambia County's Growing Opioid Crisis

In 2015, there were 3,228 deaths by drug overdose in Florida, according to the CDC. Of those, 2,538 deaths were caused by opioids alone. Additionally, opioids were found to have contributed in some way to another 1,358 fatalities.

This May, Governor Rick Scott declared the opioid epidemic a statewide public health emergency and signed an executive order that will allow Florida to accept a federal grant of \$54 million dollars over the next two years. These funds will go towards treatment and recovery efforts throughout the state. Treatment centers, like Lakeview Center which received \$700,000 from this grant, will put the money towards operations and programs such as STOP: the State Targeted Opioid Program which provides free treatment to addicts, to help boost recovery efforts. Of the total grant money, \$17 million will be allocated to the direct care of clients with medication assisted treatment. An additional \$10 million will be spread out among care coordination, for medications such as Vivitrol and Narcan, outreach into rural communities and prevention in schools.

Additionally, first responders will have greater access to medications, such as Narcan, which are used to resuscitate individuals who are overdosing.

Opioids are a class of drugs that include prescription pain relievers such as OxyContin, Vicodin, codeine, and morphine, but also include illegal drugs such as heroin and opioid synthetics such as fentanyl. Prescription opioids are generally safe when taken as prescribed by a doctor and are usually only taken for a very short time period due to their highly addictive nature. Along with pain relief, opioids produce a feeling of euphoria, which is usually the catalyst that leads to addiction.

Addicts can struggle for many years to reach sobriety and relapse is always a danger due to the insidious nature of opioid addiction. Even after 17 months clean, 36-year-old Pensacola resident Ryan Forbes remembers his first hit.

"I was given my first Lortab in 2003 by a coworker. I remember right where I was. It just took my soul. It was this feeling of energy and being pain-free. That feeling

was just awesome. It numbed any emotional weakness," Forbes says. "It was this all-in-one pill I could take at work. It gave me a buzz, it was perfectly legal, and it numbed all of my physical and emotional pain. It was this false cure for life that I thought I'd found."

This single encounter set off a 12-year battle with addiction. At the time, prescription opioids were not as heavily regulated as they are now. Forbes notes that doctor shopping was much easier then because these pills were everywhere and they were culturally accepted. Prescription painkillers did not carry the same stigma as any other illicit drugs, so they flew under the radar for a brief time.

"When you're getting it from a smart man in a white coat with a nametag that says doctor, you don't question it. How can this be bad? How could this be as addictive as the drugs we were getting off the street?" Forbes says.

But the price of opioid addiction is very steep. It isn't only about obtaining a high. Users very quickly develop a tolerance for opioids and increase their doses exponentially, or else they succumb to the devastatingly crippling effects of withdrawal.

"The addiction is very severe. There are a few medications where withdrawal is deadly and opiates fall into that category," says Dustin Perry, director of STOP at Lakeview Center. "You start to have an upset stomach, diarrhea, sweats, insomnia, hot and cold flashes. You feel absolutely miserable, so the best way to fix it is to take the drug again."

Both Perry and Forbes describe withdrawal symptoms as "the flu times one hundred."

Last year, Lakeview Center treated approximately 3,000 patients for opioid addiction. Of those, Lakeview treated 1,091 patients with methadone and another 269 with Suboxone. Perry says while Escambia County tracks closely to national numbers in terms of overdoses, we are nowhere near the numbers in south Florida, where the opioid crisis has hit critical mass.

Still, the opioid crisis has challenges uniquely its own. For one thing, opioid addiction has no target demographic. It is universal, afflicting people of all ages and economic status. One of the biggest

barriers locally is transportation. With our community spread out as it is, getting to treatment centers is a particular challenge for recovering addicts. Perry notes that those who live in Cantonment, Pace, or Century may have a harder time getting to their appointments in downtown Pensacola.

This is to say nothing of the fresh challenges law enforcement is facing. Sgt. Martez Lawrence, Supervisor of Narcotics for the Pensacola Police Department, has been on the front lines of the opioid crisis as it has unfolded in Escambia County over the last eight years. A 16-year veteran of the force, he first noted the spike in heroin cases in 2009 when he was still working as a detective. When the pill mills in south Florida shut down, heroin hit the streets with a vengeance. Now, he says, opioid investigations make up at least 50 percent of their case load. And it goes beyond heroin and prescription drugs. As the laws targeting illegal substances become more explicit, dealers and users are devising smarter ways to distribute and consume their products.

"At this point, they are coming up with different ways to distribute these drugs. We were finding Xanax that were actually Fentanyl. They were taking Fentanyl and snapping them into a Xanax pill press. We've seen where they're mixing the Fentanyl with nasal spray mix, putting it in a bottle, shaking it up and getting high that way," Lawrence says. "So not only is it an issue because they are disguising it from law enforcement and it's harder to see, but accidental exposure to it can be dangerous to law enforcement as well, so we are having to take extra precautions when it comes to how we operate now."

All of the officers in the narcotics division operate on a buddy system. Every individual is responsible for one other colleague and stays vigilant to any signs of exposure, addiction, or any other unusual behaviors. This method affords Lawrence's team an added safeguard against accidental exposure, which is a much more present danger these days.

"Some of this stuff can be absorbed through skin contact. Now what they are starting to do is mix drugs. Fentanyl seems to be the biggest one they are mixing into

other drugs. So, we may come across something that we would normally think is Spice – which isn't harmful unless it's ingested—but now has a mix of Fentanyl which can be dangerous just upon skin contact," Lawrence says.

Because exposure to these substances is so very harmful, officers are required to carry masks, gloves, and test kits. But it doesn't end there; the very nature of the job is changing. Police work has always rigidly adhered to the letter of the law, but the opioid crisis has forced a more nuanced approach.

"As law enforcement, our direction is always find the bad guy, charge them, put them in jail and the job is done. That is no longer the case anymore. It's looking at it on a case by case basis. It's the question of what is it that needs to be done to get this person reha-

bilitated so he doesn't go back out there and offend, utilizing these same drugs," Lawrence says. "Is this guy only a dealer or is he also a user? Usually, if they are users we try to cure that problem. Just putting them in jail doesn't solve the problem, so we are having to change how we look at that aspect of the opioid crisis."

While most of Lawrence's cases are localized, he has seen outside influence in Escambia county as well. Just recently PPD made an arrest in a case involving opioid shipments coming from China in a trade that was negotiated via internet. Cases like these become more complicated due to matters of jurisdiction and require the involvement of federal agencies, such as the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives and Drug Enforcement Agency, with which Lawrence says their department works very closely.

Recently an Opioid Community Action Planning meeting was held, bringing together representatives from first response teams, treatment centers, hospitals, and law enforcement to discuss how to address the opioid crisis in Escambia County. Forbes, Perry and Lawrence were in attendance. In summary, a collaborative effort is being made between these agencies

in order to properly address this multi-faceted and complex problem. This approach has already shown to have greater success over former campaigns.

Forbes, who after an incredibly transformative and deeply personal religious experience sought treatment from Lakeview Center, has nothing but good to say about the steps Escambia County is taking towards healing its community. For Forbes, finding Jesus was the pivotal first step in his healing process. Now he devotes his life entirely to helping others find their own way. In his opinion, the key to why this collaboration works is that it targets the real problem with addiction and removes the isolation it brings.

"Most of us self-medicate because we don't know how to deal with the emotions life throws at us. Not having my dad around made me pissed off for a long time. It gave me this 'I'll show you! I can do it myself attitude.' That fuels addiction. There are a lot of reasons why people self-medicate," Forbes says. "I guarantee you there is somebody that you know that is addicted. I want people to know it's okay. It may not even be your fault. You might have just gotten hurt and trusted your doctor, then got addicted. Let's work through this. You're not alone. You are not alone."

Escambia County officials and law enforcement continue to work tirelessly with first response teams and counseling services to stop the spread of this opioid epidemic in our community. Through the collaborative efforts of these agencies, Escambia County should see fewer instances of overdose and drug trafficking, but more importantly, those who suffer from addiction can receive proper treatment at little to no cost, essentially cutting this epidemic off at its roots.

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

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## National Philanthropy Day Award Nominations Are Open

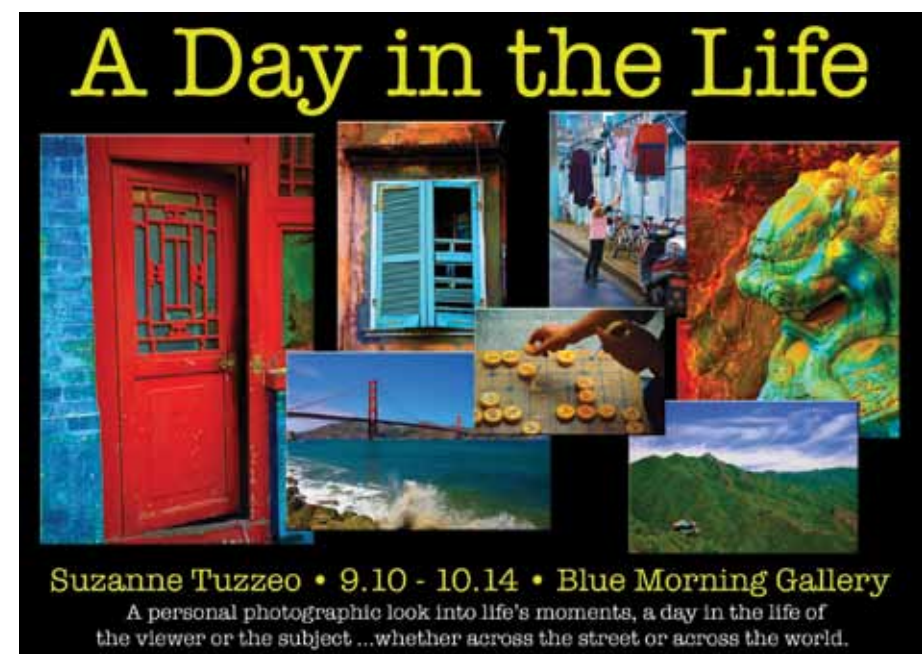

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## IRMA COULD COST 'BILLIONS UPON BILLIONS'

Local curfews were in place throughout the state, much of the Florida Keys remained closed and millions of people continued to lack electricity as cleanup work expected to reach into the billions of dollars began Monday in the wake of deadly Hurricane Irma.

While businesses slowly reopen, the state is dealing with widespread flooding, from storm surges of 4 to 8 feet along both coasts to flash flooding in Northeast Florida.

Gov. Rick Scott, who flew over hard-hit areas Monday, said damage along the Southwest coast, where Irma made a second landfall Sunday, included roofs off homes, boats tossed, flooding and sand across roads. But overall, he said the conditions appeared "not as bad as we thought the storm surge would do."

However, he depicted the destruction in the Keys, which experienced the first landfall, as "horrible."

"There is devastation, and I just hope everybody survived," Scott said during an afternoon press conference at the U.S. Coast Guard Air Station Miami in Opa-locka.

Scott viewed the damage while flying on a U.S. Coast Guard C-130 plane Monday morning.

"I know for our entire state, but especially the Keys, it's going to be a long road. There is a lot of damage," Scott said. "I know everyone wants to get back to normal. I know everyone wants to get started, but you've got to be patient. We've got to get the first responders to the Keys. We've got to get water going again. We've got to get electricity going again. We've got to get sewers going again. It's going to take a lot of time."

At least four deaths have been tied to the storm, including a Hardee County sheriff's deputy and a Florida Department of Corrections officer, who were involved in a car crash.

Scott declined to speculate on the potential for additional loss of life from the storm. He traveled across the state during the past week warning Floridians to evacuate from vulnerable areas, as Irma cut a deadly path through the Caribbean as a massive Category 5 storm with maximum sustained winds reaching 185 mph.

"I don't want anybody to die, so I hoped everybody listened to what we were talking about. We'll find out over time if people did or not," Scott said. "You know the days run together, but I remember the morning when the hurricane was hitting, the roads

were empty. So I think people did leave their homes and got off the roads."

Scott also declined to speculate on the potential costs of the storm, saying the numbers will first be compiled by individual counties.

In requesting federal disaster relief Sunday, Scott said the state had already spent \$75 million on Irma. President Donald Trump later approved the request.

Congressman Carlos Curbelo, a Republican whose district includes all of Monroe County and parts of southwest Miami-Dade, said it will cost "billions upon billions upon billions of dollars" to restore the Keys and South Florida.

Congresswoman Ileana Ros-Lehtinen, a Republican from Miami-Dade County, vowed to push federal lawmakers to provide funding for the relief efforts.

"We found it for Hurricane Harvey, we're going to band together and find it for the residents who are survivors of Hurricane Irma," Ros-Lehtinen said.

An initial estimate from Moody's Analytics on Monday projected property destruction from Irma between \$64 billion and \$92 billion.

The storm, combined with Hurricane Harvey's impact on Texas, could cause a further \$20 billion to \$30 billion hit to the nation's economic output, lowering the third quarter gross domestic product estimate to 2.5 percent from 3 percent, according to Moody's Analytics.

For Florida, the impacts will depend on demands placed on insurance companies and the levels of needed government funding, as well as how quickly Florida's tourism industry can rebound. Also, Moody's added that the fourth-quarter numbers could be boosted because of reconstruction from both storms.

State Senate Banking and Insurance Chairwoman Anitere Flores, a Miami Republican whose district also covers the Keys, said the state has to make sure state-backed Citizens Property Insurance Corp. has the funds to cover individual property-insurance claims, particularly from the Keys.

"We feel that because this storm was not as bad as it could have been, that Citizens will not have to go into actual assessment mode, and to assess people who are not Citizens property holders," Flores said. "Citizens' reserves are approximately \$9 billion. So the question that we have to figure out in the next couple of days is of that, how many Citizens property holders were at a total loss."

House Speaker Richard Corcoran, R-Land O' Lakes, has raised the possibility of a post-storm

special session "should any recovery efforts require legislative authorization."

As of Monday afternoon, 6.7 million homes and businesses were without power across Florida, according to the State Emergency Response Team.

Florida Power & Light, the largest utility in the state, reported 3.5 million of its 5 million customer accounts were out.

St. Petersburg-based Duke Energy, with about 1.8 million customer accounts, was working to restore power to nearly 1.3 million customers.

Tampa Electric reported more than 300,000 accounts had been knocked offline.

More than 820,000 were without power in Miami-Dade County, 600,000 in Broward and 530,000 in Palm Beach County.

Nearly 430,000 homes and businesses were out in Pinellas County. More than 300,000 were out in both Orange and Lee counties. Collier, Duval, Brevard, Hillsborough, Pinellas and Volusia each had more than 200,000 homes and businesses in the dark.

FPL President and Chief Executive Officer Eric Silagy estimated Monday that up to 9 million people served by his company, 90 percent of its customers, have been impacted.

While up to 1 million accounts have been restored, some customers in harder hit areas may have to wait weeks for full restoration, Silagy said.

"We've actually had over 5 million outages across our territory," Silagy said during a morning press conference. "That, frankly, is unprecedented. We've never had that many outages. I don't think any utility in the country ever has. It is by far the largest in the history of our company."

Meanwhile, all 7,935 members of the Florida Army and Air National Guard have been deployed, conducting search and rescue, law-enforcement support and humanitarian assistance.

The aircraft carrier USS Abraham Lincoln and two amphibious ships, the USS Iwo Jima and USS New York, have been deployed to assist the state in search and rescue operations.

More than 200,000 people remained Monday afternoon in 585 shelters opened throughout the state.

The Florida Highway Patrol has started escorting utility convoys into areas without power, and Scott said the state law enforcement officers will do the same when the Port Tampa and Port Canaveral reopen and fuel trucks begin to travel.

## UCF, FIU GROWTH RAISES QUESTION: HOW BIG IS TOO BIG?

Florida has some of the largest public universities in the country.

When more than 350,000 students started the new academic year in August at the 12 state universities, one out of every three students were enrolled at the University of Central Florida in Orlando or Florida International University in Miami.

UCF, where officials project a total of enrollment in the range of 66,000 students this year, trails only Arizona State University, which claimed an enrollment of about 72,000 students last fall.

Florida International officials estimate they will have about 56,000 students on campus this year.

Both schools have grown significantly over the past decade. From the fall of 2006 to last fall, UCF's enrollment grew by 37 percent, while FIU's enrollment grew by 43 percent, according to state data.

A frequent topic of discussion for the state university system's Board of Governors is: "How big is too big?"

The debate re-emerged last month as the board developed its budget request for the 2018-2019 academic year during a meeting at the University of Florida in Gainesville.

"We have changed the model in that you don't get paid so much anymore for growth as you do for excellence," said Norman Tripp, a Fort Lauderdale lawyer who serves on the Board of Governors. "I really feel as a system we need to understand better what growth should be throughout the system."

Tom Kuntz, an Orlando banker who serves as chairman of the Board of Governors, said he wants to continue the discussion about growth when the

board meets again in November.

"I personally think the most important thing is the quality," Kuntz said. "The number of students at any particular university should not be the measure of success. I don't think the goal should be to be the biggest or the smallest. It should be to be the best."

Kuntz said another factor in university enrollment growth is linked to the board's efforts to increase the number of students who are graduating at a faster rate. Increasing the four-year graduation rate for undergraduates "frees up capacity for more students," Kuntz said.

FIU and UCF leaders said they are expanding their enrollment to meet the demands for a more highly educated workforce in two of Florida's major metropolitan areas, while improving the quality of their schools.

Both schools are at the top of the 12 state universities in producing baccalaureate degrees annually, with UCF leading the system with 12,832 four-year degrees awarded in 2015-2016 and FIU with 9,100 degrees.

John Hitt, president of UCF, noted his school has twice finished at the top of the annual performance rankings for the system, which ties funding to metrics like graduation rates and job placement.

"When the quality of our program starts to suffer because we have gotten too big, we will cut back," Hitt told the Board of Governors. "I would just say look at the results of our performance versus the metrics."

Under a work plan approved by the board, UCF is projected to grow to 68,730 students by 2020. At the same time, UCF officials project they will meet enough performance metrics to be classified as a "pre-eminent" state university by 2021.

At FIU, President Mark Rosenberg said his school's growth is linked to

serving a region that includes Florida's largest county, Miami-Dade, with 2.9 million residents.

"It's not about size. It's about access for eligible students," Rosenberg said in an interview. "A college degree is still the path to the middle class. It's a path to full employment."

FIU's latest work plan projects its enrollment to reach 58,351 students by 2020.

Minority students make up an overwhelming majority of FIU's enrollment, with 67 percent of students identified as Hispanics and 12 percent as African Americans, according to the National Center for Education Statistics.

UCF's enrollment reflects 25 percent of students identified as Hispanics and 11 percent as African-Americans, the federal data shows.

"We are the shape of things to come in this country demographically at FIU," Rosenberg said. "We are not going to turn our backs on eligible students in our community."

Both schools serve large numbers of students who come from lower-income households that qualify for federal Pell grants. About 51 percent of FIU's students receive Pell grants, along with 40 percent of UCF's students.

A result of the enrollments at UCF and FIU is the largest average class sizes in the Florida university system.

UCF had a student-to-instructor ratio of 30 to 1 in the fall of 2016, while FIU had a 27 to 1 ratio, according to the federal data.

In contrast, schools like the University of Florida, Florida State University and the University of South Florida are looking to limit undergraduate growth and increase their faculty members to reduce class size.

Graduation rates at FIU and UCF also lag the system leaders.

UCF had a 68 percent six-year grad-

uation rate in 2016 and a 44 percent four-year rate, according to state data. FIU had a 55 percent six-year rate in 2016 and a 28 percent four-year rate.

While acknowledging the rates need to be improved, Rosenberg said a unique factor at FIU is the large number of part-time students, 43 percent compared to 10 percent at the University of Florida.

He said his student population reflects the 21st Century economy, where workers will have to return to school to improve their skills by obtaining new degrees or certificates, with many still holding their jobs.

"It is the shape of things to come," Rosenberg said. "Between automation and the emergence of the gig economy, people are going to be full-time learners. They may not be full-time students, but they need to be full-time learners."

While some 31 percent of UCF's enrollment is part-time students, the school has another unique factor. It leads the Florida system by bringing in the most state-college transfers, with 22,000 transfer students as part of the overall enrollment in the fall of 2016.

Transfer students, on average, have lower graduation rates than students who spend their entire time at one school.

Marcos Marchena, chairman of the UCF Board of Trustees, told the Board of Governors in Gainesville that he was skeptical about the school's enrollment size when he initially joined the trustees.

But he said he supports the growth plan so long as it is accommodated with factors such as cost containment and quality improvement.

"I don't know where too big is too big," he said. "We will get to that point. I can't tell you we are at that point right now."



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## BILLIONAIRE BLASTS TRUMP 'DREAMER' DECISION

A prominent Republican fund-raiser turned critic of President Donald Trump said Thursday it would be a huge economic mistake not to let young undocumented immigrants, called "Dreamers," remain in the United States.

"There is something wrong in separating families," Miguel "Mike" Fernandez said, after delivering a speech to students and faculty at Florida A&M University. "That is a universal wrong. We are doing that in DACA."

DACA is the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals program, which allows children brought to the country by their undocumented-immigrant parents to remain in the U.S. Former President Barack Obama put the program in place by executive order.

But the Trump administration this week rescinded the order, with an

effective date of six months, giving Congress time to enact its own version of a DACA plan.

The Cuban-born Fernandez, who is a billionaire Miami businessman, supported Jeb Bush in last year's presidential primary, but broke with his party over Trump's anti-immigration stances and spent some \$3 million in a campaign against Trump.

"If the president talks about Mexicans, murderers, criminals, rapists and so on, these (the Dreamers) are the very best. These are the opposite," Fernandez said. "These are the students who are working hard. They are going to be tomorrow's taxpayers."

Fernandez, 65, who has created a number of health-care companies and later sold them, said Florida has more than 32,000 immigrants protected under DACA, and he estimates they will pay \$6.7 billion in taxes over their lifetimes.

"It's an economic issue," he said. "Throw them out?"

Fernandez's own story as a Cuban exile who came to the U.S. as a 12-year-old with his family was the focus of his speech to the FAMU students. Despite his enormous economic success, Fernandez repeatedly emphasized that he did not believe he had any great talents.

"I'm as average as they come," he said.

He also talked about the many setbacks in his life, including business failures, three failed marriages, two heart attacks and cancer.

"You have to adjust," Fernandez said. "There is not a linear path to success. Actually, I guarantee you that failure is a necessary step towards your success. If you haven't failed, you haven't pushed yourself hard enough."

Fernandez distributed 700 copies of his autobiography, "Humbled by the Journey," and took time after the speech to sign dozens of copies and talk to individual students.

Fernandez's candor was also on display. Earlier in the day, he sent an

email to the Tampa Bay Times calling state House Speaker Richard Corcoran, R-Land O' Lakes, who supports the elimination of DACA, a "bully" and an "intellectual midget."

"They are just facts," Fernandez said when asked about the comments. "That's my opinion of the guy."

Fernandez, who said he has given about \$30 million to Republican causes over the last 15 years, also expressed "disappointment" in Agriculture Commissioner Adam Putnam, although he had given \$100,000 to help Putnam's Republican gubernatorial campaign.

"I think that we lack in this country people who speak and stand on their backbone," Fernandez said.

"He's a guy who was fairly normal in his position until he is faced with an opponent who is more to the right. He feels he has to move to the right," Fernandez said. "I move to where I am, and that's who I respect."

## WHITE NATIONALIST COULD SPEAK OCT. 19 AT UF

After rejecting a request by white nationalist Richard Spencer to speak on campus and being threatened with a federal lawsuit, the University of Florida has set a tentative Oct. 19 date for an appearance by the "alt-right" leader.

"As a public institution, UF is required by law to make a good faith effort to provide options for a reasonable date, time and campus venue, no matter how much we detest the points of views expressed. As with any event, we also have a responsibility to assess safety and security risks, and will continue to do so until the event," the university said in a news release Thursday.

University President Kent Fuchs last month rejected a request by Spencer, president of the National

Policy Institute, to appear Sept. 12 at a campus forum.

Fuchs cited security concerns in the wake of a deadly white-nationalist rally Aug. 12 in Charlottesville, Va., in which a car plowed into a group of counter-protesters, killing 32-year-old Heather Heyer. Two Virginia state troopers also died in a helicopter crash while monitoring the situation.

But Gary Edinger, a Gainesville First Amendment lawyer, threatened to sue the university on behalf of Spencer, the National Policy Institute, and Cameron Padgett, a Georgia State University student involved in organizing Spencer's speech.

Edinger said Thursday he and university officials are still working out "some small details, but the parties appear to have a meeting of the minds" regarding how much the university will be allowed to charge his clients for security. The speech would be held at the university's Phillips Center for

the Performing Arts.

"This was no doubt a sensitive and difficult issue for the University of Florida, but all citizens should be pleased that the First Amendment was ultimately respected," Edinger said.

Spencer, a controversial figure who has been an outspoken supporter of President Donald Trump, earned notoriety following a press conference where followers broke out in Nazi-like salutes in response to Spencer saying, "Hail Trump, hail our people, hail victory!"

Earlier this year, Auburn University paid \$29,000 in legal fees for Padgett after he sued the school for denying Spencer the opportunity to speak.

In Thursday's news release, University of Florida officials said the Oct. 19 date wasn't finalized.

The school has been meeting for a month with state, local and federal law-enforcement agencies to come up with a "comprehensive campus and

community security plan," according to the release.

"UF deplores Spencer's and the National Policy Institute's rhetoric and views, which run counter to those of this institution. We also acknowledge that many of our students, faculty and staff are disproportionately impacted by their racism," the release said. "While this event is not in any way affiliated with the university, UF supports the constitutional right to free speech, and our role as a public university includes legal obligations to allow a wide range of viewpoints to be expressed by external groups --- even when they are contrary to the core values of our university."

Edinger and other First Amendment lawyers maintain that the university's ability to restrict controversial figures like Spencer from appearing on campus is limited, even in the aftermath of Charlottesville.

## USF REACHES TOP TIER OF STATE UNIVERSITIES

The University of South Florida will join the ranks of Florida's "pre-eminent" state universities, USF President Judy Genshaft announced Wednesday in her fall address at the Tampa-based school.

Genshaft said USF, which serves more than 49,000 students on three campuses, has met 11 of 12 performance measures set by the state, enough to reach the top tier of the state schools, which now only includes the University of Florida and Florida State University.

"Finally, amazingly, we have reached pre-eminence," Genshaft told the crowd, which broke into applause and cheers at the Marshall Student Center.

"Since our first student enrolled in 1960, we have turned a well-regarded regional university into one of the top, pre-eminent, public research institutions in the nation," Genshaft said. "We have become the university that other institutions look up to as an aspirant peer."

The last measure USF achieved was pushing its six-year graduation rate above 70 percent. The school's graduation rate became a point of contention in the last days of the 2017 legislative session, when a final version of a higher-education bill revamped the graduation metrics putting USF's rise to pre-eminence in doubt. But the bill was vetoed by Gov. Rick Scott.

A new higher-education bill (SB 4), filed for the 2018 session, would not impact USF's pre-eminence designation in the coming year, although the school will eventually have to meet a 60 percent four-year graduation rate, which would increase from the current 50 percent mark for pre-eminent institutions.

USF's performance, exceeding 11 of the 12 pre-eminence metrics, will have to be certified by the state university system's Board of Governors before the pre-eminent designation becomes official.

The designation will bring not only more prestige but more funding for the university. UF and FSU each received \$17.3 million as pre-eminent universities this year, while USF and

the University of Central Florida each received \$8.7 million as "emerging" pre-eminent schools.

Genshaft said USF's rise to pre-eminence is part of an overall strategy to make the school one of the top public research institutions in the country.

She noted the university generated more than \$475 million in research funding in the 2016-17 academic year, a 3.6 increase over the prior year, trailing only the University of Florida in research funding in the system.

The school produces more than 700 doctoral degrees each year and will have raised \$1 billion in its "Unstoppable" fund-raising drive by November, a year ahead of schedule, Genshaft said.

The one pre-eminent performance metric where USF fell short was failing to achieve at least a \$500 million endowment for the university. But Genshaft provided some context for USF's \$441 million endowment, which is at a record level for the school.

"This is an extremely difficult metric for any university, especially one as young as ours," she said, noting USF

ranks third in its endowment size for schools founded after 1950, trailing two institutions in the University of California system.

In other developments Wednesday, Genshaft said USF has been selected by the international Times Higher Education group to host a "Young Universities Summit" in June.

"This attracts education leaders from around the world, but it has never been held in the United States before," Genshaft said.

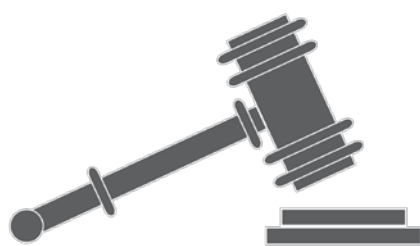
Genshaft said work has begun on the USF Health Morsani College of Medicine and Heart Institute, a facility that is projected to bring more than 2,200 students and faculty to downtown Tampa when it is completed.

Genshaft also said USF has also completed a preliminary study on building an on-campus football stadium and indoor practice facilities.

In addition, Genshaft said she wants to lead an effort to "rebrand" the school and raise its profile, rather than being "a best kept secret."

"It's about time our reputation is as strong as our objective performance," she said.

# Aunt YaYa’s Original Ya-Ya!

Serves 8–10  
Estimated Prep Time: 45 minutes

Now that I am an aunt of two precious nephews, I have my own pet name! For some reason, my nephew Hudson started calling me “YaYa,” and it has stuck. Don’t all southern women want a colorful nickname? This recipe’s name was created way back when I first read Rebecca Well’s book *The Divine Secrets of the Ya-Ya Sisterhood*. Years ago, I created this recipe and was at a loss for what to call it. “Ya-Ya” came to mind, and it stuck. Years later, *The Fish House*, a popular restaurant in Pensacola starting serving a very similar dish called “Grits a YaYa.” Now, I’m not saying that Chef Jim Shirley stole my name—but it looks a lot like my creation! So, if you want the original, look here. Just sayin’!

**Ingredients**  
4 servings hominy grits\*  
1 lb shrimp, peeled and deveined  
1 lb bay scallops  
4 tbsp. olive oil  
1 tbsp. Old Bay Seasoning  
4 c. sharp cheddar cheese, grated  
8 tbsp. real butter

1/2 c. heavy whipping cream  
1 tbsp. fresh minced garlic  
1 large Vidalia or other sweet variety of onion, chopped  
2 tsp. paprika  
Tabasco  
Salt and pepper to taste  
\*Never use quick grits or instant.

Prepare four servings of grits according to package instructions. While grits are simmering, melt two tablespoons of butter and olive oil in heavy skillet over medium high heat. When melted, sauté onions until translucent. Lower heat to medium and add garlic. Cook onions and garlic until onions are caramelized. Remove from pan and set aside.

Return skillet to the heat. Add two more tablespoons of butter and olive oil to skillet and heat until melted on medium heat. Prepare shrimp and scallops for sautéing by tossing with tablespoon of Old Bay Seasoning and then add to skillet. Sauté seafood until cooked through but not overdone. Remove from heat and set aside. Once grits are cooked thoroughly, add four tablespoons of butter, heavy whipping cream, and paprika to grits. Gradually add the cheddar cheese, stirring thoroughly until creamy and completely melted. Add a few shakes

of Tabasco to grits. I usually add four to six shakes for a family meal where I want to keep the heat down, but more is certainly great. You at least need two shakes to bring out the flavor of the cheddar. Salt and pepper to taste. Pour and spread grits into a separate baking dish and add seafood and onions until combined well. It is optional to cover the dish with shredded cheddar cheese and bake until the cheese is melted. Otherwise, it can be served as is. This dish is very amenable to changes and tweaks. For example, any seafood can be used in the dish. Additionally, a bell pepper or Rotel tomatoes can be used along with the onions for the vegetable portion. If you don’t like heavy cream or don’t have any on hand, feel free to substitute with milk or half and half. I have also used sour cream in place of the whipping cream for a very rich flavor. Have fun with this recipe and change it up to reflect the needs of your family or friends.



# Jan’s Birthday Lemon Meringue Pie

Serves 6–8  
Estimated Prep Time: 45 minutes

My mom’s favorite, Ninnie makes this pie for my mom every year on her birthday and I do believe that she eats the entire thing by herself! She says that it is, “So smooth it is best eaten for breakfast.”

### Ingredients

#### Pie Crust

1 1/4 c. all purpose flour  
1/4 tsp. salt  
3 tbsp. shortening  
3 tbsp. cold butter, cut into bits  
2–3tbsp. cold butter

#### Lemon Filling

1 1/4 c. sugar  
1/2 c. cornstarch

1/4 tsp. salt  
2 c. water  
4 large egg yolks  
1/2 c. fresh lemon juice  
4 tbsp. butter, softened  
2 tsp. grated lemon zest

#### Meringue

4 large egg whites, at room temperature  
1/4 tsp. cream of tartar  
1/3 c. sugar

Prepare pie crust: In medium bowl, combine flour and salt. Mix well. With pastry blender or two knives used scissors-fashion, cut in shortening and butter until mixture resembles coarse crumbs. Sprinkle with water, one tablespoon at a time, tossing with fork until pastry holds together to form a dough. Shape dough into a 1/2-inch thick disk, wrap in plastic wrap. Freeze one hour or refrigerate two hours or overnight. If pastry is very cold, let stand a few minutes at room temperature before rolling. Preheat oven to 450 degrees.

On lightly floured surface with lightly floured rolling pin, roll out pastry to thirteen inches around. Place rolling pin across center; lift pastry to drape over rolling pin and transfer to nine-inch pie plate. Press pastry gently to line pan. Trim edges and decoratively pinch. Line pastry shell with foil and bake twelve minutes or until pastry is set. Reduce oven to 400 degrees. Lift foil and bake an additional six

to eight minutes until it is completely done and light brown. Cool. Lemon filling: In medium saucepan, combine sugar, cornstarch, and salt and mix well. Gradually stir in the water until mixture is blended and smooth. Heat to boiling over medium heat, stirring constantly, and boil 1 minute. Remove from heat.

In small bowl, whisk egg yolks until blended. Pour in about 1/2 a cup of hot cornstarch mixture, whisking until blended. Stir together lemon juice, butter, and lemon zest and pour into cornstarch mixture. Pour hot mixture into pastry shell and set aside. Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Prepare meringue. In mixer bowl add egg whites and cream of tartar at medium speed and beat until frothy. Add sugar two tablespoons at a time. When stiff peaks are achieved, spread on top of pie. Bake pie eight to ten minutes until top is browned. Chill in refrigerator and serve.
