How to Set Up iTunes' CD Import Settings

1. (Windows) In the menus, click Edit > Preferences. If you can't see the menus, try pressing Ctrl+B.

(Mac) In the menus, click **iTunes** > **Preferences**.

- 2. If you're not under the "General" tab, click the "General" icon at the top of the Preferences window.
- 3. Set the "When a CD is inserted" option to "Show CD." This allows you to doublecheck the info that's automatically looked up. When you're importing custom compilations, this also stops iTunes from automatically importing everything before you get a chance to name it.
- 4. Click the "Import Settings" button next to the step 3 box. See next page for settings.
