

HOW TO CLONE 101

99% Success Rate

1. Find a decent size main branch or side branch to take your clipping from. Try to take cuttings that are at LEAST 4" in length. Anywhere from 4 to 9 inches is a good number.
2. When you take your cutting try to take it just above the node spacing where the leaves grow as this will give more surface area for roots to grow from. Take your clippers at a 45° angle when you make the cut this will also add more surface area for roots.
3. Once you have your cutting, remove excess growth from the cutting and cut the tips of leaves. This will stop photosynthesis and make the plant focus on making roots. I usually leave one set of fan leaves, and 1 or 2 growth tips.

*Tip: Not required but you may also take your clippers and 'skin' a light layer from the base of the stem. This again creates more area for roots to grow and allows them to grow quicker having to grow through less plant material.

4. Submerge the base stem of your cutting in the Clonex Rooting Gel solution for anywhere from 30-90 seconds, allow it to absorb the gel to stop air from going into the stem and help promote healthy root growth hormones.
5. Take your finished cutting and place it in a foam insert then place that in the cloner. Spray clones with mister daily and use humidity dome to keep clones moist and healthy. Most clones root in 5-7 days, but some can take up to 2 weeks so check daily for progress.
