- Performed complete machine setups and changeovers on National, Nedschroef, and Sakamura cold formers, including tooling installation, adjustments, timing, and process troubleshooting.
- Diagnosed mechanical and production issues by evaluating machine operation, tooling condition, timing, and expected operating behavior; inspected, adjusted, repaired, modified, and replaced dies, punches, and related production tooling.
- Performed first-piece and in-process inspections from blueprints, engineering drawings, specifications, setup documentation, and control plans using calipers, micrometers, optical comparators, thread gauges, and height gauges.
- Piloted new production jobs from flow sheets, supplied material, and tooling without established setup sheets or reference samples, developing machine setups and adjustments required to produce conforming parts and establish repeatable production.
- Created operator training documentation covering safety, machine operation, setup, inspection, and troubleshooting, and developed a standardized setup/changeover checklist to improve shift-to-shift continuity and reduce setup errors, troubleshooting time, and avoidable downtime.

- Programmed and configured electronic products by flashing firmware, assigning serial numbers, executing commands through TeraTerm/serial interfaces, and performing post-programming functional testing; used oscilloscopes and function generators for defined product testing and signal-response data collection.
- Developed product test procedures, programming fixtures, and custom test cables in collaboration with the electrical engineer, including a reusable programming fixture that eliminated installation of a dedicated six-pin programming connector on each PCB and reduced assembly steps and programming time.
