Who got you into eventing?

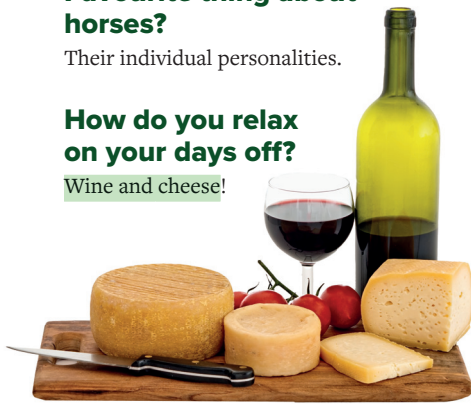
My mum.
