Before long, Amy was lured into the horrific world of sex trafficking. Forced to perform unspeakable acts with strangers, Amy's self-worth was destroyed. "All of a sudden I was working 12 hours a day. I felt like my body was not mine anymore. I was totally disconnected. I felt disgusting," Amy says.

Out of options, Amy used drugs to numb her mind and the pain. *"I tried to make plans to leave. He was furious. He threatened to kill me and kill my parents. I was filled with so much shame and guilt."*

Getting caught up in the sex trade is easier than people think. Getting out is the hard part.

Victims of sex trafficking are often paralyzed by fear and feel humiliated and alone. Their captors keep a tight grip on them by playing mind games, using intimidation and threatening violence. For most girls, escape does not seem like an option.

Sex trafficking is a growing crime in Canada.

I know it's hard to believe but stories like Amy's are happening every day right here where we live – along our highways, in our hotels and online. Young girls are being beaten, branded and bought and sold for sex. These are Canadian girls from all socioeconomic backgrounds and they are as young as 13 years old.

Girls like Amy urgently need your help right now – can we count on your support?

Breaking free from the bonds of sex trafficking takes a tremendous amount of strength and courage. The road to recovery can be difficult, but with our unyielding support they can learn to move past this horrible experience and go on to live healthy and productive lives.
