Funding Your College Education

NWACC places higher education within financial reach and offers an affordable path to your academic goals. As a student, you'll have access to a variety of [financial aid resources](#) to help you pay for college.

About Financial Aid

FAFSA - Most types of financial aid come from federal and state programs, which require completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The funds awarded to you are based off your demonstrated need. You can [fill out the FAFSA](#) form at [fafsa.ed.gov](#) and apply for state aid at [adhe.edu](#).

Grants - A grant, such as the [Pell Grant](#), is a type of financial funding that you don't need to pay back. The amount of grant money awarded to you is based on demonstrated financial need, which is decided by your [FAFSA](#) application.

Scholarships - Scholarships are awarded financial assistance that you don't need to pay back. Many [scholarships](#) are based on academic merit or other achievements, while some are also need-based.

Work-Study - Your [FAFSA](#) application also determines your eligibility for work-study employment opportunities at NWACC. Eligible students can work up to 19 hours per week to pay for college expenses.

Career Pathways - NWACC's [Career Pathways](#) program offers financial assistance to eligible students who are parents to a child under 21 and meet certain income guidelines.

Student Loans - Federal and private [student loans](#) can help you offset your education expenses but unlike grants and scholarships, this funding accrues interest and you are responsible for paying the loans back. It's best to exhaust all other financial aid resources before applying for a student loan.

How to Apply to NWACC

1. Complete the NWACC application and admission steps at www.nwacc.edu/apply.
2. Complete and file your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

Filling out the FAFSA form helps you apply for types of financial aid such as scholarships and grants. NWACC can help you complete your FAFSA, just text 479-309-5532.
3. Submit your high school transcripts and transcripts of any college courses completed to NWACC:

What to Expect After You've Been Accepted

1. Activate your My NWACC account.
You will receive an email with your NWACC username and password to activate your account.
2. Check email for important reminders from your academic advisor.
Several important documents must be received, accepted or waived before your financial aid can be disbursed.
3. Enroll in the freshmen orientation (if you are a first-time college student).
Orientation information will be provided to you through your NWACC email.
4. Register for your classes.
When you are accepted, you will be assigned an academic advisor. They will help you register for classes.
5. Set up a payment plan, if needed.
You will log into your My NWACC account to set up a payment plan.
6. Purchase your textbooks and supplies from the Barnes and Noble Bookstore at NWACC.

Brightwater was conceived to be more than a typical culinary school. As an academic department of NorthWest Arkansas Community College (NWACC), Brightwater offers academic programming and career training in the areas of culinary nutrition, artisanal food, beverage management and food entrepreneurship.

Brightwater approaches food as art, food as wellness and food as business to offer a unique approach to the culinary arts. Themes of culinary nutrition, food waste reduction and food security are woven throughout the curricula. Classes in applied farming, seasonal cooking and the art of fermentation are among the many one-of-a-kind classes at Brightwater.*

*Special classes are offered intermittently depending on demand.

STATE OF THE ART FACILITIES

Brightwater is located in 8th Street Market in Bentonville, Arkansas. The facility occupies 27,500 square feet within a larger building surrounded by various food businesses.

Facilities include:

- + Five professional kitchens
- + Butchery facility
- + Bakeshop with commercial equipment
- + Culinary demonstration theater
- + 2,500 sq. ft. greenhouse
- + And more

DEGREE & CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS

Brightwater's academic programming and career training develop individuals into leaders who combine culinary skills with the ability to recognize and address complex food issues.

AAS degrees and technical certificates are offered in the following areas:

SOUS CHEF APPRENTICESHIP

Registered through the US Department of Labor (DOL) and the American Culinary Federation Education Foundation, Brightwater's Certified Sous Chef Apprenticeship program provides a hands-on educational experience by combining classroom instruction and on-the-job training, allowing you to earn while you learn.

After completing the Certified Sous Chef Apprenticeship program, you will receive a DOL certificate of completion, and be eligible to take exams and earn the Certified Sous Chef (CSC) credential through the American Culinary Federation (ACF).
