Consider my proven approach to authoring technical documentation:

- 1. Strong technical aptitude means quick immersion and good situational awareness.
- 2. Evaluate the software, device, product or process, and then ask clarifying questions.
- 3. Write outline.
- 4. Write on core features or concepts.
- 5. Revise according to preliminary client feedback.
- 6. Timely and priority writing on remaining features.
- 7. Get answers to questions, working from specific to general topics.
- 8. Step back to write summaries: workflows, section overviews, and examples.
- 9. Write on any late-developing features (built toward the end of writing activity)
- 10. Formatting + styling of headings, sections and tables.
- 11. Formatting: spacing, lists, multiple columns, and so on.
- 12. Refine all diagrams, screenshots, and images.
- 13. Build interactive ToC, cross-references, indexes, and footnotes.
- 14. Render in target(s) and verify.
