

Air Terjun Curup Gangsa

A “musical” waterfall.

Indonesia is bustling with lively activities and busy cities. Still, there are times where people want to get away from those activities. Air Terjun Curup Gangsa is an excellent site to find the peace you need. Located in Lampung, the Air Terjun Curup Gangsa (Curup Gangsa Waterfall) is one of the giant waterfalls due to its 70 meters height and 20 meters width. It is called Curup Gangsa because of the drizzling sound that is similar to the music of Gangsa, which is a traditional flute.

Playing under the waterfall



The waterfall is pretty unique, as it has many different branches that give the impression of mini waterfalls gathered in one. After admiring the majestic appearance of the waterfall, visitors can go down the 76 stairs and reach the bottom of the waterfall and feel the water hitting their bodies.

If you look across the waterfall, you will see some tents not far from the waterfall. Yes, you can actually camp and do barbeque with the waterfall as your background! If you think camping is a hassle, there is always the mini garden that has strategically-placed gazebos.

Things to know

Although the waterfall is an open place, the tourist attraction opens from 8 A.M. to 6 P.M. The entrance ticket is Rp10,000 per person. At the same time, the cost of the parking ranges from Rp5,000 to 15,000. There is a small food stall people can visit. Trash cans, toilets and prayer rooms are also available for visitors.

How to get there

You will need to spare some time to reach Curup Bangsa because the trip from Bandar Lampung can take up to 4 hours. After all, the waterfall has a distance of 181 kilometres from Bandar Lampung. For a shorter trip, visitors can start from Kasui, as the distance between Kasui and the waterfall is only 10 km. You can also use trains from Bandar Lampung to Stasiun Blambangan Umpu, and then rent a car from the train station to the waterfall.
