## DISRUPTIVE & UNCOMFORTABLE FACTS

In the United States, Black individuals are **40% more likely** than other racial groups to live in areas affected by increased heat-related deaths.



## DISRUPTIVE & UNCOMFORTABLE FACTS

Hispanic and Latino individuals are **43% more likely** than other racial groups to live in areas where labor will be impacted by climate change.



## DISRUPTIVE & UNCOMFORTABLE FACTS

Climate impacts will affect agriculture the most, a key sector in the poorest countries and a major source of income, food security, nutrition, jobs, livelihoods and export earnings.





## DISRUPTIVE & UNCOMFORTABLE FACTS

In addition, the poorest regions of the world — Sub-Saharan Africa and South Asia — will be hit the hardest by climate change despite being the least responsible.



# THE IMPACT

More than 130 million people could be pushed into extreme poverty by climate change by 2030



# THE GOOD NEWS FINALLY . . . RESULTS

We have an example of a collaboration with a local, Black-led, community-based organization that is advancing work to restore coastal habitats that will mitigate storm-caused flooding.

The project is improving biodiversity, building local capacity and strengthening the local economy through job creation.
