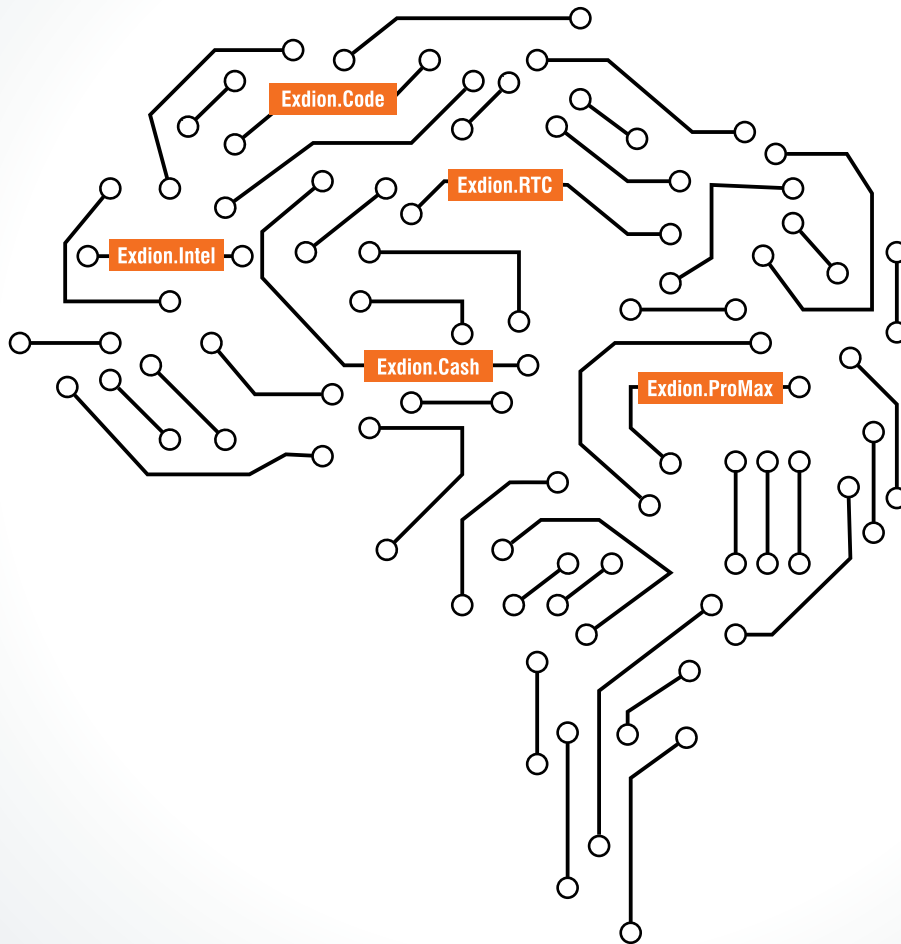

WELCOME

From the UCA President, College President and UCA Chief Executive Officer

Since we convened last year, our staff and volunteers completed the work of the 2024 strategic plan, executing tactics toward our core purpose of Ensuring Urgent Care's Advancement and Ensuring Urgent Care's Long Term Success.

Some of these tactics took interesting turns as the year progressed! The primary shift was in the UCA Board's decision to take our Quality department (that oversees Certification and Accreditation) and expand it into an entirely new organization: The Commission on Ambulatory and Urgent Care Quality. The added voice of CAUCQ will enable us to more quickly elevate the well-deserved reputation of Urgent Care as a field that embraces quality practice and operations. Stop by the CAUCQ area at UC Central to learn more from some familiar faces.

We took another important step down our Advocacy roadmap, where our engagement with members of Congress led the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services CMS to include Urgent Care in the Medicare Physician Fee Schedule as a Request for Information for the first time. We are optimistic that this year CMS

will take the next step toward more appropriate payment for Urgent Care. You can learn more about our Advocacy work by visiting UC Central and at an update session on May 5.

We continued our identity work in two ways: identifying the Values of UCA, and clarifying how the FIVE organizations of the Urgent Care "collective" work together and apart. This work should enable us to move initiatives forward more collaboratively and quickly so we accomplish more, faster. Keep an eye out for the multi-color illustration of how it all comes together.

The clinician side of Urgent Care also had a milestone year. In addition to the College of Urgent Care Medicine (CUCM), which is for all clinicians, we created the Urgent Care College of Physicians (UCCOP). These two groups are continuing work toward specialty recognition for physicians, physician assistants and nurse practitioners within their respective fields. UCCOP was recently admitted to the American Medical Association Specialty Services Society, which is on a path toward a seat in the House of Delegates and a voice in all matters that impact clinical practice in the US. Visit both

groups in UC Central to learn what's next. The Urgent Care Foundation (UCF) continued its work with the Centers for Disease Control on improving antibiotic stewardship in Urgent Care. Using the CDC grant, UCF and Hippo Education have created a new podcast course that goes beyond the fundamental principles all clinicians know and instead trains on how to apply those principles in the demanding Urgent Care setting. The course will be free to all clinicians working at UCA member locations for a year. In addition to the PR campaign just getting underway, UCF is also undertaking workforce-related projects in the coming year. Be sure to participate in the Silent Auction and the Convention's Lego activity to support UCF's efforts. Lastly, one of our goals is to help address our field's long-term staffing shortages. We are launching a new career center - Urgent Care

Compass - that will help you Find Your People (whether you are hiring or seeking). Urgent Care Compass is not like other career centers, and we are excited to show it to you! Visit UC Central to see it in action and sign up.

There is a lot more happening this year, so we encourage you to review our full 2025+ Strategic Plan at urgentcareassociation.org. As we evolve Urgent Care together, let's remember the Values that make UCA great:

We Advance.
