What are some of the most common wildlife issues that homeowners face in your area?

Roof rats, squirrels, and raccoons (year-round). Bats are seasonal (February - November). Mice in new developments.

How do the seasons affect wildlife activity in your area?

Bats are affected by season (Spring-Fall). Rats and mice are all year-round—as are other mammals—but removal is more complicated during baby season.

Any prevention tips for residents in your area?

- Homeowners should cut trees back away from the roofline.
- Any dense foliage or plants should be trimmed a few inches away from the perimeter of the home.
- Pick up fruit from fallen trees to reduce easy access to food sources.
- Feed pets indoors whenever possible.
- Clean up pets' fecal matter from yard regularly to avoid attracting pests.

When should homeowners call Critter Control?

Homeowners should call the critter control as soon as they suspect a pest is in or trying to get in their home. Prevention and early detection are always a more cost-effective process to remedy the situation and prevent any critter related damage.
