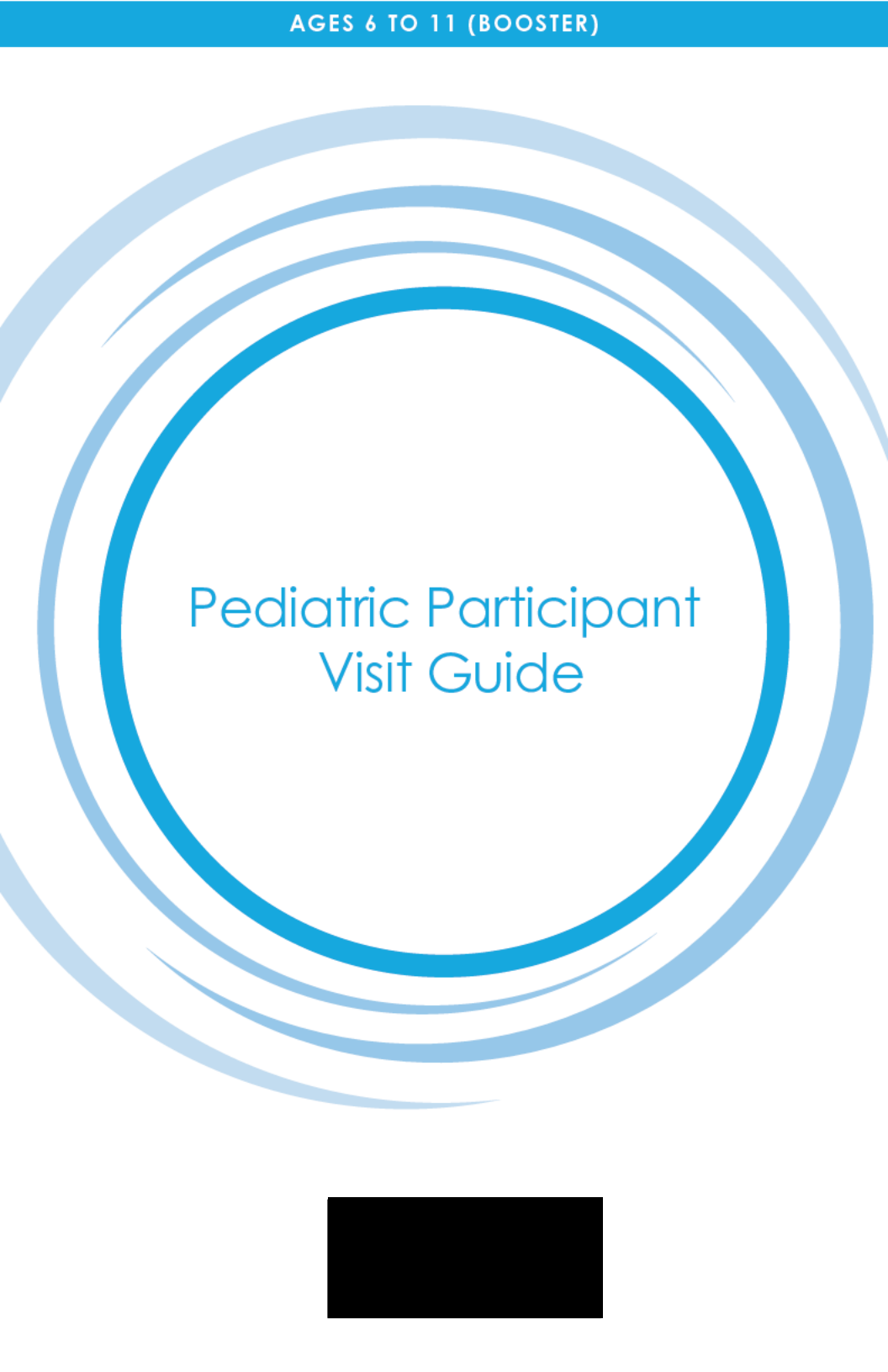
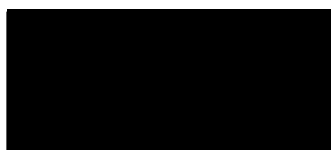

About the Study Procedures

Heroes change the world, and you're one of the heroes helping us in this study! You are now starting the part of the study where you get your shots and the study team checks to see how you're feeling.

Here are a few of the things that will happen during this study:



Physical exam: This is just like an exam by your doctor. The study team will check on your health and take your temperature. They may also check your weight and height.



Blood sample collection: The study team will take some blood from your arm to see how the study vaccine is working for you.



Receive shot: You will get a shot of the study vaccine.



Nasal swab: The study doctor will put a small cotton swab in your nose for a few seconds.



Review of medications and side effects: The study team will ask you and your parents/caregivers questions about other medications you have taken or are currently taking. You will also be asked if you feel differently from how you normally feel.



eDiary questions: You and your parents/caregivers will answer questions about your health using an app on a phone.



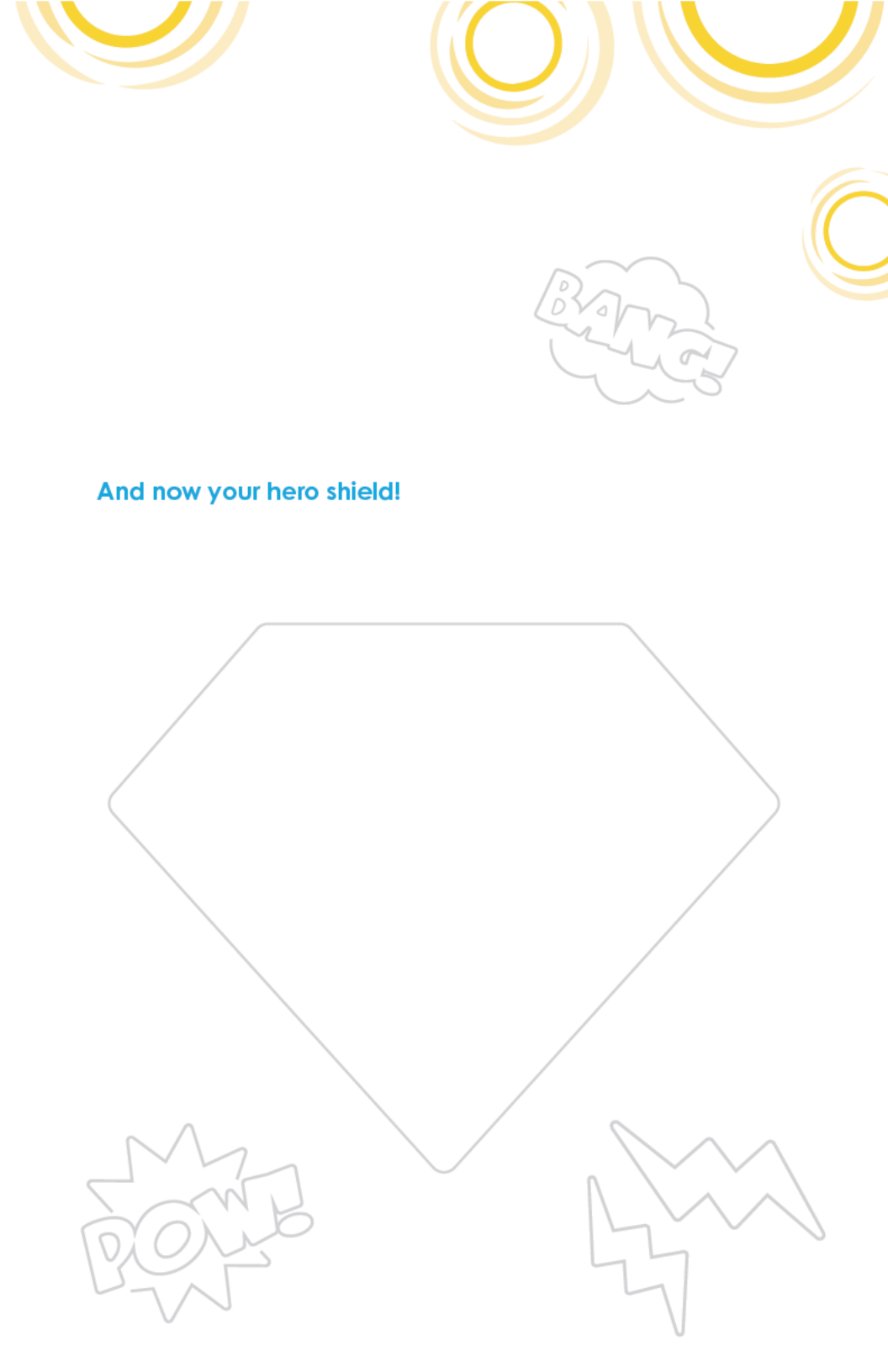
Study Visits
