1. If You Have Been Diagnosed with an Asbestos-Related Cancer, Call Us Right Away

Asbestos-related cancers — including lung cancer, mesothelioma, and certain gastrointestinal cancers such as stomach, colon, and throat cancer — can take 20 to 50 years to develop after exposure. So even if you felt fine when we last spoke, a diagnosis could still happen later.

If you have been diagnosed with one of these cancers, you may have the right to pursue a new legal claim — whether you previously settled a case with us or were told you didn't qualify at the time.

2. Please Stay Proactive About Screening

Even if you feel completely healthy, regular screening is one of the most important steps you can take. Asbestos-related cancers are far more treatable when caught early, and a low-dose CT scan (LDCT) is a simple way to get ahead of any problems.

- Talking to your primary care doctor about your asbestos exposure history
- Asking specifically about a low-dose CT scan (LDCT) of the chest
- Visiting the American Lung Association's "Saved by the Scan" program at www.lung.org/saved-by-the-scan
