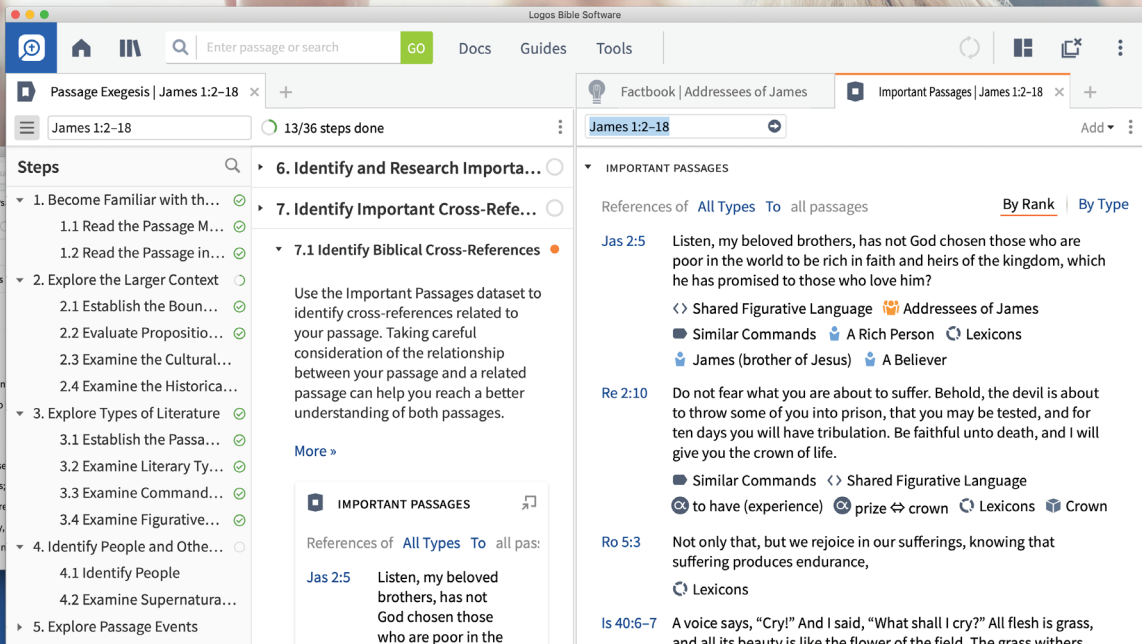


Will Your Words Linger When the Lecture Ends?
