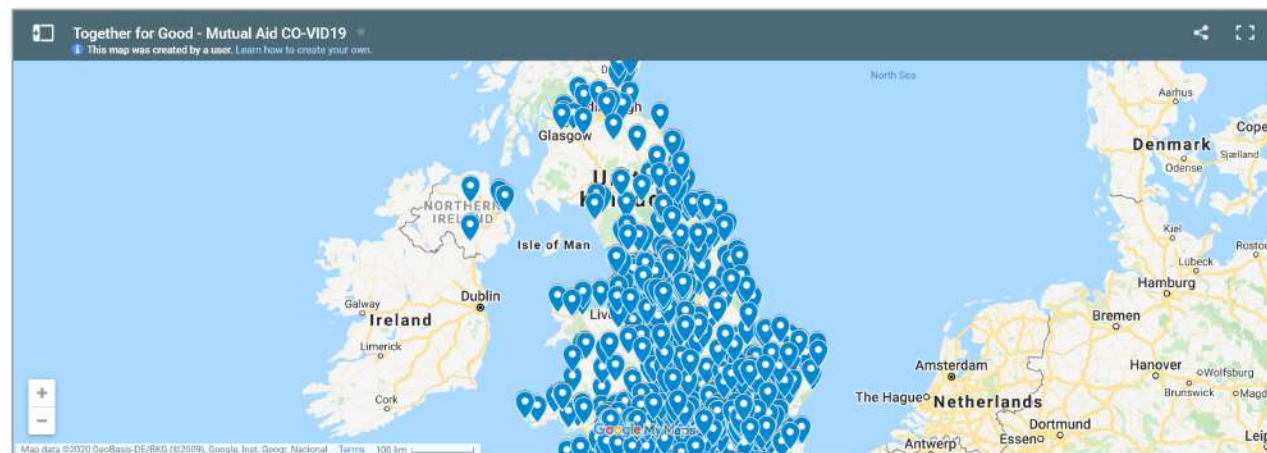

LABYRINTH PROJECT

What is a labyrinth?

A Labyrinth is an image with which we can have a direct experience or link. It is a metaphor for life's journey when used as a Spiritual tool. Unlike a maze, a Labyrinth has a single, continuous path, which leads to the centre and back out again, it should not be difficult to negotiate.

The evidence shows that Labyrinths have been around since Neolithic times. There have been several incidences of ideograms carved into rock faces across Neolithic and Bronze-age Europe. Some research suggests that the geometric shape produces an energy field that can heal ailments of the body and calm the mind.

Find out for yourself by trying a labyrinth game:



With the journey the whole world is now taking in regards to Covid-19, we would like to build a Labyrinth, created by the residents in Burnham, to stand as a memory for years to come and to remind future generations of what Burnham and the rest of the World went through.

To do this, we want each resident in Burnham to paint a stone, ideally 10cm or bigger. If you wish to participate, you can paint a stone in any way your heart desires. It could be painted your favourite colour, or painted with the name of a loved one you may have lost, perhaps painted to celebrate someone you saw as your hero during this tough time, such as the NHS, a carer or a friend/family member, it is completely up to you.

Once the lock down is over, we will provide more information on where you can drop the stones off so they can have a protective coating applied before they are added to the Labyrinth.

The labyrinth will be a multi faith area where people of all ages can go to sit, mourn and reflect at anytime, as it will be open access. The labyrinth will also be a place for children to walk through and learn about how the residents of Burnham got through their journey together.

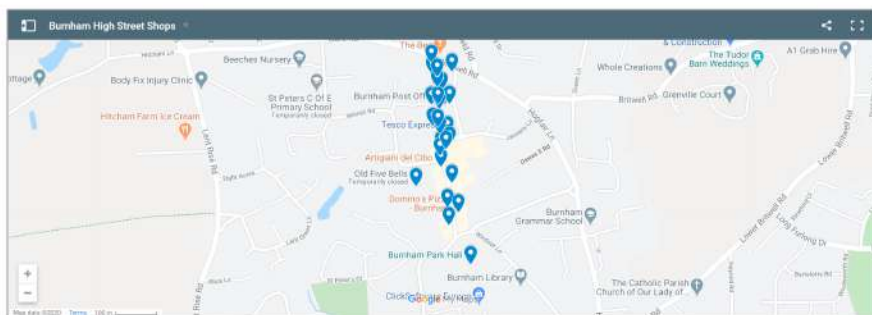
