closer to the core ideas of the prompt. Although Copilot offers more detail and is slightly more comprehensive, I believe that my summary offers a more focused and direct approach.

1. What are the strengths of the Copilot summary?

The strengths of the Copilot summary are that it's very detailed and comprehensive. The detail provides more information regarding the main idea of Lo's writing and give more insight into the acronym CLEAR, as well as the goals for AI usage in academic settings.

2. What are the weaknesses of the Copilot summary?

The weaknesses of the Copilot summary are that it is longer and less concise. The added detail can contribute to overgeneralization and make the main idea harder to understand. It lacks focus, which can lead to some confusion.

3. What are the strengths of the summary you created?

The strengths of the summary that I created are that it is concise and stays very focused on the main idea of "The CLEAR Path" by Leo S. Lo. My summary clearly defines CLEAR and explains each part of the acronym and details the framework for using AI.

4. What are the weaknesses of the summary you created?

While being brief can get the main point across very easily, the summary I created may lack some additional information that may be useful to the reader for understanding the main idea as a whole. Part VII

In using AI to generate a rigid summary of a writing, it excels. It provides academic details and accurate summaries while using correct grammar and syntax, but it does not have the human capabilities to make creative works. In my summary, I liked how it felt as if I was speaking it to a friend or even writing a publication of the event. Although there may be room for improvements in grammar and ease of reading, there is still an innately human aspect to it. The generation from ChatGPT lacks that completely. Not only does it sound robotic, but it also split what I wrote into three sections, making it almost seem like it was satisfying a 3-part rubric. All of these characteristics make the writing sound less genuine, thus highlighting AI's painful lack of creative ability. I think in the future I still will be inclined to use AI for strictly rigid purposes, maybe research or grammar checking, but after completing this assignment, I am very certain that I will not be using AI to create any creative works.
