


## Installing Oxygen XML Editor Updates

This article explains how to install a new version of the Oxygen XML Editor. Before you begin, make sure the current license key has been added to the Oxygen XML Editor (see [Oxygen Licensing](#)). You must also have Administrator access to the C:\Program Files folder.

### Instructions

1. Open the Oxygen XML Editor.
2. On the **Help** menu, click **Check for a New Version**.

The Check for a New Version dialog states that you are either running the current version or provides information about a new version that is available to download.



The above example shows that a new version is available to download.


3. Click the **Download version** link.

The Oxygen download page opens.



4. Click the blue Oxygen XML Editor **Download** button.

The Oxygen XML Editor download page opens.



## Download Oxygen XML Editor

Download Oxygen XML Editor and test it for free for 30 days (requires a [trial license key](#)). This allows you to evaluate the software for free before making a purchase decision.


\* The OpenJDK JRE bundled with Oxygen is created using jlink from the Eclipse Adoptium Temurin distribution and jmods of the corresponding version of JavaFX by Gluon.

5. Click the red **Download** button for the Windows 64-bit version.

Ignore the form that opens. The installation file automatically downloads.

6. Open the installation file after it has completely downloaded.

The Language Selection popup opens.




7. Select **English**, and then click **OK**.


8. A message appears that says: **Do you want to allow this app to make changes to this device?** Click **Yes**.

9. The Oxygen XML Editor Setup Wizard opens.

Respond to the wizard prompts.




Click **Next**.



Select **I accept the agreement**.


Click **Next**.



Accept the suggested folder name.

Click **Next**.


 In the past, there have been issues that adversely affected the formatting of Help pages after a new Oxygen XML Editor version was installed. Make sure you install the new version into a new folder so you can run the Oxygen XML Editor from a previous installation folder while troubleshooting any issues with the new version.



Do **not** check the **Uninstall previous version from** box.


Click **Next**.

**⚠** Uninstalling a previous version may have unintended consequences. For example, custom files stored in the previous installation folder may be deleted.




Accept the suggested Start Menu folder name.

Click **Next**.




Click **Select All**.


Click **Next**.
