Bibliographic Guide to Business and Economics. New York: G. K. Hall/Micmillan, 1974- Annual. (C-15)

This print and online resource is useful for collection development, the Bibliographic Guide to Business and Economics includes cataloging information for business and economics. Books, nonbooks and serials are included with author, title, and subject information. Unfortunately, there is a three-year lag time between the date of the volume and its publication date. This online database publishes web-based bibliographic information, available to current students, faculty and staff of the University of Chicago. This database is accessible to any web connection but access to linked articles is restricted to current students, faculty and staff of the University of Chicago. These are also accessible at other institutions that have licensed these resources using the publisher's URLs. Other users should contact their local library regarding access to publications. The database contains journal articles published by members of the faculty of the Graduate School of Business. The database can be searched by author or by publication. Individual faculty bibliography pages include books, working papers and other publications. The database includes full time faculty who were at Chicago beginning with the 2004 - 2005 academic year and the latest update was done in 2006. Individual bibliographies are updated more frequently than this database. (EKW 201115-673-901 N)

Two pre-eminent collections of early economic material - the holdings of the Kress Library of Business and Economics at Harvard University and the Goldsmiths Library of Economic Literature at the University of London - were merged, microfilmed and cataloged to create a massive bibliography of economic literature. The collections begin in the 15th century and run into the early 20th century. The collection also includes materials from Columbia and Yale Universities. With over 60,000 entries, the catalog of the library is one of the most comprehensive bibliographies of economic material (C-19, C-20, C-21, C-22, C-23, C24). The above link goes to the Consolidated Guide of the collection which serves as the primary access tool of the microfilm collection. The guide can be searched, browsed by collection or browsed by subject. Sections of the guide may also be downloaded for offline usage. (JMD 200945-673-900 U)

The International Bibliography of the Social Sciences (IBSS) covers anthropology, economics, political science, and sociology and each volume is written in English and French. The volume dedicated to economics is an extensive resource for international economics coverage. The 700-page bibliography is published annually, and covers articles and books of the highest quality that are written by experts and leaders in the field of economics. Also included in this text is a description of the selection criteria and a list of abbreviations used and periodicals consulted. This text is indexed by author, subject, and place-name, making it an easy to search and understand. This is an ideal bibliographic reference for students, researchers and librarians. The bibliographic information contained in this text can also be accessed online via the digital version of the IBSS available through paid subscription from *ProQuest*. (JPT 201015-673-501 N)
