4. LOWA RENE-GADE GORE-TEX MID LIGHT HIKING BOOTS, WOMEN'S Step into any rugged

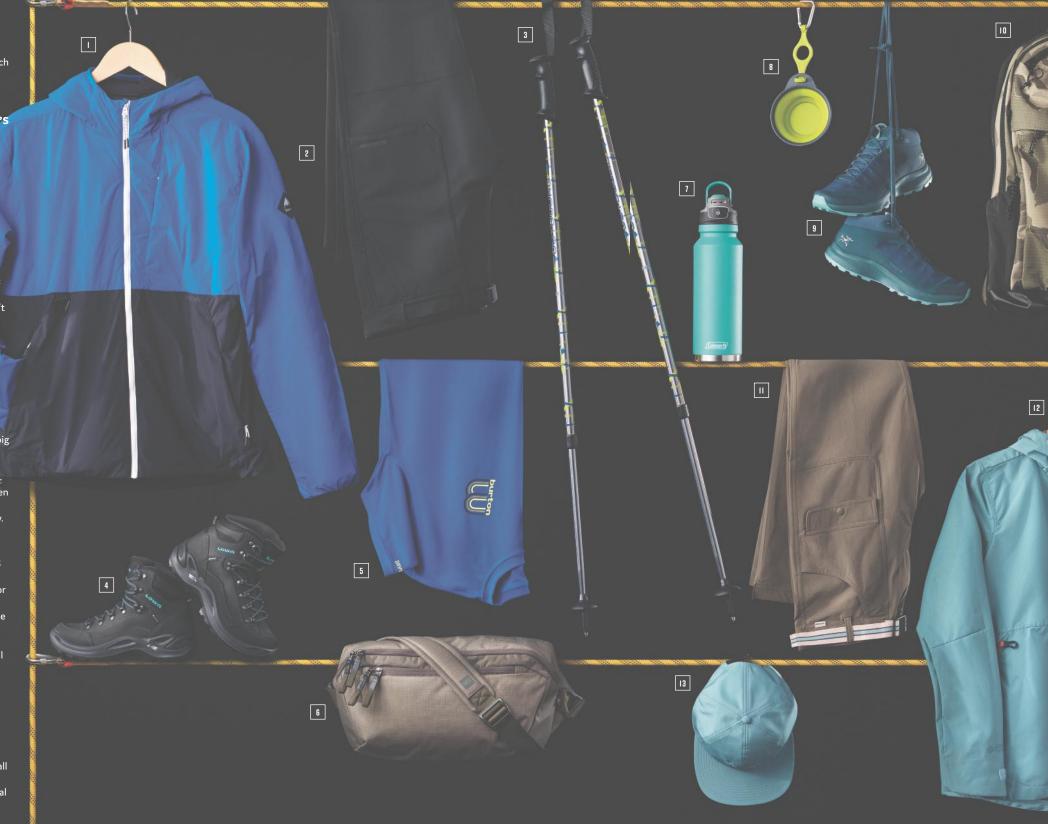
