After six years of planning and rebuilding the Waldorf Astoria on the monumental Herengracht (Gentleman's Canal), has finally opened and is ready to welcome hotel guests. It is a regular feature in the Waldorf Astoria's landmark hotels, and is a restaurant area to indulge in tea and coffee and all-day dining.

Guests and visitors can also enjoy a gastronomic experience at the restaurant Librije's Zusje Amsterdam, run by executive chef, Sidney Schutte and a sister of the 3-star Michelin restaurant De Librije in Zwolle. Signature Cocktails and fine beverages including locally brewed liqueurs and wines can be sipped at the Vault Bar, named after the bank vault which still has the original lockers showcased.



The hotel also offers the luxurious new Guerlain boutique spa, where guests can relax in a tranquil space with three different restful treatment rooms. Offering a varied range of spa treatments by highly trained therapists ensures you a unique and revitalizing experience. The spa also has direct access to the hotel's beautiful private garden.
