Wings of the North Air Museum to unveil Minnesota Aviation Hall of Fame plaques

The Wings of the North Air Museum will host the unveiling of the plaques honoring seven new inductees into the Minnesota Aviation Hall of Fame at noon Saturday, April 11, at Flying Cloud Airport in Eden Prairie. The Class of 2026 includes:

■ Eugene “Gene” DePalma, Navy veteran and aviation executive

■ Charles "Chuck" Doyle, Jr., airline captain and airplane restorer

■ Cora May Fuller, one of Minnesota's first female pilots

■ Conrad “Butch” Maxwell, Air Force veteran and propeller expert

■ James A. Olsen, founder
of Sun Country Airlines

■ Robert J. Pond, Navy
veteran and vintage aircraft
enthusiast

■ John R. Sandberg, aviation mechanic, restorer, and designer

They will join almost 250 previous inductees.

The museum will also be unveiling the actual

U.S. Navy Blue Angels flight suit worn by the first woman to fly fighter aircraft for the world famous demonstration team, Amanda Lee from Mound View. She was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 2025.

Some of the inductees or their families are expected to be at the unveiling along with several past inductees and local dignitaries. The event is free and open to the public. Doors open at 11 a.m. and the public is welcome to enjoy the aircraft and displays of the Minnesota-themed Wings of the North Air Museum until 3 p.m. A formal induction ceremony and dinner will be held later that evening at the Mystic Lake Center.

Access to Flying Cloud Airport for the public is through Gate H, one mile west of Flying Cloud Drive on Pioneer Trail.

Johnson said. "I mean, the whole family too, but she was there at all the appointments and she was just an absolute rock during it. 'Whatever we got to do, we're going to do it,' type of thing."

The couple will be married this summer, with his medical team from the Mayo Clinic in attendance. Johnson hopes his story

teaches others about the importance of organ donation. "I'm using my second chance to be an advocate in any way I can," he said.
