Mayple Marketing

Video 1: (Feeling) Lost to Empowered

Scene: Opens with actor sitting in the middle of the frame "I'm an influencer, but my fan base isn't growing as fast as I'd like."

Scene: Splits and actor is mirrored

Right side of screen: "I am too, but I'm getting the growth I want."

Scene: Pans out. Actor on the left is in the dark/shade (possible set of CVs and papers next to him). Actor on the right has a single computer/workstation next to him, a lamp is on.

Left side: "I've been trying to get my name and brand out to the right people, but all I've found are problems, walls, and a lack of help or leads. I don't even know the difference between Linkedin and Freelancer..."

Right side: "I can help with the first problem, Google can fix the second." looks over to the left side "I found something that really helped me take hold of the situation."

Left side: "I thought the nicer looking the website, the better the help would be."

Right side: "That's called falling for a fake product."

Left side: I couldn't figure out who could really promote me and what I had to offer. One person even said I had to pay for a meeting.

Right side: That's....called theft.

Left side: "I wasn't sure how to even get up off the ground floor of my own business or who could help me get the top results I need to be heard. I'm kind of on my own here."

Right side: **sighs and looks over again.** "This is starting to sound really familiar....Hey. HEY!

Look over here." **Taps the line separating them.** "I'm you, from the future."

Left side: "What? How is that...?"

Right side: "Just go with it. Look, you cost me a lot of money and heartache following

dead-ends that weren't going to pan out; and being on your own doesn't mean you have to be

alone. How about, I enlighten you and get your confidence up so you can get on track to turning

into me?"

Left side: "How do we do that?"

Right side: rolls eyes and reaches over to CVs. "This nonsense? This is holding you back."

Thankfully, there's someone that can give you the know-how to manage it and actually get you

to a place where you have some control."

Left side: "I don't under..."

Right side: stands up "Just sit there. I got this." addresses camera and screen merges into

one person. "This mess behind me was where I started when I wanted to build my brand and

try to manage my own marketing. However, nobody tells you starting out on your own doesn't

mean you have to be alone. When I was lost, instead of whining and paying people to like my

pages online, I turned to Mayple to really show me where I was going wrong, and the best

options for me...

Left side: "Like the syrup?"

Right Side: "Sit and learn." readdresses camera "Mayple has a wide range of tools that helped

me get in control and feel empowered to actually work with my brand, not just for it. They gave

me company comparisons, a free account audit, and even the ability to try-out different services,

all to make sure I was comfortable and happy with the best care the industry has to offer."

Left side: "That sounds great!"

Right side: "It is. So what are you waiting for? Don't be a mess and don't give up. Mayple is

here to lift you up."

Left side: "Okay, but what about these bills from before?"

Right side: "That sounds like a personal problem. For everything else, there's Mayple."

Video 2 (or second scene for first video): (Tools) Build-Up Your Brand...and Yourself

Scene: Opens with actor sitting in the middle of the frame

"I'm a brand."

Scene: Splits and actor is mirrored

Right side of screen: "I am too."

Scene: Pans out. Actor on the left is surrounded by power tools, pencils, art supplies, posters, etc. Actor on the right has a single computer/workstation next to him on a desk (possible toolbox on the desk).

Left side: "I've been trying to make connections and create campaigns to get the right people to see me and what I have to offer. Unfortunately..." **holds up broken power cord/tool/etc.**

"That's not going so well."

Right side: "I'm doing pretty well for myself."

Left side: **looks over** "You found a fresh pack of batteries?"

Right side: looks over "No, I just let the professionals do what they do best."

Left side: "But I'm a professional-"

Right side: leans over and looks at the chaos "mess. You're a professional mess." pushes

left side out of the frame and right half (neat/orderly/etc.) takes over "I didn't know how to

get my name and image out there. However, Mayple has been there and understood exactly

what I needed." opens toolbox "Looking for the right people to run my marketing was a

nightmare, and I didn't want to go down the same road as before. Thankfully, Mayple offered me

the tools to not only make the right decision, but to make the best decision for me."

Left side: (voice-over) "How?"

Right side: "Not only could I compare different agencies against each other and what I wanted, they did a complete audit of everything I've tried so far, let me know exactly what I would be getting into before I signed anything."

Left side: **(voice-over)** "So it's like an inside-look?"

Right side: "Yeah, but instead of just an inside-look, you get complete transparency."

Left side: **(voice-over)** "What about all the marketing lingo?"

Right side: "Not everyone's a marketing genius. However, I know my brand better than anyone else. Thankfully, M knows the rest. Once I found the right campaign manager for my project, I needed someone to make sure I was getting exactly what I wanted. Mayple was there every step of the way to back me up and explain anything that didn't make sense." **picks up broken tool** "or work."

Left side: (voice-over or appears in the frame, looks a bit disheveled or confused) "What do they get from all of this?"

Right side: Peace of mind. Mayple knows how hard it is to get the right marketing, and their compassion translated to results." **addresses camera** "Marketing and management isn't all numbers. Thanks to Mayple not only did I have the tools to get to where I wanted to go, but the confidence to do it on my own terms."

Video 3: Making Yourself Heard

Scene: Opens with actor sitting in the middle of the frame

"I'm a small business."

Scene: Splits and actor is mirrored

Right side of screen: "I am too."

Scene: Pans out. Actor on the left is surrounded by a microphone, loudspeaker, other sound symbolism. Actor on the right has a single computer/workstation next to him on a desk.

Left side: "I've been trying to get my voice heard

Right side: "I'm doing pretty all right for myself."

Left side: **looks over** "You got the Bluetooth to work?"

Right side: looks over "Not exactly."

Right side: leans over and takes the microphone "I found someone who actually listens."

Right side expands and fills the screen

Right side: stands up with the mic and walks forward "Mayple made it not only easy for me to connect to the right influencers and marketers that understood me, but also could get the word out about what I had to offer.

Left side: **(voice-over)** "What about my budget"

Right side: "Mayple helped me try-out different agencies and options that fit within my budget."

Left side: (voice-over) "What about finding the right voice for my new product?"

Right side: "They connected me with marketing specialists that have promoted similar brands that work exactly in my industry."

Left side: **(voice-over)** "What about easing my fears about stepping out into the marketing world?"

Right side: "Face-to-face online support, advertiser audits, actual performance benchmarks, and more, all suited to exactly what I needed."

Left side: **(voice-over)** "What about getting the Bluetooth to work?"

Right side: **eyebrow raise** "I think that's an IT issue. For everything else there's Mayple right at your fingertips."
