ABOUT SABYASACHI

Indian ace fashion designer Sabyasachi Mukherjee's instantly recognizable aesthetic finds its roots in his middle-class upbringing. As a young boy, he was greatly influenced by his grandmothers who played a significant role in shaping his identity, which is reflected in his work today.

"I was born in 1974 to a Bengali family. My father was a chemical engineer, my mother a bohemian artist. But it was my two grandmothers who shaped my identity. One taught me the power of minimalism, the other the exuberance of maximalism," the designer shared on Instagram to honor 25 years of his exclusive brand.

Ambitious from a young age, Sabyasachi graduated from the National Institute of Fashion Technology, Kolkata, with top honors. Leading designers expressed their desire to work with him, but the young man sought to carve his own path

with an unwavering ambition to create India's largest luxury design house.

EARTHY DÉCOR

Grounded in old-world charm, the boutique's interiors are decked with vintage lamps, chandeliers, dark wood furniture, paintings, vases, head busts, showpieces of Sabyasachi's insignia, the majestic royal Bengal tiger etc. The earthy décor adds gravitas to the pieces showcased.

BOUTIQUE HIGHLIGHTS

Uncut diamonds, pearls, tourmalines, and emeralds are just a few of the gemstones that the multicolored jewelry pieces on display are embellished with. Additionally, they have neckpieces and earrings made from 18 karat gold, featuring symbols of the royal Bengal tiger and other animals.

Clothing on display includes party wear and casuals made from fabrics like silk, cotton, net, velvet etc. The shimmering and elaborate pieces we loved include an elegant single piece featuring tassels, heavily embroidered jackets, and the carefully curated display of a few ensembles featured on the runway at the 25th-anniversary event.

Other exciting selections on display include leather bags, sleek eyewear, colorful footwear, and the bold and seductive bucket bag, The Nani – a piece of art inspired by the grandmother of the famous couturier behind this eponymous luxury label. ■ IPSHITA
