Nera meaning: Coinage from Sanskrit 'niramaya' meaning 'health'.
The name connotes that the capsules promote health and
well-being. The sound is modern and international.





Jevos

Jevos meaning: Coinage from Sanskrit 'jiva' meaning 'healthy'.
The name connotes that the capsules promote health and well-being.
The sound is global-contemporary.



ROA

Roa meaning: Coinage from Sanskrit 'rohati' meaning 'heal'.
The name suggests that the company's capsules heal the body with
vital medicine and nutrition. The sound is short and global.




YATA

Yata meaning: Coinage from Sanskrit 'yataya' meaning 'transport'.
The name suggests that the capsules transport good health or
necessary nutrition to the body. The sound is contemporary.



ZAMÉ

Zame meaning: Coinage from Sanskrit 'zambara' meaning 'magic'.
The name suggests that ACG capsules work like magic to relieve pain,
restore health or infuse nutrition in the body. The sound is Euro-global.

SKOOPA
