One of the biggest fears people with Parkinson's share with us is that when they go into hospital, they won't get their medication on time, every time.

The ability to manage symptoms of their Parkinson's can be lost if medication is delayed. They may find themselves unable to move, to get out of bed, or even to walk to the bathroom.



Our most recent report found that almost two-thirds of people weren't always getting their medication time. That's far too many people not getting the support they need.

We've created a 15-minute training video for all ward staff, to help them understand the importance of managing medication for patients with Parkinson's. **You can help** by telling your local hospital they need to bring in mandatory training.
