This sample sets the scene for the Battle of St. Albans and takes players through the quest objectives that lead to King Henry VI's capture and the Duke of Somerset's death. The Age of Empires cinematics will be narrated by Elizabeth of York, the York queen who ended the War of the Roses by marrying Henry VII.

FADE IN:

ELIZABETH OF YORK May 22, 1455. A great king has fallen. A mad king rules in his place.

ELIZABETH OF YORK
Henry VI, of House Lancaster, took
his father's throne when he was
barely tall enough to reach the
seat cushion. The weak-willed king
allowed both his court and his
country to become a battleground
for squabbling nobles.

ELIZABETH OF YORK
The feeble king grew mad under the weight of his crown. His illness demanded a strong leader take his place. Richard, Duke of York and cousin to the mad king, was named protector of the realm. Honorable and focused on restoring order, Richard spent years guiding the realm back toward stability.

Not all were pleased with Richard's newfound role. Queen Margaret of Anjou, the vicious wife of the mad king, was not eager to see her power diminished under Richard's rule. Together with her scheming ally, the Duke of Somerset, they planned to see Richard executed when Henry VI recovered.

But Richard of York had powerful allies of his own. And he would not cede his rule without a fight. Thus began the War of the Roses.

Gameplay: Skirmish starts. Player is commanding Richard of York and a small contingent of soldiers in the northern part of the map.

RICHARD OF YORK
The mad king and the Duke of
Somerset will have my head if I
show my face in St. Albans. I must
gather my forces and...persuade
them to change their minds.

OBJECTIVE Meet up with the Earl of Salisbury.

Gameplay: A marker appears on the western part of the map. Player takes Richard of York and his forces toward the Earl of Salisbury.

They fight small groups of King Henry VI's units and bandits along the way.

The Earl of Salisbury (Gaia unit) rides out to greet Richard of York and offers him a group of knights (Gaia unit) and men-at-arms (Gaia unit).

EARL OF SALISBURY Brother! We will gladly aid your cause. But we cannot storm the city without archers. My son awaits with a fine contingent of longbowmen. Let us be off.

OBJECTIVE: Find the Earl of Warwick and his Longbowmen.

Gameplay: The Player leads Richard of York further south. They must sneak around or fight spearmen and archers (Enemy - King Henry VI's forces) in one of Henry VI's outposts before they reach the Earl of Warwick.

The Earl of Warwick (Gaia unit) and his longbowmen (Gaia unit) approach Richard of York.

EARL OF WARWICK
We'll ride south with you, Uncle.
Every longbowman here is a veteran
of the Hundred Years' War. Bring
us to St. Albans, and we'll make
you into a king.

OBJECTIVE: Attack the city of St. Albans.

Gameplay: The Player guides Richard of York's forces to St. Albans in the south.

It is a small city surrounded by crossbowmen, scouts, spearmen, and knights (Enemy - King Henry VI's forces).

Palisade walls have been erected around the city.

RICHARD OF YORK

To arms, men! We must destroy the barriers and get inside the city!

OBJECTIVE: Destroy the palisade walls to enter St. Albans.

Gameplay: Player has Richard of York's forces make a hole
in the palisade walls.

Once they enter the city, a trigger prompts the EARL OF WARWICK to speak.

EARL OF WARWICK
My spies tell me that King Henry
is hiding in the chapel. That
wretch, Somerset, will be near.
Let us take the king and skewer
Somerset's treacherous heart.

OBJECTIVE: Find and kill the Duke of Somerset.

Gameplay: A map marker appears in the city's monastery.

HENRY VI (Ally - Henry VI) and the DUKE OF SOMERSET (Enemy - Henry VI's Forces) await.

Player has Richard of York's forces fight through the city until they reach HENRY VI and DUKE OF SOMERSET.

HENRY VI

By God, this is treason! Somerset, defend me!

DUKE OF SOMERSET
I will run a blade through
Richard of York's innards, your majesty!

OBJECTIVE: Kill the Duke of Somerset and capture Henry VI.

Gameplay: Richard of York's forces fight DUKE OF SOMERSET (Enemy - Henry VI's Forces), a cavalier unit.

HENRY VI (Ally - Henry VI) , a king unit, stays near the chapel.

When DUKE OF SOMERSET dies, RICHARD OF YORK speaks.

RICHARD OF YORK
The city is ours. Come, Henry, we have much to discuss about the state of the realm.

Gameplay: Victory screen appears. Ending cinematic plays.

ELIZABETH OF YORK Arrows rained down on the city of St. Albans that day. Within an hour, the city fell. And Richard of York marched victoriously through the streets.
